1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Salton Portable Induction Cooktop ID1880 offers efficient and precise cooking with its integrated temperature probe. This 1500W unit features a crystal glass top, 10 adjustable temperature levels, and various convenient functions designed for versatile cooking.

Key Features:

- **Integrated Temperature Probe:** Allows for precise internal temperature control, ideal for sous vide, deep frying, and slow cooking.
- **10 Temperature Levels:** Adjustable settings from 60°C to 240°C (140°F to 465°F) for diverse cooking needs.
- **Energy Efficient:** Induction technology heats cookware directly, reducing energy waste and ensuring faster heating.
- **Crystal Glass Surface:** Sleek design with touch-sensitive controls, easy to clean.
- **Convenient Functions:** Includes a 3-hour timer with auto shut-off, pause function, and a keep-warm setting for up to 2 hours.
- **Safety Lock:** Prevents accidental button presses.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read all safety instructions carefully before using the appliance to prevent injury or damage.

General Safety Precautions:

- Always place the cooktop on a stable, heat-resistant surface.
- Ensure adequate ventilation around the unit.
- Do not immerse the cooktop in water or any other liquid.
- Keep out of reach of children. The induction technology heats the pot directly, but the surface can still become hot from residual heat.
- Use only induction-compatible cookware.
- Do not place metallic objects (e.g., knives, forks, spoons, lids) on the cooktop surface as they can become hot.
- Unplug the appliance when not in use and before cleaning.

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Verify that all items are present in the package:

- Salton Portable Induction Cooktop (Model ID1880)
- Integrated Temperature Probe
- Magnet Tester
- Instruction Manual

4. SETUP

1. **Unpack:** Carefully remove all packaging materials and ensure the cooktop is free from damage.
2. **Placement:** Place the cooktop on a flat, stable, and dry surface. Ensure there is sufficient space around the unit for ventilation.
3. **Power Connection:** Plug the power cord into a standard 120V AC electrical outlet.
4. **Temperature Probe (Optional):** If using the temperature probe, connect it to the designated port on the side of the cooktop. The probe and its support bracket are stored on the bottom of the unit.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Basic Operation:

- Power On:** Place induction-compatible cookware on the cooktop. Press the Power button (P) to turn on the unit.
- Select Mode:** Use the 'Mode' button to cycle through cooking modes (e.g., power levels, temperature settings).
- Adjust Settings:** Use the '+' and '-' buttons or the slider control to adjust power (1-10 levels) or temperature (60°C to 240°C / 140°F to 465°F). The display will show the selected setting.
- Temperature Unit:** Press the 'C/F' button to switch between Celsius and Fahrenheit.

Using the Temperature Probe:

The integrated temperature probe allows for precise cooking by monitoring the internal temperature of your food.

1. Insert the probe into the thickest part of the food, avoiding bones.
2. Connect the probe to the cooktop's designated port.
3. The cooktop will display the current internal temperature and can maintain a set temperature for extended periods, ideal for techniques like sous vide.

Timer and Keep Warm Functions:

- **Timer:** Set the 3-hour timer for precise cooking durations. The unit will automatically shut off once the timer expires.
- **Keep Warm:** Activate the keep-warm function to maintain food temperature for up to 2 hours after cooking.

Pause and Lock Functions:

- **Pause:** Temporarily pause cooking without losing your settings.
- **Lock:** Engage the lock function to prevent accidental changes to settings during operation, enhancing safety.

6. COOKWARE COMPATIBILITY

Induction cooktops work by creating a magnetic field that directly heats compatible cookware. For optimal performance, use pots and pans made of ferromagnetic materials such as cast iron, enameled iron, or stainless steel with a magnetic base. Aluminum, copper, glass, and ceramic cookware are generally not compatible unless they have an induction-ready base.

To test if your cookware is compatible, place the included magnet tester (or any magnet) on the bottom of the pot or pan. If the magnet sticks, the cookware is suitable for induction cooking.

7. CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

Regular cleaning ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your Salton Portable Induction Cooktop.

- 1. Before Cleaning:** Always unplug the cooktop and allow it to cool completely.
- 2. Surface Cleaning:** Wipe the crystal glass surface with a soft, damp cloth and mild detergent. For stubborn stains, use a non-abrasive cleaner specifically designed for glass cooktops. Spills do not bake onto the surface, making cleanup simple.
- 3. Control Panel:** Wipe the touch-sensitive control panel with a soft, dry cloth.
- 4. Base:** Clean the exterior of the base with a damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or scourers.
- 5. Storage:** Store the cooktop in a dry place when not in use.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your induction cooktop, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

- **Cooktop not turning on:** Ensure the unit is properly plugged into a working outlet. Check if the power button has been pressed. Verify that induction-compatible cookware is placed on the cooking zone.
- **Cookware not heating:** Confirm that your cookware is induction-compatible using the magnet tester. The base of the cookware should be flat and cover a significant portion of the cooking zone.
- **Error codes displayed:** Consult the full instruction manual for specific error code meanings and troubleshooting steps.
- **Unusual noises:** A low humming sound is normal during induction cooking. If loud or unusual noises occur, ensure cookware is flat and properly centered.
