1. INTRODUCTION

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

4. ASSEMBLY

The X-PRO 200 ATV requires some assembly. The following components typically require installation:

- Handlebar brackets
- All four wheels
- Front and rear racks (if included)
- Rear shock
- Battery

5.1 Pre-Operation Checklist

- Check tire pressure.
- Verify brake function.
- Ensure all fasteners are tight.
- Check fuel and oil levels.
- Confirm lights and horn are operational.

5.2 Starting the ATV

1. Ensure the transmission is in neutral.

2. Turn the ignition key to the 'ON' position.
3. Apply the brake and press the electric start button.

5.3 Driving and Transmission

The X-PRO 200 ATV features an automatic transmission with reverse. To engage forward or reverse, shift the gear lever while the ATV is stationary and the engine is idling. Gradually apply throttle for smooth acceleration. The LED headlight provides illumination for operation in low-light conditions.

6. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance is crucial for the longevity and safe operation of your ATV. The 177.3cc air-cooled engine is designed to prevent overheating, reducing some maintenance concerns related to liquid cooling systems. However, routine checks are still necessary.

6.1 Routine Checks

- **Oil Level:** Check engine oil regularly and change as per the maintenance schedule.
- **Air Filter:** Clean or replace the air filter periodically, especially when operating in dusty conditions.
- **Spark Plug:** Inspect and clean or replace the spark plug as needed.
- **Brakes:** Inspect brake pads and fluid levels. Adjust as necessary.
- **Chain/Drive System:** Lubricate and adjust the drive chain regularly.
- **Tires:** Maintain correct tire pressure and inspect for wear or damage.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Engine does not start	No fuel, dead battery, faulty spark plug, kill switch engaged	Check fuel level, charge/replace battery, inspect/replace spark plug, disengage kill switch
Loss of power	Clogged air filter, fuel system issue, spark plug issue	Clean/replace air filter, check fuel lines and carburetor, inspect spark plug
Brakes feel spongy	Low brake fluid, air in brake lines, worn brake pads	Check and top up brake fluid, bleed brake lines, replace brake pads
