INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the safe and effective use of your ELEHOT-STORE Professional Hair Clipper. Please read this manual thoroughly before first use and keep it for future reference. Proper use and maintenance will ensure optimal performance and longevity of your device.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- Always unplug the appliance immediately after use and before cleaning.
- Do not place or store the appliance where it can fall or be pulled into a tub or sink.
- Do not place in or drop into water or other liquid.
- Do not reach for an appliance that has fallen into water. Unplug immediately.
- Close supervision is necessary when this appliance is used by, on, or near children or invalids.
- Use this appliance only for its intended household use as described in this manual.
- Never operate this appliance if it has a damaged cord or plug, if it is not working properly, or if it has been dropped or damaged.
- Keep the cord away from heated surfaces.
- Never drop or insert any object into any opening.
- Do not use outdoors or operate where aerosol (spray) products are being used or where oxygen is being administered.
- Always attach plug to appliance first, then to outlet. To disconnect, turn all controls to OFF position, then remove plug from outlet.
- The appliance is designed for hair cutting only. Do not use it for other purposes.

- **Ceramic Blades:** Equipped with durable and wear-resistant ceramic blades, offering precise cutting. Blade configurations include 1 mm, 1.3 mm, 1.6 mm, and 1.9 mm. Self-sharpening technology ensures long-term durability.

SETUP

1. **Initial Charging:** Before first use, fully charge the hair clipper. Connect the USB cable to the charging stand and plug the adapter into a power outlet. Place the clipper onto the charging stand. The LCD display will show the charging progress. A full charge takes approximately 2.5 hours.
2. **Attaching Guide Combs:** Select the desired guide comb based on the hair length you wish to achieve. Align the comb with the clipper blade and push it firmly until it clicks into place. Ensure it is securely attached before use.
3. **Detaching Guide Combs:** To remove a guide comb, gently pull it upwards from the clipper blade.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. **Turning On/Off:** Press the Power button to turn the clipper on. Press it again to turn it off.
2. **Adjusting Blade Length:** The clipper features four adjustable blade lengths (1.0mm, 1.3mm, 1.6mm, 1.9mm). Use the adjustment lever or button on the clipper body to select the desired length.
3. **Hair Cutting:**
 - Ensure hair is clean and dry before cutting.
 - For best results, comb the hair in the direction of growth.
 - Start with a longer guide comb than you think you need, and gradually switch to shorter combs if desired.
 - Hold the clipper with the blade flat against the head and move it slowly against the direction of hair growth.
 - Overlap strokes to ensure an even cut.

MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

- Cleaning the Blade:** After each use, turn off and unplug the clipper. Remove the guide comb. The blade head is removable and can be rinsed directly under running water. Use the included cleaning brush to remove any trapped hair or debris from the blades.

- Drying:** After rinsing, shake off excess water and allow the blade to air dry completely before reattaching it to the clipper body or storing.
- Lubrication:** Periodically, apply a few drops of clipper oil (not included, but generally recommended for clippers) to the blades to ensure smooth operation and prevent rust. Turn the clipper on for a few seconds to distribute the oil.
- Storage:** Store the clipper and its accessories in a dry, cool place, away from direct sunlight and moisture.

Important: When cleaning, ensure water does not contact the charging port to prevent damage.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Clipper does not turn on.	Battery is depleted.	Charge the clipper fully. Ensure the charging stand and adapter are properly connected.
Poor cutting performance or pulling hair.	Blades are dirty or dull. Hair buildup.	Clean the blades thoroughly. Lubricate the blades. If issues persist, consider professional sharpening or blade replacement (if available).
Clipper makes unusual noise.	Lack of lubrication. Debris in motor.	Apply clipper oil to the blades. Ensure no hair or debris is obstructing the motor area.
LCD display not working.	Battery issue or internal fault.	Ensure the clipper is charged. If the problem persists, contact customer support.
