H2O Audio Stream 3 Bone Conduction Headphones User Manual

Model: Stream 3 w/ Bone Conduction (MP8-DM-BC-S)

1. INTRODUCTION

The H2O Audio Stream 3 is a versatile waterproof MP3 player and open-ear Bluetooth headphone system designed for active lifestyles, particularly swimming. Featuring bone conduction technology, 8GB of internal memory, and an IPX8 waterproof rating, it allows you to enjoy music in various environments. This manual provides essential information for setup, operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting.

2. SETUP

2.1. Charging the Device

Before initial use, fully charge your Stream 3 device. Connect the included USB charging cable to the device and a power source (e.g., computer USB port or USB wall adapter). The LED indicator will show charging status.

2.2. Loading Music (MP3 Player Mode)

The Stream 3 features 8GB of internal memory, capable of storing over 2000 songs. To load music:

1. Connect the Stream 3 to your computer using the USB cable.
2. The device will appear as a removable drive.
3. Drag and drop your audio files (M4A, MP3, WMA, FLAC, APE formats are supported) directly into the device's storage.
4. Safely eject the device from your computer before disconnecting.

2.3. Bluetooth Pairing (Out of Water Use)

The Stream 3 can connect to your smartphone via Bluetooth for wireless audio streaming when out of the water. The Bluetooth range is approximately 30 feet (10 meters). **Note: Bluetooth signals do not transmit effectively underwater, so this feature is for land-based use only.**

1. Ensure the Stream 3 is powered on.
2. Press and hold the Bluetooth button (often marked with a Bluetooth symbol or 'M' for mode, depending on the specific button layout) until the LED indicator flashes, indicating pairing mode.
3. On your smartphone or Bluetooth-enabled device, go to Bluetooth settings and select "H2O Audio Stream 3" from the list of available devices.
4. Once paired, the LED indicator will change to a steady light.

3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

3.1. Controls Overview

The Stream 3 features intuitive controls for easy operation:

- **Volume Buttons (+/-):** Press to adjust audio volume.
- **Play/Pause Button:** Press once to play or pause audio.
- **Skip/Fast Forward Buttons:** Press to skip tracks. Hold to fast forward/rewind within a track.
- **Mode/Shuffle Button (M):** Press to switch between MP3 and Bluetooth modes. Hold to activate shuffle play in MP3 mode.

3.2. Wearing the Device

The Stream 3 is designed for secure and comfortable wear during aquatic activities. The bone conduction headphones sit outside the ear, allowing for open-ear comfort and situational awareness.

- Attach the main unit to your goggle strap or swimwear using the integrated mounting clip. The stronger 360 clip ensures stability.
- Position the bone conduction transducers on your cheekbones, just in front of your ears, for optimal sound transmission.
- Ensure the short cord is managed to prevent entanglement.

4. MAINTENANCE

4.1. Cleaning

After each use, especially in chlorinated or saltwater, rinse the device and headphones with fresh water. Gently wipe with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use harsh chemicals or abrasive materials.

4.2. Waterproofing

The Stream 3 has an IPX8 waterproof rating, meaning it can withstand complete submersion up to 12 feet (3.6 meters). Ensure the headphone jack is securely connected to maintain the waterproof seal. The patented Seal-Tight headphone boot helps keep the jack dry.

4.3. Storage

Store the Stream 3 in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. Avoid placing heavy objects on the device.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Device not turning on:** Ensure the device is fully charged. Connect to a power source and check the charging indicator.
- **No sound or poor sound quality:**
 - Check volume levels on the device.
 - Ensure headphones are properly connected and positioned on your cheekbones.
 - If in MP3 mode, verify that audio files are correctly loaded and are in a supported format.
 - If in Bluetooth mode, ensure the device is paired and within range (out of water).
- **Difficulty transferring files to the device:**

- Ensure the USB cable is securely connected to both the device and the computer.
 - Try a different USB port or cable.
 - Ensure your computer's operating system recognizes the device as a removable drive.
- **Bluetooth connectivity issues:**
 - Ensure the device is in Bluetooth pairing mode.
 - Confirm the device is out of water and within the 30ft (10m) range of your smartphone.
 - Forget the device in your phone's Bluetooth settings and attempt to re-pair.
 - **Buttons unresponsive or difficult to press:** Ensure the buttons are clean and free of debris. If underwater, ensure you are pressing firmly.
 - **Battery life shorter than expected:** Battery performance can vary with usage and age. Ensure the device is fully charged before each use.
