- Unplug the apparatus during lightning storms or when unused for long periods.
- Refer all servicing to qualified service personnel.

## PRODUCT OVERVIEW

Familiarize yourself with the main components and controls of your Audizio Tours system.

## Front Panel Controls & Display

- **Power/Standby Button:** Turns the unit on or off.
- **Source Button:** Selects input source (CD, USB, Bluetooth, DAB+, FM, AUX).
- **Menu/Info Buttons:** Navigates menus and displays information.
- **Navigation/Enter Buttons:** For menu selection and track control.
- **Volume +/-:** Adjusts the master volume.
- **LCD Display:** Shows current mode, track information, radio station, etc.
- **USB Port:** For MP3 playback from USB drives.

## Remote Control

The remote control for the Audizio Tours system, featuring dedicated buttons for power, source selection, CD/USB playback controls, radio tuning, volume adjustment, and sound equalization settings like X-Bass.

The remote control provides full functionality for convenient operation from a distance. Ensure batteries are correctly inserted.

## SETUP

### Placement

The Audizio Tours system can be placed on a flat surface using its integrated stand or mounted on a wall. Ensure the unit is placed on a stable surface or securely mounted.

## Power Connection

1. Connect the power cable to the AC IN socket on the rear of the unit.
2. Plug the other end of the power cable into a suitable wall outlet (220V).

## Antenna Connection

For optimal DAB+ and FM radio reception, ensure the included antenna is properly extended and positioned.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

### Power On/Off

Press the **Power/Standby** button on the unit or remote control to turn the system on or off.

### Source Selection

Press the **Source** button repeatedly on the unit or remote control to cycle through available input sources: CD, USB, Bluetooth, DAB+, FM, AUX.

### Bluetooth Pairing

1. Select the Bluetooth source using the **Source** button. The display will show "Bluetooth".

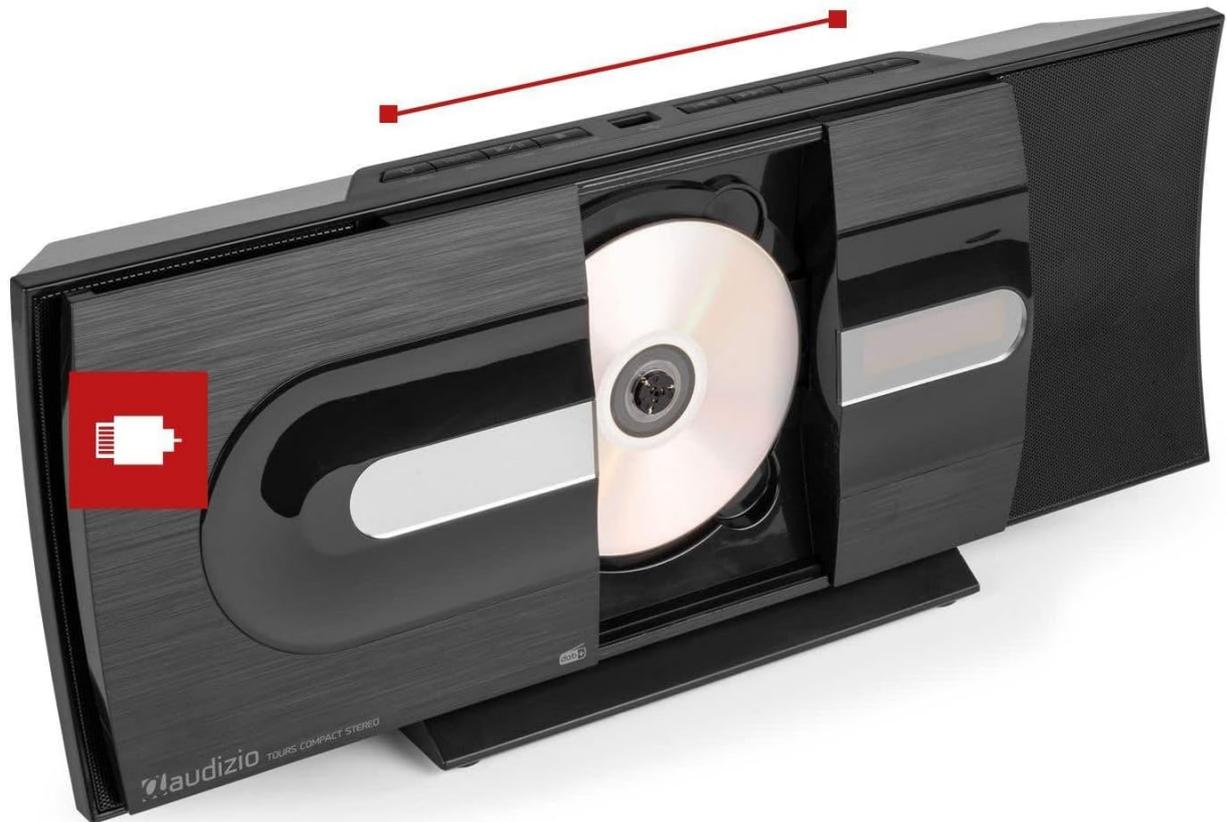
2. On your smartphone or tablet, enable Bluetooth and search for available devices.
3. Select "Audizio Tours" from the list of devices.
4. Once paired, you can stream audio wirelessly from your device to the system.

## CD Playback

1. Select the CD source.
2. The motorized CD door will open. Insert a CD (CD-R/RW compatible) with the label side facing up.
3. The door will close automatically, and the system will begin reading the disc.
4. Use the playback controls (Play/Pause, Skip, Stop) on the unit or remote control.

### USB Playback (MP3)

1. Insert a USB flash drive containing MP3 files into the USB port.
2. Select the USB source.
3. The system will automatically detect and begin playing MP3 files.
4. Use the playback controls (Play/Pause, Skip, Stop) on the unit or remote control.

## Radio Operation (DAB+ and FM)

1. Select DAB+ or FM source.
2. For DAB+, the system will automatically scan for available stations on first use. For FM, you can manually tune or auto-scan.
3. Use the navigation buttons to browse stations.
4. To save a preset, press and hold the Preset button, then select a preset number and confirm.
5. To recall a preset, briefly press the Preset button and select the desired number.

## Sound Settings

- **Volume:** Adjust using the Volume +/- buttons on the unit or remote.
- **Equalization (EQ):** Use the EQ button on the remote to cycle through preset sound modes.
- **X-Bass:** Press the X-Bass button on the remote to enhance bass frequencies.

## Clock, Alarm, and Sleep Timer

The system includes a clock with sleep timer and alarm functions.

- **Setting the Clock:** Refer to the detailed instructions in the full manual for setting the time.
- **Sleep Timer:** Allows the unit to automatically turn off after a set period.
- **Alarm Function:** Set an alarm to wake up to your preferred audio source.

## MAINTENANCE

- Always unplug the unit from the power outlet before cleaning.
- Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the exterior of the unit.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners, waxes, or solvents as they may damage the finish.
- Keep the CD slot and USB port free of dust and debris.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
---------	----------------	----------

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No power	Power cable not connected; Power outlet not active.	Check power cable connection; Try a different outlet.
No sound	Volume too low; Incorrect source selected; Mute function active.	Increase volume; Select correct source; Deactivate mute.
Bluetooth not pairing	Bluetooth not enabled on device; Unit not in pairing mode; Device too far.	Ensure Bluetooth is on and in pairing mode; Move device closer.
CD/USB not playing	Disc/USB damaged or incompatible format; Incorrect source selected.	Try another disc/USB; Ensure files are MP3; Select correct source.
Poor radio reception	Antenna not extended; Weak signal.	Fully extend and reposition antenna; Try auto-scan again.
