Eureka Apollo Bagless Cylinder Vacuum Cleaner Instruction Manual

Model: Apollo-800W

INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential instructions for the safe and efficient operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your Eureka Apollo Bagless Cylinder Vacuum Cleaner. Please read this manual thoroughly before first use and retain it for future reference.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Always follow basic safety precautions when using electrical appliances to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, or injury.

- Do not leave the vacuum cleaner unattended when plugged in.
- Unplug from outlet when not in use and before servicing.
- Do not use outdoors or on wet surfaces.
- Do not allow to be used as a toy. Close attention is necessary when used by or near children.
- Use only as described in this manual. Use only manufacturer's recommended attachments.
- Do not use with damaged cord or plug. If appliance is not working as it should, has been dropped, damaged, left outdoors, or dropped into water, return it to a service center.
- Do not pull or carry by cord, use cord as a handle, close a door on cord, or pull cord around sharp edges or corners. Do not run appliance over cord. Keep cord away from heated surfaces.
- Do not unplug by pulling on cord. To unplug, grasp the plug, not the cord.
- Do not handle plug or vacuum cleaner with wet hands.
- Do not put any object into openings. Do not use with any opening blocked; keep free of dust, lint, hair, and anything that may reduce airflow.
- Keep hair, loose clothing, fingers, and all parts of body away from openings and moving parts.
- Do not pick up anything that is burning or smoking, such as cigarettes, matches, or hot ashes.
- Do not use to pick up flammable or combustible liquids, such as gasoline, or use in areas where they may be present.
- Do not use without dust cup and/or filters in place.

- Turn off all controls before unplugging.
- Use extra care when cleaning on stairs.

PACKAGE CONTENTS

Your Eureka Apollo vacuum cleaner package should include the following components:

- Eureka Apollo Cylinder Vacuum Cleaner Unit
- Flexible Hose
- Telescopic Wand
- Floor Nozzle (Standard Brush)
- 2-in-1 Dusting Brush/Crevice Tool

SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

1. **Attach the Hose:** Insert the flexible hose into the suction inlet on the main vacuum cleaner unit until it clicks securely into place.
2. **Connect the Telescopic Wand:** Attach the telescopic wand to the handle end of the flexible hose. Ensure it is firmly connected.
3. **Attach the Floor Nozzle:** Connect the desired floor nozzle (standard brush) to the end of the telescopic wand.
4. **Attach Accessories (Optional):** For specialized cleaning tasks, attach the 2-in-1 dusting brush/crevice tool directly to the hose handle or the telescopic wand.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Powering On and Off

- Plug the power cord into a suitable electrical outlet.
- Press the power button located on the main unit to turn the vacuum cleaner on.
- To turn off, press the power button again.

Adjusting Suction Power

The Eureka Apollo features powerful suction suitable for various surfaces.

Some models may include a suction control slider on the hose handle or main unit to adjust suction strength for different floor types or delicate items. Refer to the markings on your specific unit.

Using the Telescopic Wand and Accessories

- **Telescopic Wand:** Adjust the length of the telescopic wand by pressing the release button and extending or retracting it to a comfortable height for floor cleaning or to reach high areas like curtains and ceilings.

- **2-in-1 Dusting Brush/Crevice Tool:** This versatile tool can be used for cleaning upholstery, pet hair from beds, tight spaces like sofa crevices, computer keyboards, and other delicate surfaces. It can be attached directly to the hose handle.

Automatic Cord Rewind

To retract the power cord, gently pull the cord slightly and then release it. The cord will automatically rewind into the unit.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures optimal performance and extends the life of your Eureka Apollo vacuum cleaner. Always unplug the appliance before performing any maintenance.

Emptying the Dust Container

The vacuum cleaner is equipped with a 2.2-liter dust container. Empty it regularly, especially when the 'MAX' fill line is reached, to maintain strong suction.

1. Press the dust container release button (if applicable) and carefully remove the dust container from the main unit.
2. Position the dust container over a waste bin.
3. Open the bottom flap or lid of the dust container and shake out the contents.
4. Close the flap/lid and reattach the dust container to the vacuum cleaner unit until it clicks into place.

Cleaning the Filters

The Eureka Apollo uses a HEPA filter system. Filters should be cleaned regularly to prevent clogging and maintain suction power.

1. Remove the dust container as described above.
2. Locate and remove the pre-motor filter (usually foam or felt) and the HEPA post-motor filter.
3. Tap the filters gently over a waste bin to remove loose dust.
4. If washable, rinse the filters under cold running water until the water runs clear. Do not use detergents.
5. Allow filters to air dry completely for at least 24 hours before reinserting them. Do not use a hairdryer or other heating methods.
6. Reinsert the dry filters and reattach the dust container.

Note: Replace filters every 6-12 months, or as needed, depending on usage.

General Cleaning and Storage

- Wipe the exterior of the vacuum cleaner with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners.
- Check the hose and attachments for blockages periodically.
- Store the vacuum cleaner in a cool, dry place. The compact design allows for easy storage.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
---------	----------------	----------

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Vacuum cleaner does not turn on.	Not plugged in. No power at outlet. Power button not pressed.	Ensure the power cord is securely plugged into a working outlet. Check the circuit breaker or try another outlet. Press the power button firmly.
Loss of suction.	Dust container is full. Filters are dirty or clogged. Hose or attachments are blocked.	Empty the dust container. Clean or replace the filters as per maintenance instructions. Check the hose, telescopic wand, and floor nozzle for any obstructions and remove them.
Unusual noise.	Blockage in the hose or nozzle. Motor issue (less common).	Turn off and unplug the vacuum. Check for and remove any blockages. If the noise persists after checking for blockages, contact customer support.


