SETUP GUIDE

Follow these steps to assemble and set up your Donner DED-70 Electric Drum Set.

1. Unpacking and Component Identification

- 3 x 8" Rubber Cymbal Pads

2. Assembling the Drum Rack






Image: A user connecting a portable power bank to the DED-70 drum set, illustrating its portable charging capability.

1. Sound Module Overview


The sound module is the central control unit. It features buttons for power, kit selection, volume control, and metronome/play functions.




Image: The DED-70 drum set with dimensions shown, highlighting the "Silent Mode Easy for Neighbors" feature when using headphones.

MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance will extend the life of your drum set.

- Cleaning: Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe down the pads, cymbals, module, and frame. Avoid abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Storage:** When not in use, store the drum set in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. The adjustable folding design allows for easy storage in limited space.
- Cable Management: Keep cables neatly organized to prevent tangling and damage.
- Pad Tension: The mesh drum heads can be adjusted for tension. Use a drum key (not included) to tighten or loosen the tension rods around the rim of the pads for desired feel.



| No Sound | Power not connected or turned on. Headphones/speaker not properly connected. Volume too low. Cable from pad to module loose. | Ensure power adapter is securely plugged in and module is powered on. Check headphone/speaker connection to the correct port. Increase the volume on the module. Verify all pad cables are firmly connected to the module. |
| Inconsistent Pad Response | Loose cable connection.Pad tension too loose or too tight. | Check and secure all cables from pads to module. Adjust the tension of the mesh drum heads. |
| Pedal Not Responding | Pedal cable loose or disconnected. | Ensure the pedal cable is securely connected to the module. |
