PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Igloo Dual Purpose Ice Cube Maker & Dispensing Shaver is designed to provide both ice cubes and shaved ice for various needs. Its sleek stainless steel and black design integrates well into any setting, from kitchen countertops to home bars and RVs. The unit features user-friendly touch controls and indicator lights for ease of use, signaling when the ice basket is full or when water needs to be added. An optional water line hookup allows for continuous ice production without manual refilling.

SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read all instructions carefully before operating this appliance. Keep this manual for future reference. Always follow basic safety precautions to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, and injury to persons.

- Ensure the appliance is connected to a properly grounded electrical outlet.
- Do not immerse the appliance, cord, or plug in water or other liquids.
- Unplug from the outlet when not in use, before cleaning, or if a malfunction occurs.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug, or after the appliance malfunctions or has been damaged in any manner.
- Keep hands and utensils out of the ice maker during operation to prevent injury.
- Use only potable water in the appliance.
- This appliance is for household use only.

SETUP

Unpacking and Placement

1. Carefully remove all packaging materials and inspect the unit for any damage.
2. Place the ice maker on a flat, stable, and level surface away from direct sunlight and heat sources. Ensure there is adequate ventilation around the unit.
3. Allow the unit to stand upright for at least 2 hours before plugging it in, especially if it was transported on its side. This allows the refrigerant to settle.

Initial Cleaning

- Before first use, clean the interior of the ice maker with a soft cloth and warm, soapy water. Rinse thoroughly.
- Drain any residual water using the water drain plug located at the bottom of the unit.

Water Filling Methods

The Igloo Ice Maker offers two ways to supply water:

- **Manual Fill:** Open the lid and pour potable water directly into the water reservoir up to the MAX fill line.
- **Water Line Hookup (Optional):** For continuous ice production, connect a water line to the "Water Inlet" port on the back of the unit. Refer to the detailed diagram for proper connection.

OPERATION

Making Ice Cubes

1. Ensure the water reservoir is filled.
2. Plug the unit into a grounded electrical outlet.
3. Press the "ICE" button on the control panel. The indicator light will illuminate.
4. The ice maker will begin producing ice cubes. The first batch may take slightly longer. Subsequent batches will be ready in approximately 7-15 minutes.
5. When the "ICE FULL" indicator light illuminates, the ice basket is full, and the unit will pause ice production. Remove ice to resume.
6. If the "ADD WATER" indicator light illuminates, the water reservoir is low. Refill water to continue ice production.

Making Shaved Ice

1. Ensure ice cubes are available in the ice basket.
2. Open the small door on the front of the unit where the shaved ice dispenses.
3. Place a glass or container under the shaved ice chute.
4. Press the "SHAVED ICE" button on the control panel. The unit will begin shaving ice and dispensing it into your container.
5. Release the button when you have the desired amount of shaved ice.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning the Unit

- Always unplug the unit before cleaning.
- Regularly clean the interior with a soft cloth and a mild detergent. Rinse thoroughly and dry.
- For thorough cleaning, remove the ice basket and clean it separately.
- Drain the water from the reservoir using the water drain plug at the bottom of the unit.

- Clean the exterior with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals.

Storage

If the ice maker will not be used for an extended period, ensure it is thoroughly cleaned and dried. Drain all water from the reservoir. Store the unit in a cool, dry place.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you experience issues with your Igloo Ice Maker, please consult the following common troubleshooting steps:

- **Unit not turning on:** Check if the power cord is securely plugged into a grounded outlet. Ensure the outlet is functioning.
- **"ADD WATER" indicator is on:** The water reservoir is low. Refill with potable water.
- **"ICE FULL" indicator is on:** The ice basket is full. Remove ice to resume production.
- **Ice is not forming or is too soft:**
 - Ensure the room temperature is within the recommended operating range (typically 50°F to 90°F).
 - Check if the water reservoir is adequately filled.
 - Ensure there is proper ventilation around the unit.
 - Clean the unit as per maintenance instructions.
- **Unusual noise:** This could be normal operational sounds (compressor, water pump). If the noise is excessive or unusual, unplug the unit and contact customer support.
