Velvac 022050 Saddle Muffler Clamp 2 1/2 Inch Instruction Manual

1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the proper installation, use, and maintenance of the Velvac 022050 Saddle Muffler Clamp, designed for 2 1/2 inch exhaust systems. Please read this manual thoroughly before proceeding with installation to ensure safe and effective operation.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

WARNING:

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Verify that all components are present before beginning installation:

4. INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps for proper installation of the saddle muffler clamp:

1. **Prepare the Exhaust System:** Ensure the exhaust pipes to be joined or clamped are clean and free of rust or debris. If replacing an old clamp, remove it completely.
2. **Position the Clamp:** Slide the U-bolt over the exhaust pipe(s) at the desired clamping location. The saddle portion of the clamp should rest against the pipe(s) on the opposite side of the U-bolt.
3. **Align Components:** If joining two pipes, ensure they are properly aligned and seated before tightening the clamp. The clamp should bridge the joint evenly.
4. **Install Nuts:** Thread the nuts onto the ends of the U-bolt. Hand-tighten them initially to hold the clamp in place.
5. **Tighten the Clamp:** Using an appropriate wrench, gradually tighten the nuts evenly. Alternate between nuts to ensure even pressure distribution. Do not overtighten. The clamp should be snug enough to prevent movement and exhaust leaks, but not so tight as to deform the pipes.
6. **Verify Security:** After tightening, gently attempt to move the clamped pipes to ensure a secure connection. Check for any signs of exhaust leaks.

5. OPERATION AND FUNCTION

The Velvac 022050 Saddle Muffler Clamp is designed to create a secure, leak-free connection between exhaust pipes or to secure a muffler to an exhaust pipe. Its saddle design distributes clamping force evenly, minimizing pipe distortion while providing a strong hold. Once properly installed, the clamp functions passively to maintain the integrity of the exhaust

system connection.

6. MAINTENANCE

Regular inspection of the muffler clamp is recommended to ensure continued performance:

- **Visual Inspection:** Periodically check the clamp for signs of rust, corrosion, or damage. Ensure the nuts are still tight and the clamp is securely holding the exhaust components.
- **Tightness Check:** If any looseness is detected, re-tighten the nuts evenly. Avoid overtightening.
- **Replacement:** If the clamp shows significant signs of wear, corrosion, or damage, it should be replaced immediately to prevent exhaust leaks or component separation.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Exhaust Leak:** If an exhaust leak is detected around the clamp, first ensure the nuts are tightened evenly and sufficiently. If the leak persists, inspect the clamp and pipes for damage or improper fit. Replacement of the clamp or adjustment of the pipes may be necessary.
- **Clamp Loosening:** Over time, vibrations can cause fasteners to loosen. Regularly check the tightness of the nuts. If loosening is a recurring issue, consider using thread-locking compound on the nuts (ensure it is suitable for high-temperature applications).
