# ARUBA 60 cm Wall-Mounted Vanity Unit

## INSTRUCTION MANUAL

### 1. Introduction

This manual provides detailed instructions for the assembly, installation, operation, and maintenance of your Vente-unique ARUBA 60 cm Wall-Mounted Vanity Unit. This unit is designed for bathroom use and features a natural wood-effect finish with white drawer fronts. It includes two soft-close drawers for storage and is intended for wall-mounting. Please read all instructions carefully before beginning assembly and retain this manual for future reference.

### 2. Safety Information

- Read all instructions before assembly and installation.
- Ensure all parts are present and undamaged before starting assembly. Do not proceed if any parts are missing or damaged.
- Assembly should be performed by at least two adults to prevent injury and damage to the product.
- Use appropriate tools as specified in the assembly section.
- Always secure the vanity unit to a solid wall structure using the provided mounting hardware. Failure to do so may result in the unit tipping over, causing serious injury or damage.
- Keep small parts and packaging materials away from children to prevent choking hazards.
- Do not overload drawers. Distribute weight evenly.
- Avoid exposing the unit to excessive moisture or direct water spray.

### 3. Package Contents

Verify that all components listed below are included in your package. If any items are missing or damaged, please contact Vente-unique customer service.

- Vanity Unit Body (1)
- Drawer Fronts (2)
- Drawer Sides and Backs (for 2 drawers)
- Drawer Bottoms (2)
- Soft-Close Drawer Slides (2 pairs)
- Assembly Hardware (screws, dowels, cam locks, wall mounting brackets, wall plugs)
- Instruction Manual (this document)

## 4. Setup and Assembly

---

### 4.1 Tools Required

- Phillips Head Screwdriver
- Drill with appropriate drill bits (for wall mounting)
- Spirit Level
- Measuring Tape
- Pencil
- Hammer (optional, for dowels)

### 4.2 Assembly Steps

1. **Prepare the Workspace:** Clear a spacious, clean, and flat area for assembly. Lay down a blanket or cardboard to protect the unit's surfaces.
2. **Assemble the Cabinet Body:** Follow the diagrams provided in the separate assembly sheet (if included) to connect the side panels, back panel, and top/bottom panels using the provided screws, dowels, and cam locks. Ensure all connections are secure.
3. **Assemble the Drawers:** Attach the drawer sides to the drawer fronts and backs. Insert the drawer bottoms into the grooves. Secure all connections.
4. **Install Drawer Slides:** Attach the cabinet portion of the soft-close drawer slides to the inside of the cabinet body according to the pre-drilled holes. Attach the drawer portion of the slides to the assembled drawers.
5. **Insert Drawers:** Carefully align the drawer slides and push the drawers into the cabinet body until they click into place. Test the soft-close mechanism.
6. **Prepare for Wall Mounting:** Determine the desired height and location for the vanity unit on your bathroom wall. Use a spirit level and pencil to mark the positions for the wall mounting brackets. Ensure the marks are level and correspond to the mounting points on the unit.
7. **Drill Pilot Holes:** Using an appropriate drill bit for your wall type (e.g., masonry bit for concrete, wood bit for studs), drill pilot holes at the marked locations. Insert the wall plugs (if required for your wall type) into the pilot holes.
8. **Attach Wall Brackets:** Secure the wall mounting brackets to the wall using the provided screws. Ensure they are firmly attached and level.
9. **Mount the Vanity Unit:** With the help of a second person, carefully lift the assembled vanity unit and align its mounting points with the wall brackets. Secure the unit to the brackets according to the instructions provided with the hardware. Double-check that the unit is stable and securely fastened to the wall.

## 5. Operating the Vanity Unit

---

The ARUBA vanity unit is equipped with two drawers featuring a soft-close mechanism. To operate the drawers:

- **Opening:** Gently pull the integrated handle on the drawer front to open.
- **Closing:** Push the drawer gently until it engages with the soft-close mechanism. The drawer will then slowly and quietly close completely. Avoid forcing the drawer shut, as this can damage the mechanism.

## 6. Maintenance

---

Proper care will ensure the longevity and appearance of your vanity unit.

- **Cleaning:** Wipe surfaces with a soft, damp cloth. For stubborn marks, use a mild, non-abrasive cleaner specifically designed for furniture. Immediately dry all surfaces with a clean, dry cloth to prevent water damage.
- **Avoid Harsh Chemicals:** Do not use abrasive cleaners, solvents, or ammonia-based products, as these can damage the finish.
- **Moisture Protection:** While the unit is designed for bathroom environments, avoid prolonged exposure to

- standing water or excessive humidity. Promptly wipe up any spills.
- **Drawer Mechanism:** Periodically check the drawer slides for smooth operation. Do not apply lubricants unless specifically recommended by the manufacturer.

## 7. Troubleshooting

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Drawers do not close smoothly or soft-close mechanism is not working.	Drawer slides are misaligned or obstructed.	Remove the drawer and check for any obstructions in the slides. Ensure the slides are correctly installed and aligned on both the drawer and the cabinet body.
Vanity unit feels unstable or wobbly after installation.	Improper wall mounting or loose connections.	Re-check all wall mounting screws and brackets to ensure they are securely fastened to a solid wall structure. Tighten any loose connections within the cabinet body.
Missing parts during assembly.	Packaging error.	Do not proceed with assembly. Contact Vente-unique customer service immediately with your purchase details.
