PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The tectake® Multi-purpose Steel Cabinet is designed for secure and versatile storage in various environments, including offices, homes, and workshops. Constructed from robust steel, this cabinet offers enhanced protection for your documents and valuables with its security cylinder lock and two keys. It features two main compartments, two practical drawers, and reinforced doors for smooth operation.

Its adaptable design includes height-adjustable shelves, allowing you to customize the interior space to suit your specific storage needs, whether for files, books, or other items. The cabinet combines functionality with an aesthetic design, featuring doors that open smoothly up to a 130° angle and noise-dampening rubber buffers for quiet closing.

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

This multi-purpose cabinet is designed for straightforward assembly, allowing it to be set up in just a few steps. Ensure you have adequate space and the necessary tools before beginning the assembly process. It is recommended to assemble the cabinet on a soft, clean surface to prevent scratches.

The cabinet features height-adjustable shelves, which can be positioned according to your storage requirements during or after assembly. Refer to the included assembly diagram for detailed step-by-step instructions on connecting the panels and installing the shelves and drawers.

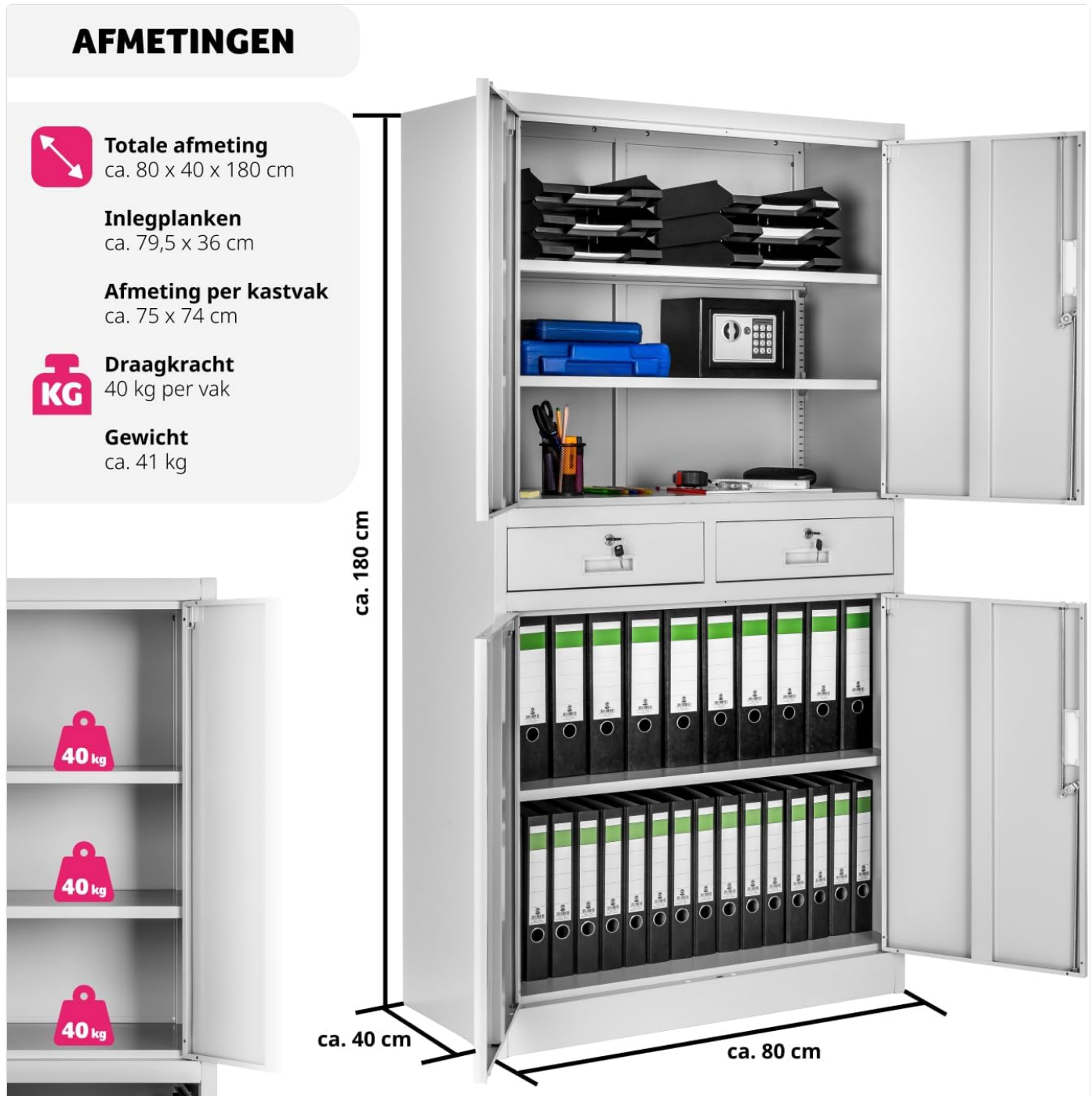


Figure 2: A diagram illustrating the key dimensions of the tectake® Multi-purpose Steel Cabinet, including its total height, width, and depth. It also highlights the weight capacity per shelf and the overall weight of the unit, which are important for planning placement and usage.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Using the Locks and Keys

The cabinet is equipped with security cylinder locks for both the main doors and the two drawers. Each lock comes with two keys. Insert the key into the lock and turn it to secure or unlock the doors/drawers. Ensure the key is fully inserted before turning to prevent damage. Handle keys with care, as some users have reported they can be delicate.

Adjusting Shelves

The shelves within the main compartments are height-adjustable. To adjust a shelf, first empty its contents. Locate the shelf support clips on the interior side panels. Remove the shelf, reposition the clips to the desired height, and then place the shelf back onto the clips, ensuring it is level and securely seated.

Using the Drawers

The two integrated drawers provide additional secure storage. Pull the drawer handles to open them. To lock a drawer, push it fully closed and use the corresponding key to secure it. The drawers are ideal for smaller items, stationery, or sensitive documents.

MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and appearance of your tectake® steel cabinet, regular maintenance is recommended.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe down the smooth surfaces of the cabinet with a soft, damp cloth. For stubborn marks, a mild, non-abrasive cleaning solution can be used. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive materials that could damage the finish.
- **Dusting:** Regularly dust the interior and exterior surfaces to prevent buildup.
- **Lock Care:** If the locks become stiff, a small amount of graphite powder or a specialized lock lubricant can be

applied to the keyhole. Do not use oil-based lubricants as they can attract dust.

- **Door Hinges:** Periodically check the door hinges for smooth operation. If they become noisy or stiff, a small amount of silicone spray lubricant can be applied.

Always ensure the cabinet is dry after cleaning to prevent rust, especially in humid environments.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Keys are difficult to insert or turn.	Dust or debris in the lock mechanism; key not fully inserted; slight misalignment.	Ensure the key is fully inserted. Apply a small amount of graphite powder or dry lock lubricant into the keyhole. Avoid forcing the key.
Doors or drawers do not close smoothly.	Obstruction; misalignment of hinges/runners; cabinet not level.	Check for any items blocking closure. Verify the cabinet is on a level surface. Inspect hinges/runners for damage or loose screws and tighten if necessary.
Minor dents or deformations on panels.	Occasional manufacturing or transit damage.	Small deformations that do not affect functionality or appearance from the exterior can often be left as is. For significant damage, contact customer support.
