IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

This bed frame is designed for a maximum weight capacity of 275 pounds. For safe assembly, use and maintenance, follow all instructions provided and ensure the bed frame is securely fastened. Exceeding the maximum weight limit or improper use may result in injury or damage to the product.

General Safety Guidelines:

- Always ensure all bolts and connectors are securely tightened before use.
- Regularly check the bed frame for loose parts or damage. Do not use if any components are compromised.
- The top bunk is not suitable for children under six years of age.
- Use only mattresses that comply with the recommended dimensions to prevent gaps that could trap a child.
- Prohibit horseplay on or under the bed.
- Always use the ladder for access to the upper bunk.
- Ensure the slide is properly attached and clear of obstructions before use.

- Do not fully tighten all bolts until the entire structure is assembled, then go back and tighten everything securely.
- Ensure the convertible slide and ladder are installed according to your preferred orientation (left or right) and are firmly secured.

Using the Bunk Bed:

- **Ladder Use:** Always use the integrated ladder to access the upper bunk. Ensure hands and feet are placed firmly on the rungs.
- **Guardrails:** The top bunk is equipped with full guardrails. Ensure these are always in place and undamaged to prevent falls.
- **Slide Use:** The convertible slide is for recreational use. Ensure the area around the slide exit is clear of obstacles. Supervise children during slide use.
- **Mattress Placement:** Place mattresses securely within the bed frame. For the top bunk, ensure the mattress thickness does not exceed the height of the guardrails, maintaining adequate safety clearance.
- **Weight Limits:** Adhere strictly to the 275-pound maximum weight capacity for the entire bed frame.

MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance will help extend the life and ensure the safety of your Majnesvon Twin Low Bunk Bed.

Cleaning and Care:

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the bed frame with a dry cloth to remove dust and dirt. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners, as these can damage the lacquered finish.
- **Regular Checks:** Periodically inspect all bolts, screws, and connections to ensure they remain tight. Retighten if necessary.
- **Structural Integrity:** Check for any signs of wear, cracks, or damage to the wood components. If damage is found, discontinue use and contact customer support for assistance.
- **Environmental Conditions:** Avoid placing the bed in direct sunlight or near heat sources, which can cause wood to dry out or warp. Maintain a stable room temperature and humidity.

TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your bunk bed.

Common Issues and Solutions:

- **Bed feels wobbly or unstable:**
 - Ensure all assembly bolts and screws are fully tightened.
 - Verify that all components are correctly aligned according to the assembly instructions.
 - Check if the bed is placed on an even surface. Adjust if necessary.
- **Difficulty with assembly:**
 - Re-read the assembly instructions carefully, paying attention to diagrams.
 - Ensure you have all parts and hardware as listed in the manual.
 - If a part seems to not fit, do not force it. Double-check the part number and orientation.
 - Consider having a second person assist with assembly.

• **Squeaking noises:**

- Tighten all bolts and connections. Loose connections are a common cause of squeaking.
- Apply a small amount of lubricant (e.g., paraffin wax or silicone spray) to metal-on-metal contact points if applicable, or wood-on-wood joints.
