## 1. INTRODUCTION

---

The Oral-B PRO 3 3500 Electric Toothbrush is designed to provide a superior cleaning experience, helping you brush as recommended by dental professionals. It features advanced cleaning technology and smart features to promote healthier gums and remove more plaque compared to a manual toothbrush.

## 2. SAFETY INFORMATION

### WARNING:

- Use under adult supervision.
- Do not allow children to play with the product.
- Replace the brush head every 3 months or when bristles are worn.
- Do not use on children under 3 years of age.
- Consult your dentist before use if you have had oral surgery or gum disease.

## 3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Oral-B PRO 3 3500 features a round brush head, 3D cleaning action, and a 360° visual pressure sensor for effective and safe brushing.

## Key Features:

- **3D Cleaning Technology:** Oscillates, rotates, and pulsates to break up and remove plaque.
- **360° Visual Pressure Control:** Lights up red and reduces brushing speed if you brush too hard, protecting your gums.
- **Built-in Timer:** Guides you to brush for the dentist-recommended 2 minutes, with 30-second quadrant alerts.
- **3 Brushing Modes:** For personalized cleaning.
- **Long-lasting Lithium-Ion Battery:** Provides extended use between charges.
- **Round Brush Head:** Designed to surround each tooth for a thorough clean.

## 4. SETUP

### 4.1 Charging the Toothbrush

1. Plug the charger into an electrical outlet.
2. Place the toothbrush handle on the charging unit.
3. The battery indicator light will show the charging status. A full charge can take approximately 12-16 hours.
4. For optimal battery life, fully discharge the battery every 6 months by using the toothbrush until it stops, then fully recharge it.

## 4.2 Attaching the Brush Head

1. Align the brush head with the shaft of the toothbrush handle.
2. Push the brush head down firmly until it clicks into place.

## 5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

### 5.1 Brushing Your Teeth

1. Wet the brush head and apply a small amount of toothpaste.
2. Place the brush head on your teeth, then press the On/Off button to start.
3. Guide the brush head slowly from tooth to tooth, spending a few seconds on each tooth surface.
4. The **built-in timer** will signal after 30 seconds to move to the next quadrant of your mouth, and after 2 minutes for a complete brushing session.
5. The **360° visual pressure control** will light up red if you apply too much pressure, indicating you should reduce the force.
6. After brushing, press the On/Off button to turn off the toothbrush.

## 6. BRUSHING MODES

---

The Oral-B PRO 3 3500 offers 3 distinct brushing modes to cater to your specific oral care needs. Press the mode button (often the same as the On/Off button) repeatedly to cycle through the modes.

- **Daily Clean:** Standard mode for daily comprehensive cleaning.
- **Sensitive:** Gentle speed for sensitive teeth and gums.
- **Whitening:** Designed to gently polish away surface stains.

*Note: The specific modes available may vary slightly by region or product variant.*

## 7. MAINTENANCE

---

### 7.1 Cleaning the Toothbrush

1. After each use, rinse the brush head thoroughly under running water with the handle switched on.
2. Remove the brush head and clean the handle and brush head separately under running water.
3. Wipe the handle dry with a soft cloth.
4. Clean the charging unit regularly with a damp cloth. Do not immerse the charger in water.

### 7.2 Replacing the Brush Head

Dental professionals recommend replacing your brush head every 3 months, or sooner if the bristles are splayed or worn. The indicator bristles on Oral-B brush heads fade halfway to signal when it's time for a replacement.

## 8. TROUBLESHOOTING

---

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
---------	----------------	----------

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Toothbrush does not turn on.	Battery is discharged.	Place the toothbrush on the charger for at least 30 minutes, then try again. Ensure the charger is plugged in.
Toothbrush does not hold a charge.	Battery may be old or faulty.	Ensure proper charging as per Section 4.1. If the issue persists, contact Oral-B customer service.
Red light illuminates frequently during brushing.	Applying too much pressure.	Reduce the pressure applied to your teeth and gums. The toothbrush is designed to do the work for you.
Brush head feels loose.	Brush head not properly attached or worn.	Ensure the brush head is pushed down firmly until it clicks. If it's an old brush head, replace it.
