1. INTRODUCTION

Welcome to the instruction manual for your new Nasitip Kids Ride On Tractor with Green Trailer. This 12V battery-powered electric vehicle is designed to provide an engaging and realistic driving experience for toddlers, featuring a slow start function, 7-LED headlights, a USB music player, and a 2+1 gear shift system. The included detachable green trailer adds to the fun, allowing children to transport toys and other items. This manual provides essential information for assembly, operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting to ensure safe and enjoyable use of the product.

2. IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

WARNING: To reduce the risk of injury, adult supervision is required. Never use in roadways, near motor vehicles, on or near steep inclines or steps, swimming pools or other bodies of water. Always wear shoes, and never allow more than one rider.

- This product is certified by ASTM F963 CPSIA CPC, ensuring compliance with safety standards.
- Always ensure the child is securely fastened with the adjustable seat belt before operation.
- Utilize the slow start function for gentle acceleration, preventing sudden jolts.
- The parental remote control allows adults to override child control for added safety, especially for younger users.
- Recommended age for use is 36 months to 6 years.
- Maximum weight capacity is 66 lbs. Do not exceed this limit.
- Operate the tractor on flat, dry surfaces. Avoid uneven terrain, slopes, or wet conditions.
- Keep hands, hair, and loose clothing away from moving parts.
- Regularly inspect the vehicle for any damage or loose parts before each use.

4. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

4.1. Rear Wheel Assembly

Attach the rear wheels to the axle. Ensure all washers and hubcaps are securely fastened.

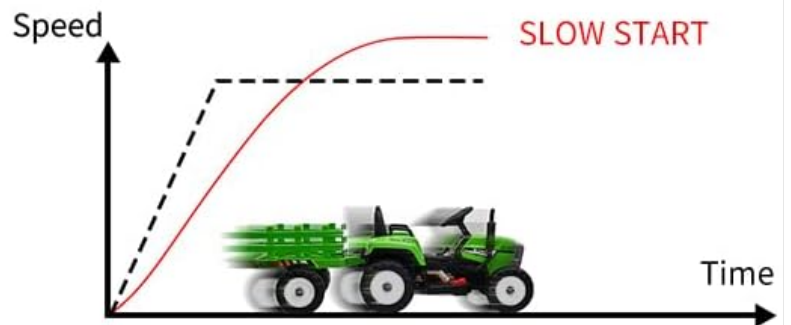

4.4. Detachable Trailer Assembly

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Your Nasitip Kids Ride On Tractor offers both manual and parental remote control options for versatile play.

5.1. Manual Control

- **Power On/Off:** Press the red power button on the control panel to turn the tractor on or off.
- **Foot Pedal:** Press the foot pedal to accelerate. The slow start function ensures a smooth takeoff.
- **Gear Shift:** Use the 2+1 gear shift lever to select High speed, Low speed, or Reverse.
- **Steering Wheel:** Turn the steering wheel to control direction.
- **Horn:** Press the button on the steering wheel to activate the horn.
- **Headlights:** Press the light button on the control panel to turn the 7-LED headlights on or off.

5.2. Parental Remote Control

The 2.4G remote control allows parents to steer, control speed, and stop the tractor. This is ideal for younger children or for guiding the vehicle in challenging areas.

- **Pairing:** Follow the instructions in the remote control manual to pair it with the tractor.
- **Directional Control:** Use the joystick or directional buttons to move the tractor forward, backward, left, and right.
- **Speed Selection:** Adjust the speed settings on the remote (if applicable) to match your child's skill level and terrain.

- **Emergency Stop:** The remote control typically includes an emergency stop button for immediate halting of the vehicle.

5.3. Music Player and Bluetooth Function

The built-in music player enhances the ride with pre-loaded tunes or your child's favorite songs.

- **USB/TF Card:** Insert a USB drive or TF card into the designated port to play MP3 audio files.
- **Bluetooth:** Activate Bluetooth on the tractor's control panel and pair it with your mobile device to stream music wirelessly.
- **Volume Control:** Adjust the volume using the buttons on the control panel.

6. MAINTENANCE

6.1. Charging the Battery

To ensure optimal performance and battery life, follow these charging guidelines:

- Connect the charger to the charging port on the tractor.
- Plug the charger into a standard wall outlet.
- Charge the battery for 8-12 hours before first use and after each play session. Do not overcharge.
- The battery indicator on the control panel will show the current charge level.
- If the tractor will not be used for an extended period, charge the battery monthly to maintain its health.

6.2. Cleaning and Storage

- Wipe the tractor with a damp cloth to clean. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- Store the tractor in a dry, cool place away from direct sunlight and moisture.
- Protect the vehicle from extreme temperatures.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Tractor does not move.	Battery is low or not connected.	Charge the battery for 8-12 hours. Check battery connections.
Tractor moves slowly.	Low battery charge; operating on uneven terrain; overloaded.	Recharge battery. Move to a smoother surface. Reduce load (ensure rider is within weight limit).
Remote control not working.	Remote batteries are dead; remote not paired.	Replace remote batteries. Re-pair the remote control according to its manual.
Pedal stuck or unresponsive.	Debris or dirt obstructing the pedal switch.	Carefully inspect and clean the pedal area and switch. If issue persists, contact support.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Lights not working.	Light switch is off; loose connection.	Ensure the light switch is on. Check for any loose wiring connections to the lights.
