## INTRODUCTION

This device is designed for accurate and convenient measurement of blood pressure and pulse rate at the wrist. ## SETUP

---

### Battery Installation

Your monitor requires two AAA batteries for operation. Follow these steps to install them:

1. Locate the battery compartment cover on the back of the monitor.
2. Press down and slide the cover off.
3. Insert the two AAA batteries, ensuring the polarity (+ and -) matches the diagrams inside the compartment.
4. Replace the battery compartment cover until it clicks securely into place.

### HoMedics Health App Connection

The monitor features Bluetooth wireless technology to sync data with the HoMedics Health App on your smartphone. This allows for easy tracking and sharing of your readings, with automatic date and time stamps.

1. Download the HoMedics Health App from your smartphone's app store (iOS or Android).

2. Open the app and follow the on-screen instructions to create an account or log in.
3. Enable Bluetooth on your smartphone.
4. Within the app, select the option to add a new device and choose your HoMedics Premium Wrist Blood Pressure Monitor.
5. Follow any further pairing instructions provided by the app to establish the connection.




Image: A smartphone displaying the HoMedics Health App, showing options to select and connect different HoMedics monitors.

## OPERATION GUIDE

---

### Proper Wrist Positioning

Accurate readings depend on correct wrist positioning. The monitor features a Wrist Positioning Sensor to guide you to the ideal position: your wrist at heart level.

1. Sit comfortably with your feet flat on the floor and your arm resting on a table.
2. Place the cuff on your left wrist, ensuring the display is on the inside of your wrist. The bottom edge of the cuff should be approximately 1/4 inch (0.6 cm) from your palm.
3. Raise your wrist so the monitor is at the same level as your heart. The positioning sensor on the display will provide visual cues to help you achieve the correct height.
4. Relax your hand and avoid clenching your fist.

## WRIST POSITIONING GUIDE

Positioning sensor helps guide your wrist to be heart level, the ideal position to help you take an accurate blood pressure reading

### Taking a Measurement

The monitor utilizes Smart Measure inflation technology for quick and comfortable readings.

1. Ensure you are in a relaxed state and have followed the wrist positioning guidelines.
2. Select your user profile (User 1 or User 2) using the designated button if applicable.
3. Press the **START/STOP** button. The cuff will begin to inflate automatically.
4. Remain still and silent during the measurement. The monitor will deflate and display your systolic pressure, diastolic pressure, and pulse rate.
5. The reading will automatically be stored in the device's memory and, if connected, synced to the HoMedics Health App.

# EASY TO USE

Large backlit display with one-touch operation




Image: A detailed view of the monitor's backlit LCD display, highlighting the user selection, START/STOP button, and app connect features.

## User Memory and Averaging

The monitor supports two users, each with storage for up to 120 memories, totaling 240 memories. It also provides AM/PM averaging, which calculates the average of the last 3 morning or evening readings.

- To view stored memories, press the **M** (Memory) button. Repeated presses will cycle through past readings.
- The AM/PM averaging feature helps track trends in your blood pressure over time.



## 2-USER MEMORY

Stores up to 240 total  
memories: 120 per user

### Irregular Heartbeat Detector (IHB)

The monitor is equipped with an Irregular Heartbeat Detector. If an irregular heartbeat is detected during a measurement, an IHB symbol will appear on the display. This indicates a pulse irregularity. If this symbol appears frequently, consult your physician.

### Risk Category Index

The Risk Category Index provides a visual classification of your blood pressure reading based on established guidelines, allowing for easy comparison. Refer to the quick-start guide or consult your physician for detailed interpretation of these categories.

## 1 Irregular Heartbeat Detector

## 2 Risk Category Index

## 3 AM/PM Averaging

Averages the last 3 morning readings or the last 3 evening readings

## CARE AND MAINTENANCE

### Cleaning

To maintain the accuracy and longevity of your monitor:

- Wipe the monitor and cuff gently with a soft, dry cloth.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners, solvents, or immerse the device in water.

### Storage

Proper storage helps protect the device:

- Store the monitor in the provided storage bag when not in use.
- Keep the device in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight, extreme temperatures, and humidity.
- Remove batteries if the device will not be used for an extended period to prevent leakage.

### TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your HoMedics Premium Wrist Blood Pressure Monitor, refer to the table below for common problems and their solutions.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Monitor does not turn on	Batteries are dead or incorrectly inserted.	Replace batteries with new AAA batteries, ensuring correct polarity.
Inaccurate or inconsistent readings	Incorrect wrist positioning, movement during measurement, or talking.	Ensure proper wrist positioning at heart level. Remain still and silent during measurement. Wait 5 minutes before re-measuring.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Bluetooth connection failure	Bluetooth is off on phone, app not open, or monitor not in pairing mode.	Ensure Bluetooth is enabled on your phone. Open the HoMedics Health App. Follow app instructions to re-pair the device.
Error message on display	Excessive body motion detected, cuff not applied correctly, or other internal error.	Ensure you are still during measurement. Re-apply cuff snugly. If error persists, contact customer support.



