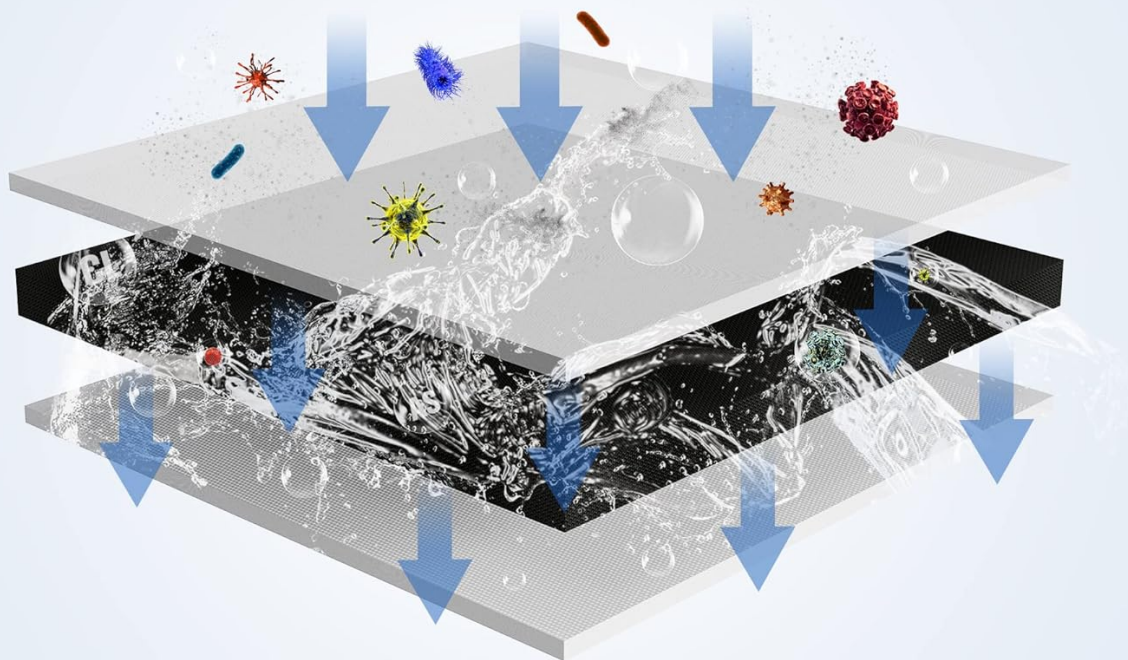

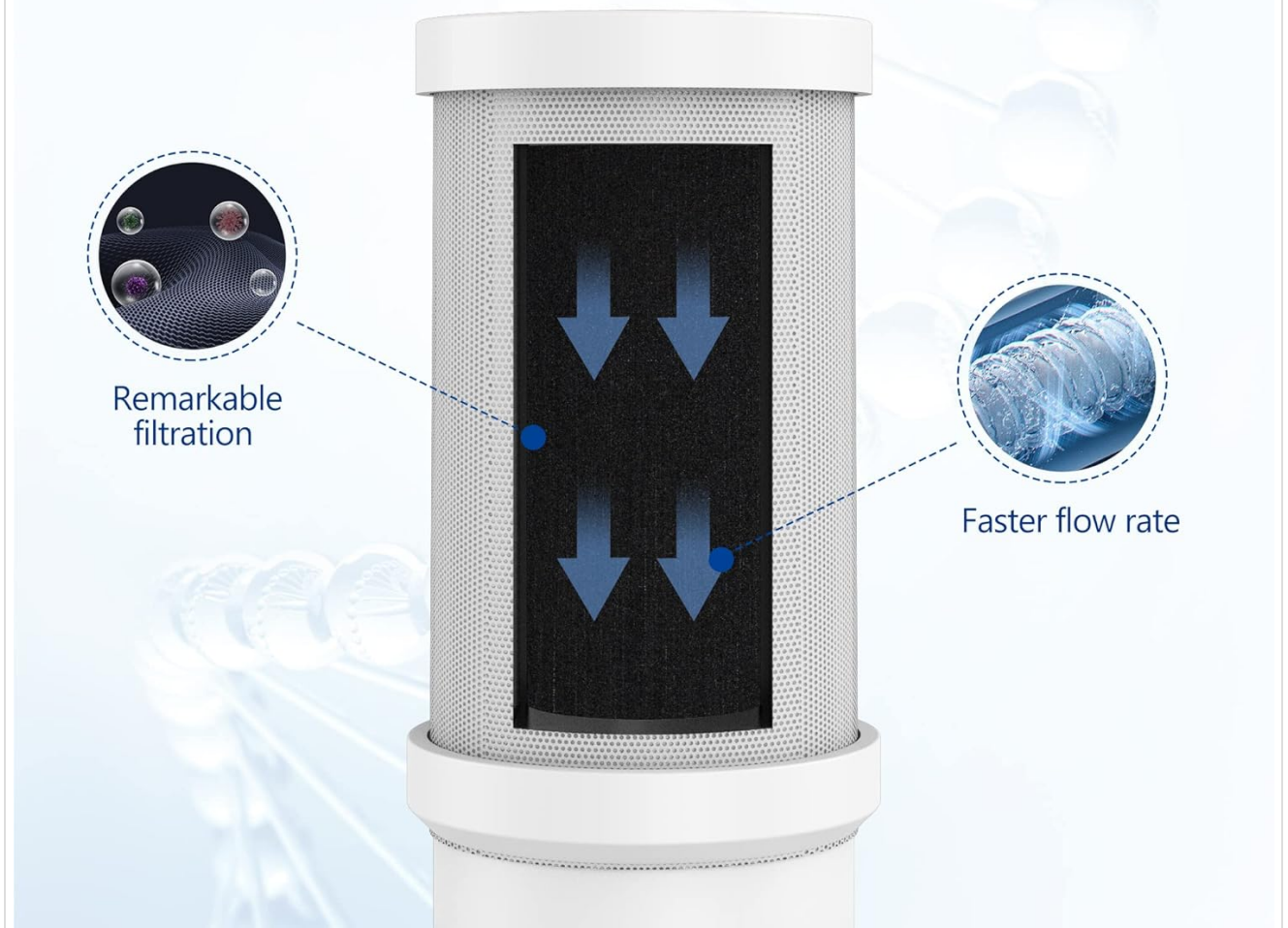


Figure 2.3: Coconut Carbon Block Filtration.

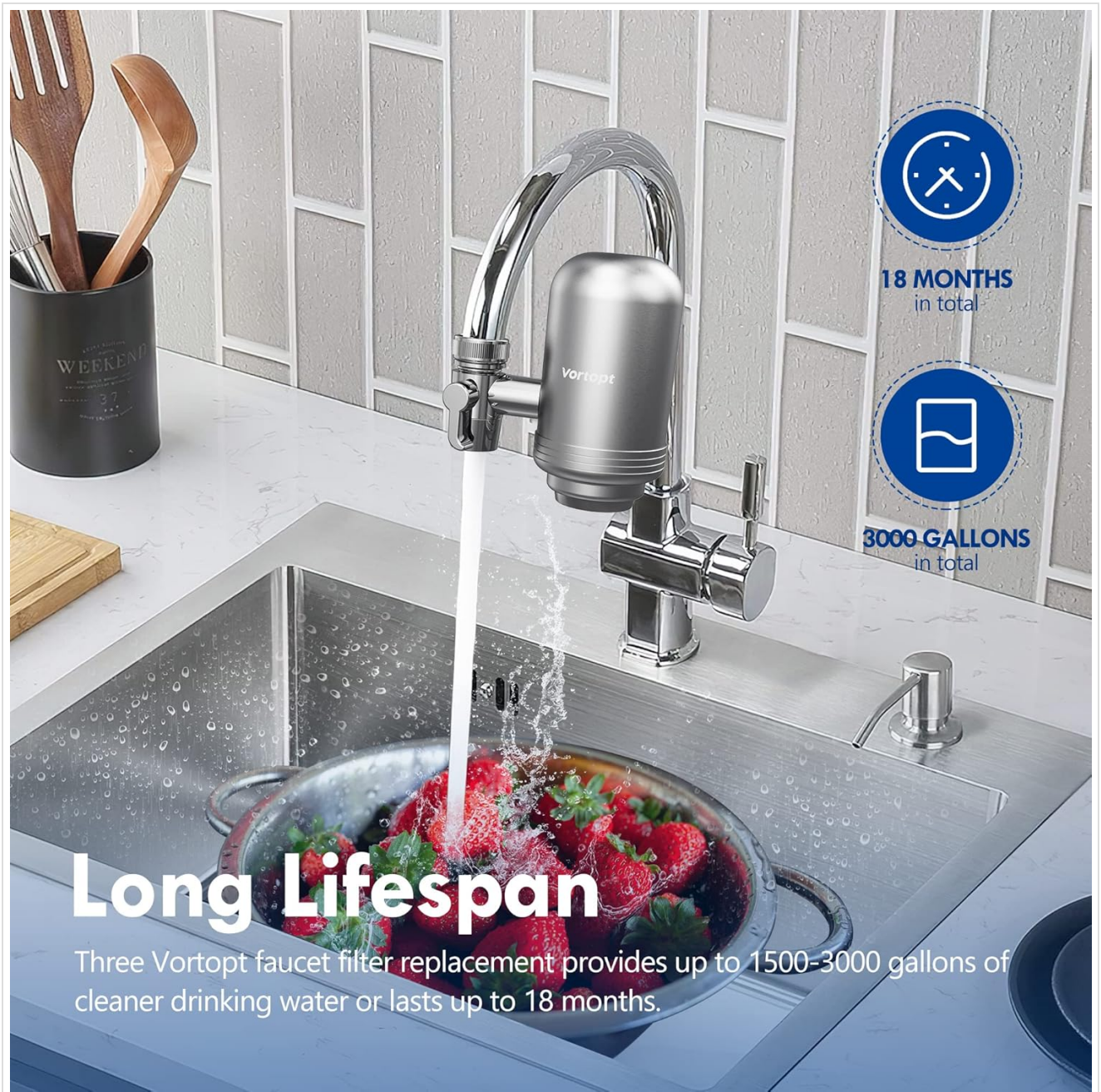


Figure 2.4: Filter Lifespan Illustration.

3. COMPATIBILITY AND INSTALLATION

3.1. Compatible Models

3.2. Installation Instructions

Follow these steps to replace your Vortopt faucet water filter:

1. Ensure the water supply to the faucet is turned off.
2. Carefully twist the back cover off your existing Vortopt faucet filter system.
3. Remove the old filter cartridge. Dispose of it responsibly.
4. Insert the new Vortopt replacement filter cartridge into the system, ensuring it is seated correctly.
5. Replace the back cover by twisting it securely back into place.
6. Turn on the water supply and flush the new filter for approximately 5 minutes to remove any carbon fines and prepare it for use.

4. OPERATION

Once installed, the Vortopt replacement filter operates automatically as water flows through your compatible faucet filtration system. The multi-stage filtration process immediately begins to reduce contaminants, providing clean, filtered water on demand.

No special operation is required beyond regular use of your faucet. Ensure the filter system is properly attached to the faucet for optimal performance.

5. MAINTENANCE

Regular filter replacement is crucial for maintaining optimal water quality and system performance. The lifespan of your filter depends on your water quality and usage volume.

- **Replacement Frequency:** Replace your Vortopt filter every 3 to 6 months, or after filtering approximately 400 gallons of water, whichever comes first.
- **Indicators:** A noticeable decrease in water flow rate or a return of unpleasant tastes or odors in the filtered water are indicators that the filter needs to be replaced.
- **Cleaning:** The filter cartridge itself does not require cleaning. Attempting to clean it may damage the filtration media and compromise its effectiveness.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you experience issues with your Vortopt faucet water filter system after replacing the filter, consider the following common solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Reduced Water Flow	New filter not fully flushed; air trapped in system; filter nearing end of life.	Flush new filter for 5 minutes. Ensure proper installation. If old filter, replace it.
Unpleasant Taste/Odor Returns	Filter has reached its capacity; improper installation.	Replace the filter. Re-install the filter, ensuring a secure fit.
Leaking from System	Filter not seated correctly; O-rings damaged or missing.	Ensure filter is twisted in tightly. Check O-rings for proper placement and condition.
