INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential instructions for the safe assembly, operation, and maintenance of your Ravin R29X Sniper Package Crossbow Hunter's Bundle. Please read this entire manual carefully before using the crossbow to ensure safe and optimal performance. Retain this manual for future reference.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

WARNING: Crossbows are powerful hunting tools. Improper use can result in serious injury or death. Always adhere to the following safety guidelines:

- Always treat the crossbow as if it is loaded.
- Never point the crossbow at anything you do not intend to shoot.
- Keep your finger off the trigger until you are ready to shoot.
- Ensure the safety mechanism is engaged until ready to fire.
- Only use arrows specifically designed for your Ravin R29X crossbow.
- Never dry fire the crossbow. Dry firing can cause severe damage to the crossbow and potential injury.
- Always wear appropriate eye protection when operating or maintaining the crossbow.
- Be aware of your surroundings and ensure a clear backstop before shooting.
- Keep all body parts, especially fingers and thumbs, clear of the string path and rail during cocking and firing.
- Store the crossbow unloaded and in a secure location, out of reach of children.

SETUP

1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove all components from the hard carrying case. Inspect for any shipping damage.
2. **Crossbow Assembly:** Refer to the specific assembly instructions provided with your Ravin R29X crossbow. Ensure all bolts are tightened to manufacturer specifications.
3. **Bi-Pod Attachment:** The TacHeads Quick-Detach Bi-Pod can be attached to the designated mounting point on the crossbow. Ensure it is securely fastened.
4. **Scope Adjustment:** The scope is factory-installed. For initial sighting, follow the scope's specific instructions for zeroing at your desired range.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

- Cocking the Crossbow:** Use the integrated Versa-Draw cocking system. Follow the specific steps outlined in the Ravin R29X user guide to safely cock the crossbow. Ensure the string is fully engaged and the safety automatically engages.
- Loading an Arrow:** Place a Ravin-approved arrow onto the rail, ensuring the nock is properly seated on the string and the arrow is fully forward against the retention spring.
- Engaging Safety:** After cocking and loading, ensure the safety mechanism is engaged until you are ready to shoot.
- Aiming and Firing:** With the safety disengaged, align your target through the scope. Maintain a firm grip and squeeze the trigger smoothly. Keep all body parts clear of the string path.
- Decocking:** If not firing, safely decock the crossbow according to the manufacturer's instructions. Never attempt to decock by hand or by firing into the ground.

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance is crucial for the longevity and safe operation of your Ravin R29X crossbow.

- String and Cable Lubrication:** Apply Ravin String Fluid to the crossbow string and cables as recommended by the manufacturer, typically after every 10-20 shots or before extended storage. This helps reduce friction and extend component life.
- Cleaning:** Keep the crossbow rail clean and free of debris. Use a soft cloth to wipe down the crossbow after each use.
- Inspection:** Regularly inspect the string, cables, limbs, and all fasteners for signs of wear, fraying, or damage. Replace worn components immediately.
- Storage:** Store the crossbow in its hard carrying case in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. Ensure it is unloaded and decocked.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Ravin R29X crossbow, consider the following common solutions:

- Inaccurate Shots:** Check arrow fletching, broadhead alignment, scope zero, and ensure consistent shooting form. Inspect for any loose components on the crossbow.
- Cocking Issues:** Ensure the cocking mechanism is clean and free of obstructions. Verify proper technique as per the operating instructions.
- String Wear:** Fraying or excessive wear on the string or cables indicates a need for replacement. Contact Ravin customer support or an authorized service center.
- Misfire/Failure to Fire:** Ensure the crossbow is fully cocked, the arrow is properly seated, and the safety is disengaged. If issues persist, do not attempt to force operation; seek professional assistance.
