# 1. Introduction

This manual provides essential instructions for the proper setup, operation, and maintenance of your Shark ION P50, IC160, or IC162 series cordless upright vacuum charging dock. This is a genuine Shark OEM replacement part, Part Number XCRGFD160, designed to ensure compatibility and optimal performance with your specified Shark vacuum models. The charging dock provides a dedicated space for charging your vacuum and storing up to three accessories.

- Use only with the specified Shark ION P50, IC160, and IC162 series cordless upright vacuums.
- Do not use outdoors or on wet surfaces.
- Always disconnect the charging cable from the power outlet before cleaning or performing any maintenance.
- Do not handle the charging cable or dock with wet hands.
- · Keep the charging dock away from heat sources and direct sunlight.
- Ensure the charging cable (not included) is not damaged before use.

## 3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Verify that your package contains the following item:

• Shark ION P50 Series Charging Dock (Part Number XCRGFD160)

**Note:** The charging cable required to power the dock is not included with this replacement part. Please use the original charging cable provided with your Shark ION P50, IC160, or IC162 vacuum.

# 4. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Unpack the Dock: Carefully remove the charging dock from its packaging.
- 2. **Choose a Location:** Select a flat, stable, and dry surface near a standard electrical outlet. Ensure there is enough space around the dock for your vacuum and for easy access.
- 3. **Connect Charging Cable:** Insert your existing Shark charging cable into the designated port on the charging dock. Then, plug the charging cable into a working electrical outlet.
- 4. **Accessory Storage:** The dock is equipped with storage for up to three accessories. Attach your vacuum accessories to the designated posts on the dock for convenient storage.
