DEWALT 20V MAX Cordless Pruner (DCPR320D1) Instruction Manual

1. INTRODUCTION

The DEWALT 20V MAX Cordless Pruner (DCPR320D1) is a high-performance tool designed for efficient cutting of thick flower stems, branch limbs, and bush overgrowth. With a 1-1/2 inch cutting capacity, it offers a lightweight build to reduce hand strain, making pruning tasks significantly easier than manual methods. This pruner features non-stick coated blades for smooth cuts and an integrated LED for improved visibility in low-light conditions.

3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The DEWALT 20V MAX Cordless Pruner is engineered for durability and ease of use. Key features include:

- **Non-Stick Coated Blades:** Designed for smooth, swift cuts and reduced sap buildup.
- **1-1/2 Inch Cutting Capacity:** Capable of cutting branches up to 1.5 inches in diameter.
- **Integrated LED Work Light:** Illuminates the cutting area for improved visibility in dimly lit spaces.
- **Quick Blade Change Mechanism:** Allows for easy and convenient blade replacement using the included tool.
- **20V MAX* Battery Compatibility:** Utilizes DEWALT's 20V MAX* Lithium-Ion battery system for cordless operation.

4. SETUP

4.1 Battery Installation

1. Ensure the battery is fully charged before first use.
2. Align the battery pack with the battery port on the bottom of the pruner handle.
3. Slide the battery pack into the tool until it clicks securely into place.

4. To remove the battery, press the release button on the battery pack and slide it out.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Powering On/Off

1. To power on the pruner, press and hold the main trigger for approximately 3 seconds until the blades open and a beep is heard.
2. To power off the pruner, press and hold the main trigger for approximately 3 seconds until the blades close and a beep is heard.

5.2 Making a Cut

1. Position the open blades around the branch you wish to cut.
2. Ensure the branch is within the 1-1/2 inch cutting capacity.
3. Firmly press the main trigger to close the blades and make the cut. Release the trigger to open the blades for the next cut.
4. The integrated LED light will activate when the trigger is pulled, illuminating the cutting area.

6. MAINTENANCE

6.1 Blade Cleaning and Lubrication

Regularly clean and lubricate the blades to maintain optimal performance and extend their lifespan. Use a soft cloth to wipe away sap and debris. Apply a few drops of lubricating oil to the blades after each use, especially after cutting resinous wood.

6.2 Blade Replacement

The pruner is designed for quick blade changes. Refer to the included change tool and follow these general steps:

1. Ensure the pruner is powered off and the battery is removed.
2. Use the provided Allen wrench to loosen and remove the retaining screw on the blade.
3. Carefully remove the old blade.
4. Position the new blade, ensuring it aligns correctly with the mechanism.
5. Reinsert and tighten the retaining screw firmly.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Tool not powering on:** Ensure the battery is fully charged and properly seated in the tool. Check for any debris obstructing the battery terminals.
- **Blades not cutting effectively:** The blades may be dull or dirty. Clean and lubricate the blades. If dull, replace them following the blade replacement instructions.

- **Tool stops during operation:** This may indicate a low battery charge or an overload condition. Recharge the battery or reduce the size of the branches being cut.
