SAFETY INFORMATION

Wall Fixing: For safety, this product includes hardware for wall attachment. It is recommended to secure the shelf unit to a wall to prevent tipping, especially in households with children or pets. Always use appropriate screws and wall plugs for your wall material.

Indoor Use: This product is recommended for indoor use only.

Weight Capacity: Do not exceed the maximum load capacity of 33 kg per shelf to ensure stability and prevent damage.

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

The OMAR shelf unit is designed for straightforward assembly. Follow the steps below for proper setup.

- Unpack Components:** Carefully unpack all parts and check against the included parts list to ensure everything is present.
- Assemble Frame:** Connect the posts according to the diagram. Ensure all connections are secure.
- Install Shelves:** Place the shelves at your desired height. The shelves are adjustable, allowing you to customize the storage space. Ensure shelves are firmly seated on the support pins.
- Adjust Feet:** Adjust the height of the feet to level the unit on uneven floors. Turn the feet clockwise or counter-clockwise until the unit is stable.
- Wall Attachment:** Use the provided safety hardware to secure the unit to a wall. This step is crucial for stability and safety.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The OMAR shelf unit is designed for organized storage. Its open design allows for easy visibility and access to stored items.

- **Adjusting Shelves:** To adjust shelf height, remove items from the shelf, lift the shelf, reposition the support pins to the desired slots on the posts, and then re-seat the shelf.
- **Placement:** The galvanized finish makes this unit suitable for areas with higher humidity, such as kitchens or washrooms.
- **Customization:** The OMAR series offers various storage accessories (sold separately) that can be combined with this unit to customize your storage solution.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

To maintain the condition of your OMAR shelf unit, follow these care instructions:

- **Cleaning:** Wipe clean with a soft cloth dampened with water and a mild dishwashing detergent or soap, if necessary.
- **Drying:** Wipe dry with a clean cloth.
- **Avoid Abrasives:** Do not use abrasive cleaners or scouring pads, as they can damage the galvanized surface.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Unit is Unstable:** Ensure the adjustable feet are properly leveled. If the unit is still unstable, verify that all connections are tightened and consider securing it to a wall using the provided hardware.
- **Difficulty Assembling:** Refer to the assembly diagrams provided with the product. Ensure all parts are

correctly oriented before tightening.
