1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the NETVUE Outdoor Security Camera. This manual provides detailed instructions for setting up, operating, and maintaining your camera to ensure optimal performance and security for your property. This camera offers 1080P Full HD video, 360° pan-tilt surveillance, motion detection, color night vision, two-way audio, and is compatible with Alexa.

2. PRODUCT FEATURES

- **1080P Full HD & Color Night Vision:** Equipped with an advanced CMOS sensor and spotlight, providing clear, properly exposed video. Offers optional color or infrared night vision, automatically switching in low light.
- **Pan-Tilt 360° Surveillance & Digital Zoom:** Achieve a comprehensive view with 355° horizontal pan and 90° vertical tilt capabilities, along with digital zoom for detailed monitoring.
- **Intelligent Motion Detection & Real-time Alarm:** Supports custom motion detection areas and sensitivity. Sends real-time notifications to your app upon activity detection, minimizing false alarms.
- **IP66 Weatherproof Design:** Built to withstand harsh weather conditions, operating reliably in temperatures from -4°F to 122°F (-20°C to 50°C).
- **Enhanced Connectivity:** Features 5dBi dual antennas for a more stable 2.4GHz Wi-Fi connection. (Note: Not

compatible with 5GHz Wi-Fi networks).

- **Two-Way Audio:** Communicate directly through the camera with built-in microphone and speaker.
- **Flexible Storage Options:** Supports local storage via Micro SD card (up to 128GB, Class 10, not included) and optional cloud storage services (subscription required).
- **Alexa Compatibility:** Seamlessly integrate with Amazon Alexa for voice control and smart home automation.

4. SETUP GUIDE

4.1 Initial Setup and App Connection

1. **Download the Netvue App:** Search for "Netvue" in your smartphone's app store (iOS or Android) and download the official application.
2. **Create an Account:** Open the Netvue app and follow the on-screen instructions to create a new user account or log in if you already have one.
3. **Power On the Camera:** Connect the camera to a power source using the provided power adapter. The camera will initiate its startup sequence.
4. **Add Device:** In the Netvue app, tap the "+" icon to add a new device. Select your camera model from the list.
5. **Connect to 2.4GHz Wi-Fi:** Ensure your smartphone is connected to a 2.4GHz Wi-Fi network. The camera only supports 2.4GHz Wi-Fi. Enter your Wi-Fi password in the app.
6. **Scan QR Code:** The app will generate a QR code. Hold your camera approximately 4-8 inches (10-20 cm) in front of your phone screen until you hear a confirmation sound from the camera.
7. **Complete Setup:** Follow any remaining prompts in the app to complete the pairing process. Once connected, you can name your camera and begin live viewing.




Figure 2: Quick Setup Process

4.2 Mounting the Camera

The NETVUE Outdoor Security Camera supports both wall-mounted and roof-mounted installations.

- 1. Choose a Location:** Select a location that provides the desired viewing angle and has access to a power outlet. Ensure the Wi-Fi signal is strong at the chosen spot.
- 2. Mark Drill Holes:** Use the provided mounting template to mark the positions for drilling on the wall or ceiling.
- 3. Drill Holes:** Drill holes at the marked positions and insert the wall anchors if mounting on masonry or drywall.
- 4. Secure the Mount:** Attach the camera's mounting bracket to the wall or ceiling using the provided screws.
- 5. Attach the Camera:** Securely attach the camera to the mounting bracket. Adjust the camera's angle as needed.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Live View and Pan-Tilt-Zoom (PTZ) Control

Access the live feed of your camera through the Netvue app. Use the on-screen controls to pan horizontally (355°), tilt vertically (90°), and digitally zoom to focus on specific areas.




Figure 4: 360° All-Round View with Pan-Tilt Control

5.2 Motion Detection and Alerts

The camera can detect motion and send instant alerts to your phone. You can customize the detection area and sensitivity within the app to reduce unwanted notifications.

- **Setting Detection Zones:** In the app settings, define specific areas within the camera's view where motion detection should be active.
- **Adjusting Sensitivity:** Modify the motion detection sensitivity to suit your environment and minimize false alarms from minor movements.
- **Receiving Alerts:** Ensure app notifications are enabled on your smartphone to receive real-time alerts when motion is detected.

5.3 Two-Way Audio

Use the two-way audio feature to communicate with visitors or deter intruders directly through the camera. Tap the microphone icon in the live view to speak, and listen through the camera's speaker.

5.4 Night Vision Modes

The camera offers both infrared (black and white) and full-color night vision modes. The spotlight can be activated to achieve color night vision in low-light conditions.

- **Infrared Mode:** Automatically activates in very low light, providing clear black and white video.
- **Color Mode:** Can be manually activated or set to trigger with motion detection, utilizing the built-in spotlight for full-color video at night.

5.5 Storage Options

Your NETVUE camera offers two primary storage methods for recorded footage:

- **Micro SD Card Storage:** Insert a Class 10 Micro SD card (up to 128GB, not included) into the camera's designated slot for local recording. This option does not require monthly fees.
- **Cloud Storage:** Subscribe to Netvue's cloud service for secure, remote storage of your video recordings. This provides access to footage from anywhere and offers additional AI recognition features.

6. MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Regularly wipe the camera lens with a soft, dry cloth to ensure clear image quality. Do not use harsh chemicals.
- **Firmware Updates:** Keep your camera's firmware updated through the Netvue app to ensure optimal performance, security, and access to new features.
- **Power Supply:** Ensure the power connection is secure and free from damage.
- **Weather Protection:** While IP66 weatherproof, avoid directing high-pressure water jets directly at the camera.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Camera offline or frequently disconnects	Weak Wi-Fi signal; Incorrect Wi-Fi band (5GHz); Network interference.	Ensure camera is within Wi-Fi range. Verify your router is broadcasting a 2.4GHz network. Reduce interference by moving router or camera. Restart camera and router.
Cannot complete initial setup	Incorrect Wi-Fi password; Not connected to 2.4GHz Wi-Fi; QR code not scanned properly.	Double-check Wi-Fi password. Confirm your phone is on 2.4GHz Wi-Fi. Ensure QR code is clear and held at the correct distance (4-8 inches). Try resetting the camera.
Poor image quality	Dirty lens; Insufficient lighting; Network bandwidth issues.	Clean the camera lens. Ensure adequate lighting for daytime. Check your internet speed.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Motion detection not working or too many false alarms	Incorrect sensitivity settings; Detection zone not configured.	Adjust motion detection sensitivity in the app. Configure specific detection zones to exclude irrelevant areas (e.g., busy roads, swaying trees).
Two-way audio not functioning	Microphone/speaker muted in app; Network latency.	Check app settings to ensure microphone and speaker are enabled. Verify network connection stability.


