SETUP AND INSTALLATION

- Unpacking:** Carefully remove the inner pot from its packaging. Inspect for any signs of damage.
- Initial Cleaning:** Before first use, wash the inner pot thoroughly with warm, soapy water using a soft sponge. Rinse well and dry completely.
- Placement:** Ensure the exterior of the inner pot is clean and dry. Gently place the inner pot into the main body of your CUCKOO Rice Cooker Model CRP-HN1059F. Make sure it sits securely and flat at the bottom of the cooker. Do not force it into place.
- Compatibility Check:** Verify that the inner pot fits snugly and correctly within the rice cooker. An improper fit can affect cooking performance.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The inner pot is an integral part of your rice cooker's operation. Follow these guidelines for optimal use:

- Rice and Water Measurement:** Use the measurement markings inside the inner pot to add the correct amount of rice and water according to your recipe or the rice cooker's instructions. The "X-Wall Diamond" coating ensures even heat distribution.

- **Avoid Overfilling:** Do not exceed the maximum fill line indicated on the inner pot to prevent overflow during cooking.
- **Handle with Care:** Always use oven mitts or the rice cooker's handles when removing the hot inner pot after cooking.
- **Placement:** Always ensure the inner pot is properly seated in the rice cooker before starting any cooking cycle.

MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Proper care of your inner pot will extend its lifespan and maintain its nonstick properties.

- **Cleaning:** After each use, allow the inner pot to cool down. Wash it with warm, soapy water and a soft sponge or cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners, scouring pads, or metal utensils, as these can damage the nonstick coating.
- **Stubborn Residue:** If food sticks, soak the inner pot in warm water for a few minutes to loosen the residue before cleaning.
- **Drying:** Dry the inner pot thoroughly before storing or placing it back into the rice cooker.
- **Storage:** Store the inner pot in a dry place. Avoid stacking heavy objects inside it that could scratch the coating.
- **Utensils:** Always use plastic, silicone, or wooden utensils when stirring or serving from the inner pot to protect the nonstick surface.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your inner pot, consider the following:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Inner pot does not fit correctly.	Debris in the rice cooker housing; incorrect model inner pot.	Ensure the rice cooker housing is clean. Verify the inner pot is the correct model (CRP-HN1059F).
Food sticks to the nonstick coating.	Coating wear due to abrasive cleaning/utensils; high heat without liquid.	Ensure proper cleaning methods are used (soft sponge, no metal utensils). Avoid heating the pot empty. If coating is significantly worn, replacement may be necessary.
Scratches on the inner pot.	Use of metal utensils or abrasive cleaning materials.	Always use plastic, silicone, or wooden utensils. Clean with soft sponges only.
