1. Introduction




Figure 4.1: Front view of the Wiko T50 smartphone, showcasing its large display and front camera.

Key Components:

- **Display:** 6.6-inch FHD+ borderless display for immersive viewing.
- Cameras: 64MP AI Triple Camera system on the rear, featuring a 120-degree ultra-wide angle lens. Front camera for selfies and video calls.
- Buttons: Power button and volume rocker located on the right side for easy access.
- Ports: USB port for charging and data transfer.
- SIM Tray: Dual SIM support for flexible connectivity.

5. SETUP

5.1 Inserting SIM Cards

- 1. Locate the SIM tray on the left side of the device.
- 2. Use the provided SIM ejector tool to open the tray.
- 3. Carefully place your Nano-SIM cards into the designated slots. Ensure the gold contacts are facing down.
- 4. Gently push the SIM tray back into the slot until it clicks into place.

5.2 Charging the Battery

- 1. Connect the charger to the USB port at the bottom of your Wiko T50.
- 2. Plug the charger into a power outlet.
- 3. The device supports 40W fast charging. The battery indicator on the screen will show charging progress.
- 4. Once fully charged, disconnect the charger.

5.3 Powering On/Off

- To Power On: Press and hold the Power button on the right side until the Wiko logo appears.
- To Power Off: Press and hold the Power button, then select 'Power off' from the options on the screen.

6. OPERATING

6.1 Basic Navigation (Android 11.0)

- Touchscreen: Navigate the device using touch gestures such as tap, swipe, pinch-to-zoom.
- Home Screen: The central hub for your apps and widgets.
- Notifications: Swipe down from the top of the screen to view notifications and quick settings.
- App Drawer: Swipe up from the bottom of the screen to access all installed applications.

6.2 Camera Usage

Your Wiko T50 features a 64MP Al Triple Camera system.

- 1. Open the Camera application from your home screen or app drawer.
- 2. Select your desired mode (Photo, Video, Portrait, Pro, etc.).
- 3. Tap the shutter button to capture a photo or start/stop recording a video.
- 4. Switch between the main lens and the 120-degree ultra-wide lens for different perspectives.

6.3 Connectivity

- Wi-Fi: Go to Settings > Network & internet > Wi-Fi to connect to available Wi-Fi networks.
- **Bluetooth:** Go to Settings > Connected devices > Connection preferences > Bluetooth to pair with Bluetooth devices.
- Mobile Data (4G LTE): Ensure your SIM card is active and mobile data is enabled in Settings > Network & internet > Mobile network.
- USB: Connect your device to a computer using a USB cable for file transfer or charging.

7. MAINTENANCE

- Cleaning: Use a soft, lint-free cloth to clean the screen and body of the device. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.
- **Software Updates:** Regularly check for and install software updates to ensure optimal performance and security. Go to Settings > System > System update.
- **Battery Care:** To prolong battery life, avoid fully discharging the battery frequently. Charge the device before the battery level drops too low.
- **Storage Management:** Periodically clear unnecessary files and apps to free up storage space and maintain device speed.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

Here are solutions to common issues you might encounter:

Problem	Solution
Device does not power on	Ensure the battery is charged. Connect the charger and wait a few minutes before attempting to power on again.
Battery drains quickly	Close unused apps, reduce screen brightness, disable Wi-Fi/Bluetooth when not in use. Check for background app activity.
Cannot connect to Wi-Fi	Restart your Wi-Fi router and the phone. Ensure you have entered the correct Wi-Fi password.

Problem	Solution
Apps are crashing or freezing	Restart the device. Clear the cache of the problematic app (Settings > Apps > [App Name] > Storage & cache > Clear cache).
No network signal	Ensure SIM card is properly inserted. Check if airplane mode is off. Try restarting the device. Contact your network provider if the issue persists.
