1. INTRODUCTION

The PuroAir 240 HEPA Air Purifier is designed to improve indoor air quality by filtering up to 99.9% of pollutants. This device is suitable for large rooms, covering up to 1,000 sq ft in one hour, and is effective against dust, pollen, smoke, pet dander, and volatile organic compounds (VOCs). It features a powerful 3-layer filtration system and smart particle sensing for automated operation.

Its quiet operation, including a built-in sleep mode, makes it ideal for bedrooms and continuous 24/7 use. 2. SETUP

Before first use, ensure all packaging materials are removed. The PuroAir 240 features a cylindrical filter that is easily accessible from the bottom of the unit.

1. Unpack the air purifier and place it on a flat, stable surface.
2. Turn the unit upside down.
3. Twist the base cover counter-clockwise to unlock and remove it.
4. Remove the plastic packaging from the HEPA filter.
5. Insert the filter back into the unit, ensuring it is seated correctly.
6. Replace the base cover and twist clockwise to lock it securely.
7. Plug the power cord into a suitable electrical outlet.

3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The control panel is located on the top of the unit, featuring touch-sensitive buttons for various functions.

PuroAir detects air quality in your home and adjusts your purifier automatically 24/7.

Power On/Off

Press the power button (circle icon) to turn the unit on or off.

Fan Speed

Press the fan speed button (wavy lines icon) to cycle through different fan speeds. The PuroAir 240 typically offers multiple speed settings, including a quiet sleep mode.

Auto Mode

Press the Auto/Mode button (circular arrow icon) to activate Auto Mode. In this mode, the air purifier's smart particle sensor monitors air quality and automatically adjusts the fan speed to maintain optimal air purification.

Sleep Mode

Activate Sleep Mode for ultra-quiet operation, ideal for nighttime use. This mode typically dims indicator lights and operates at the lowest fan speed.

Timer

Use the Timer button (clock icon) to set the operating duration. Available settings may include 2, 4, 6, or 8 hours, after which the unit will automatically turn off.

Air Quality Indicator

The unit features an LED indicator that changes color to reflect the current air quality: blue for good, yellow for moderate, and red for poor. This allows for real-time monitoring of your indoor environment.

Child Lock

To prevent accidental changes to settings, press and hold the 'Hold to Lock' button (lock icon) for a few seconds to activate or deactivate the child lock feature. When activated, the control panel will not respond to touches.

4. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures optimal performance and extends the lifespan of your PuroAir 240. The unit features a 'Replace Filter' indicator to alert you when a filter change is needed.

Filter Replacement

The PuroAir 240 uses a combined filter that includes a pre-filter, HEPA filter, and activated carbon. The 'Replace Filter' indicator light will illuminate when it's time to change the filter, typically every 6-8 months depending on usage and air quality.

1. Turn off and unplug the air purifier.
2. Turn the unit upside down and unlock the base cover.
3. Carefully remove the old filter. Note the amount of dust and debris collected.
4. Dispose of the old filter responsibly.
5. Remove the new filter from its protective packaging.
6. Insert the new filter into the unit, ensuring a snug fit.
7. Replace and lock the base cover.
8. Plug in the unit and reset the 'Replace Filter' indicator by pressing and holding the corresponding button (often the timer or power button for a few seconds, refer to specific model instructions if unsure).

Cleaning the Unit

Wipe the exterior of the air purifier with a soft, dry cloth as needed. Avoid using abrasive cleaners or solvents. Ensure the air intake and outlet grilles are free from obstructions.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Unit does not turn on:** Ensure the power cord is securely plugged into a working outlet. Check if the child lock is activated.
- **Reduced airflow or unusual noise:** Check if the filter is clogged and needs replacement or cleaning. Ensure there are no obstructions around the air intake or outlet.
- **Air quality indicator always red/yellow:** This may indicate high levels of pollutants in the

environment. Ensure proper ventilation and consider running the unit on a higher fan speed or in Auto Mode. If the issue persists, the filter may need replacement.

- **Filter indicator light remains on after replacement:** You may need to manually reset the filter indicator. Refer to the 'Filter Replacement' section or your specific model's instructions.
