1. IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read this manual thoroughly before installation and operation. Keep this manual in a safe place for future reference.

- This device is designed to detect both smoke and carbon monoxide.
- Installation should be performed by a qualified electrician if you are not familiar with electrical wiring.
- Do not paint the device. Paint can clog the openings and interfere with sensor operation.
- Test the alarm weekly to ensure proper function.
- Replace the 9V backup battery annually, or when the low battery warning sounds.

2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The X-Sense XP04 is a hardwired combination smoke and carbon monoxide detector designed for comprehensive home safety. It features advanced photoelectric smoke and electrochemical CO sensors for accurate detection.

This detector is AC powered and includes a replaceable 9V battery backup, ensuring continuous monitoring even during power outages. It can be interconnected with up to 18 compatible X-Sense hardwired alarms, providing full coverage throughout your home.

3. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

The X-Sense XP04 detector is designed for easy installation. All necessary mounting hardware is included.

Installation Steps:

1. **Prepare the Mounting Location:** Ensure the power is off at the circuit breaker before beginning installation. Select a location in accordance with local codes and the provided guidelines.
2. **Install the Mounting Bracket:** Secure the mounting bracket to the ceiling or wall using the provided screws and anchor plugs.
3. **Connect Wiring:** Connect the AC hardwired cables (black, white, red) to your household wiring. The red wire is for interconnection with other compatible alarms.
4. **Install Battery Backup:** Insert the 9V backup battery into the battery compartment.
5. **Attach Detector:** Align the detector with the mounting bracket and twist clockwise until it locks securely into place.
6. **Restore Power:** Turn on the power at the circuit breaker. The detector will perform a self-test.

Interconnection for Full Coverage

This detector supports interconnection with up to 18 X-Sense 2-in-1 hardwired alarms. When one interconnected alarm is triggered, all connected alarms will sound simultaneously, providing early warning throughout your home.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

LED Indicator Status:

- **Green LED:** Indicates normal operation and AC power.
- **Yellow LED:** Indicates a fault or low battery condition.
- **Red LED:** Indicates an alarm (smoke or carbon monoxide detected).

Testing the Alarm:

Press and hold the 'Test/Silence' button located on the center of the detector. The alarm will sound, and the LED indicator will flash. Release the button to stop the test. Test the alarm weekly.

Silencing the Alarm:

In case of a non-emergency alarm (e.g., cooking fumes), press the 'Test/Silence' button to temporarily silence the alarm. The alarm will automatically reset after a few minutes if the air clears. If the hazard persists, the alarm will reactivate.

5. MAINTENANCE

Battery Replacement:

The 9V backup battery should be replaced annually. When the battery is low, the detector will chirp and the yellow LED will flash. To replace the battery:

- 1. Twist the detector counter-clockwise to remove it from the mounting bracket.
- 2. Open the battery compartment.
- 3. Remove the old 9V battery and insert a new one, ensuring correct polarity.
- 4. Close the battery compartment and reattach the detector to the mounting bracket by twisting clockwise.
- 5. Test the alarm after battery replacement.

Cleaning:

Clean your detector at least once a month to remove dust and debris. Use a soft brush or a vacuum cleaner with a soft brush attachment to clean the vents and cover. Do not use water, cleaners, or solvents.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Alarm chirps periodically (Yellow LED flashes)	Low battery	Replace the 9V backup battery.
Alarm sounds without apparent smoke/CO	Dust, high humidity, cooking fumes, or chemical vapors	Clean the detector, ventilate the area, or relocate if false alarms persist due to environmental factors.
Alarm does not sound during test	No power, faulty battery, or device malfunction	Check AC power, replace battery, or contact customer support if issues persist.
Red LED flashes, but no alarm sound	Faulty speaker or internal malfunction	Contact customer support for assistance.
