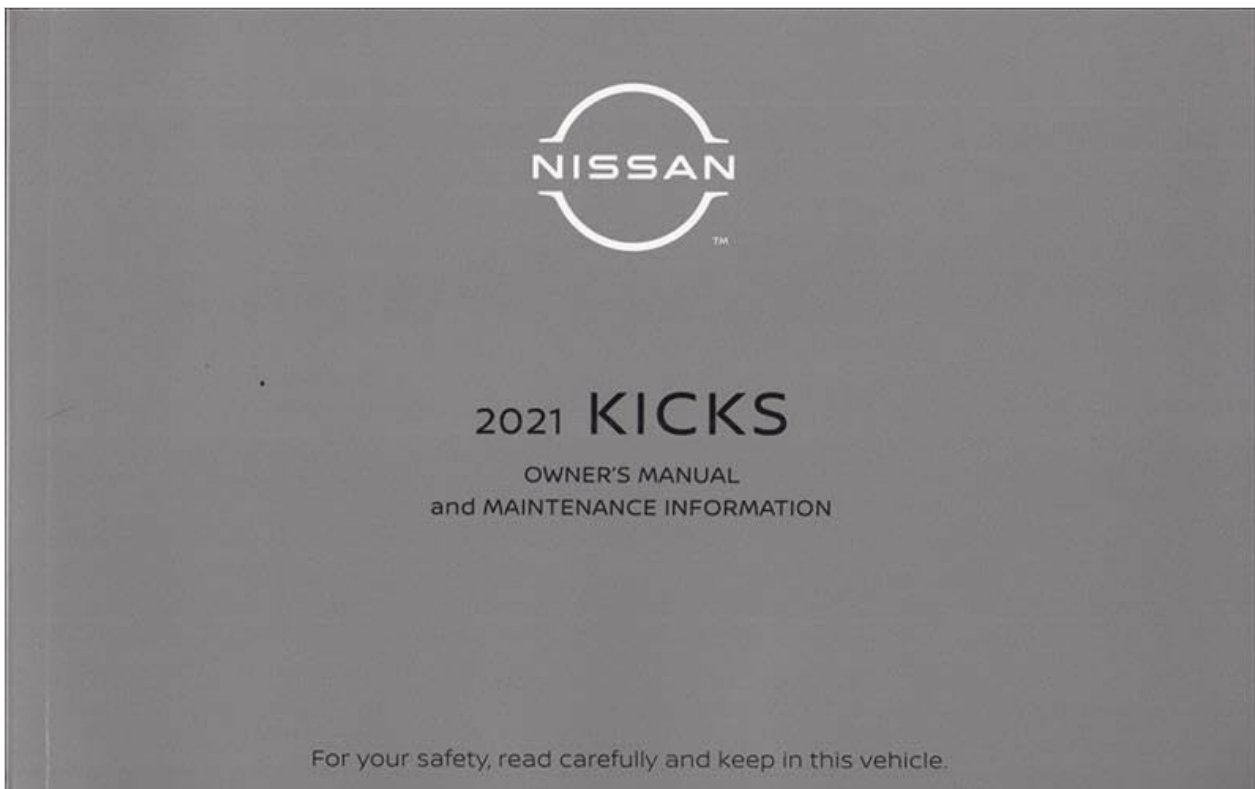

- Inspect tires for wear, damage, or embedded objects.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

---

### 6.1 Engine Will Not Start

- **Battery:** Check battery terminals for corrosion or looseness. If the battery is dead, jump-start the vehicle according to the instructions in this manual.

- **Immobilizer:** If the security indicator light is on, there might be an issue with the NISSAN Anti-Theft System (NATS). Try using a different key.

### 6.2 Warning Lights

- **Check Engine Light:** If this light illuminates, it indicates a potential issue with the engine or emissions system. Have the vehicle inspected by a qualified technician.
- **Low Tire Pressure Warning Light:** Indicates one or more tires are significantly underinflated. Check and adjust tire pressures immediately.

### 6.3 Flat Tire

- Safely pull over to a level area away from traffic.
- Refer to the manual for instructions on using the jack and changing a flat tire with the spare.
