1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the ISLANDSAFE Digital Electronic Lock Box. This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation of your new security safe. Please read these instructions carefully before use and retain them for future reference.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- Always keep the emergency keys in a secure location, separate from the safe and away from unauthorized access.
- Do not store the emergency keys inside the safe.
- Ensure the safe is securely mounted to prevent unauthorized removal.
- Replace batteries promptly when the low battery indicator appears to avoid being locked out.
- Avoid exposing the safe to extreme temperatures or moisture.

4. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The ISLANDSAFE Digital Electronic Lock Box QT features a robust design with multiple security and convenience elements.

Key Features:

- **Child-Safe Curved Steel Body:** Designed with smooth, rounded edges.
- **5mm Thick Pry-Resistant Door:** Enhances security against forced entry.
- **Dual Solid Steel Bolts:** Provides strong locking mechanism.
- **Removable Shelf:** Allows for flexible organization of contents.
- **Soft Interior Lining:** Protects delicate items from scratches.
- **Built-in LED Light:** Illuminates the interior for easy access in low light.
- **Protective Floor Pad:** Prevents damage to surfaces.
- **Dual Alarm System:** Activates after 3 incorrect passcode entries or violent shaking.

5. SETUP

5.1 Initial Opening and Battery Installation

1. Locate the emergency keyhole behind the keypad cover.
2. Insert one of the emergency keys into the keyhole and turn it counter-clockwise.
3. While holding the key, turn the knob clockwise to open the safe door.
4. Inside the safe, locate the battery compartment on the back of the door.
5. Insert 4 AA batteries (not included) into the compartment, ensuring correct polarity.
6. Close the battery compartment.

5.2 Mounting Instructions

The safe has pre-drilled mounting holes in the back for secure installation.

1. Choose a suitable location for mounting (e.g., wall or cabinet).
2. Mark the drilling points through the pre-drilled holes on the safe's back panel onto the mounting surface.
3. Drill pilot holes at the marked points.
4. Align the safe with the drilled holes and secure it using the provided expansion screws.
5. Ensure the safe is firmly attached and stable.

6. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1 Setting/Changing the Passcode

1. With the safe door open, press the red reset button located on the inside of the door (usually near the hinge). The indicator light on the keypad will flash.
2. Enter your desired 3-8 digit passcode on the keypad.
3. Press the '#' button to confirm. The indicator light will stop flashing, confirming the new passcode is set.

3 SECURE ACCESS MODES

Mode 1: Keypad Entry

1. Enter your 3-8 digit passcode.
2. Turn the knob clockwise within 5 seconds to unlock the safe.

Mode 2: Override Key

Use this mode if you forget your passcode or if the batteries are completely drained.

1. Remove the keypad cover to reveal the emergency keyhole.
2. Insert an emergency key and turn it counter-clockwise.
3. While holding the key, turn the knob clockwise to unlock.

Mode 3: Emergency Power

Use this mode if the batteries are dead and you do not have the override key readily available, or prefer to use the keypad.

1. Connect the emergency battery box to the external power port on the keypad.
2. Enter your passcode on the keypad.
3. Turn the knob clockwise to unlock.

6.3 Alarm System

The safe is equipped with a dual alarm system for enhanced security.

- **Incorrect Passcode Alarm:** If an incorrect passcode is entered 3 consecutive times, the alarm will sound for 60 seconds.
- **Vibration/Attack Alarm:** If the safe experiences violent shaking or an attempted attack, the alarm will sound for 60 seconds.

To silence the alarm, enter the correct passcode or use the emergency key to open the safe.

DUAL ALARM SYSTEM

The alarm will be triggered in case of 3 false passcode entry times or violent shaking.




Image 6.5: An illustration detailing the dual alarm system, which is triggered by three failed passcode entries or violent shaking, resulting in a 60-second audible alarm.

7. MAINTENANCE


- **Battery Replacement:** Replace the 4 AA batteries when the low battery indicator light illuminates on the keypad. Always use new, high-quality batteries.
- **Cleaning:** Wipe the exterior of the safe with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid using abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Interior:** The interior lining can be gently vacuumed or wiped with a dry cloth to remove dust.

- **Keypad:** Keep the keypad clean and dry. Avoid pressing buttons with excessive force.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

| Problem | Possible Cause | Solution |
|-----------------------------------|--|---|
| Safe does not open with passcode. | Incorrect passcode entered; Dead batteries; Knob not turned within 5 seconds. | Re-enter correct passcode; Replace batteries or use emergency battery box; Enter passcode and turn knob promptly. |
| Keypad is unresponsive. | Dead batteries. | Use emergency battery box or emergency key to open and replace batteries. |
| Alarm sounds unexpectedly. | 3 incorrect passcode entries; Safe was shaken or impacted. | Enter correct passcode or use emergency key to disarm. |
| Door does not close properly. | Obstruction in the door frame; Locking bolts are extended. | Check for obstructions and remove; Ensure knob is turned counter-clockwise to retract bolts before closing. |


