INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the HONEY JOY 55" Kids Trampoline with Safety Enclosure Net. This manual provides essential information for the safe assembly, operation, and maintenance of your trampoline. Please read all instructions carefully before use to ensure the safety of the user and the longevity of the product. Keep this manual for future reference.

SAFETY INFORMATION

Your child's safety is paramount. Adhere to the following safety guidelines at all times:

- **Adult Supervision Required:** Always ensure an adult supervises children using the trampoline.
- **Age and Weight Limits:** This trampoline is suitable for children aged 3 to 6 years old. The maximum weight limit is 45 kg (99 lbs). Do not exceed this limit.
- **One Jumper at a Time:** Only one child should use the trampoline at any given time to prevent collisions and injuries.
- **Clearance Area:** Ensure adequate overhead clearance and a clear perimeter around the trampoline. Keep objects, furniture, and other children away from the trampoline during use.
- **Proper Entry and Exit:** Children should enter and exit the trampoline through the designated zippered opening. Do not jump onto or off the trampoline.
- **No Somersaults or Flips:** Avoid somersaults, flips, or other dangerous maneuvers that can lead to serious injury.
- **Inspect Before Each Use:** Before each use, check the trampoline for any loose, damaged, or missing parts. Do not use if any components are compromised.
- **Weather Conditions:** Do not use the trampoline in wet, windy, or stormy conditions. High winds can lift the trampoline.
- **Lower Enclosure Net:** The lower enclosure net is designed to prevent small children or objects from entering the area beneath the jumping mat. Ensure it is properly secured.

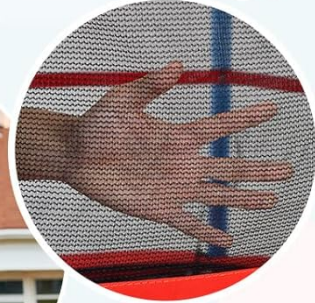
SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

Assembly requires adult supervision. Ensure all parts are present before beginning. Refer to the included instruction manual for detailed diagrams.

1. **Unpack Components:** Carefully remove all parts from the packaging and lay them out on a clean, flat surface. Verify all components are present according to the parts list in the separate instruction manual.
2. **Assemble the Base Frame:** Connect the steel frame tubes to form the hexagonal base. Ensure all connections are secure.
3. **Attach Jumping Mat:** Carefully attach the jumping mat to the frame using the provided bungee cords. Ensure even tension around the entire perimeter.
4. **Install Safety Poles:** Insert the foam-padded safety poles into the designated slots on the frame. Secure them firmly.
5. **Attach Enclosure Net:** Drape the safety enclosure net over the poles and secure it to the top of the poles and the jumping mat. Ensure the zipper opening is correctly positioned.

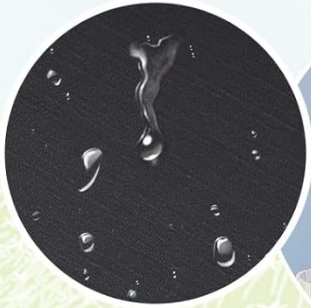
6. **Install Lower Enclosure Net:** Attach the lower enclosure net to the bottom of the frame to prevent access underneath the jumping mat.
7. **Final Inspection:** Double-check all connections, bolts, and fasteners to ensure they are tight and secure before allowing use.

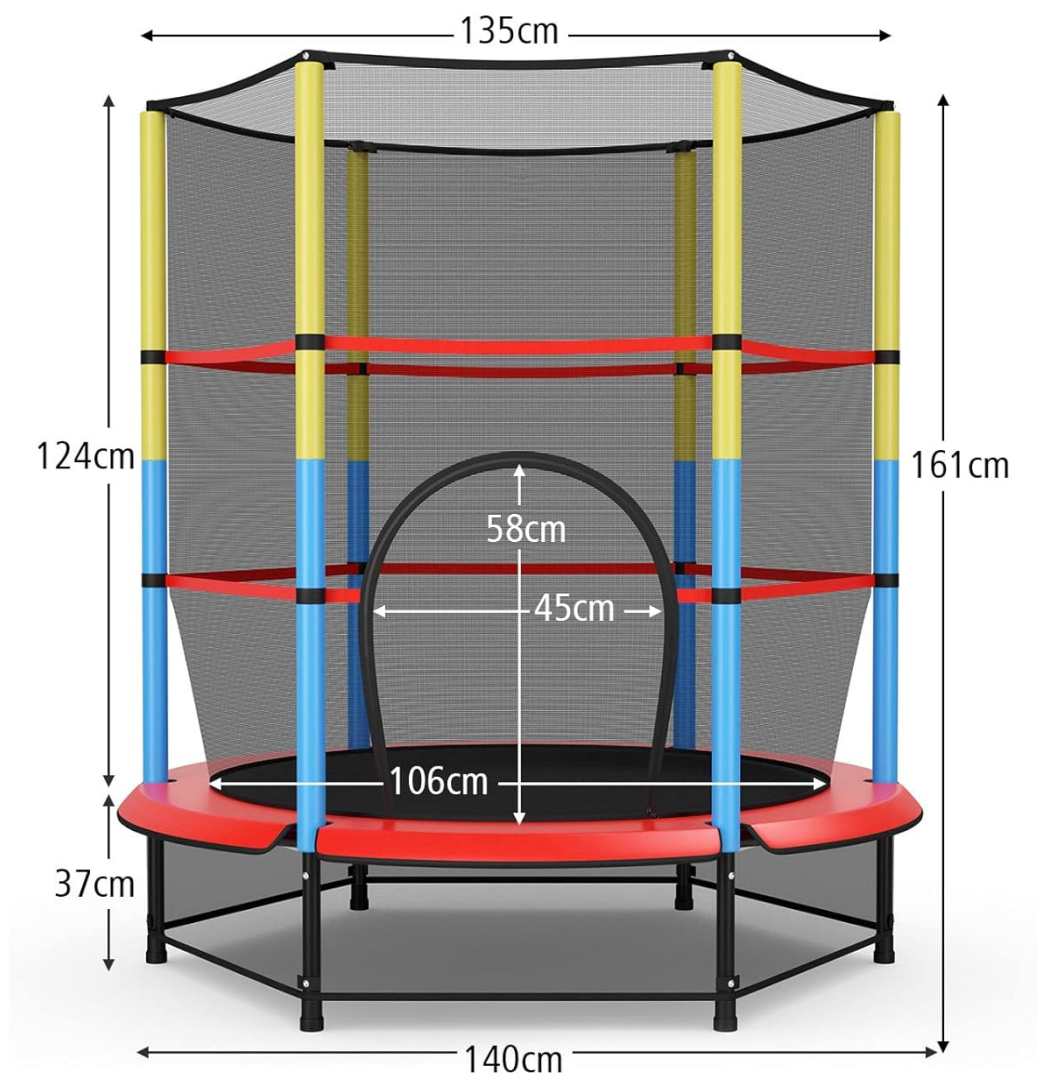

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

To ensure a safe and enjoyable experience, follow these operating guidelines:

- **Supervision:** Always ensure an adult is present and actively supervising children using the trampoline.
- **Entry and Exit:** Instruct children to use the zippered entrance to get on and off the trampoline. Do not allow them to climb over the net or frame.
- **Jumping Technique:** Encourage children to jump in the center of the mat. Avoid jumping too high or attempting stunts.
- **Safety Enclosure Net:** The 360-degree fence net and soft foam padded poles are designed for safety. Ensure the net is always zipped closed during use.
- **Footwear:** For best grip and safety, children should use the trampoline barefoot or with appropriate non-slip socks.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the safety and longevity of your trampoline.

- **Cleaning:** The PP and PE jump mat is waterproof and tear-resistant, allowing for easy wipe cleaning with a damp cloth and mild soap. Avoid harsh chemicals.
- **Frame Inspection:** Periodically check the steel tube frame for any signs of rust, bends, or damage. Ensure all connections remain tight.
- **Net and Padding Check:** Inspect the safety enclosure net, foam padding on the poles, and the safety pad covering the bungee cords for tears, holes, or deterioration. Replace damaged parts immediately.
- **Bungee Cords:** Check the bungee cords for wear, fraying, or loss of elasticity. Replace if necessary to maintain optimal bounce and safety.
- **Storage:** If possible, store the trampoline indoors during prolonged periods of non-use or severe weather to protect it from the elements.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Refer to the table below for common issues and their solutions.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Trampoline feels unstable or wobbly.	Loose frame connections or uneven ground.	Tighten all frame bolts and ensure the trampoline is placed on a flat, level surface.
Jumping mat has reduced bounce.	Worn or stretched bungee cords.	Inspect bungee cords for damage or loss of elasticity. Replace worn cords.
Safety net is sagging or torn.	Damaged net or loose attachments.	Check net for tears. Ensure all fasteners and zippers are secure. Replace the net if significantly damaged.
Noise during jumping.	Loose frame connections or friction.	Tighten all frame bolts. Ensure anti-slip foot mats are in place. The premium bungee cords are designed for silent operation, but check for any rubbing parts.
