INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the FOHERE 3-in-1 Waffle Maker, Sandwich Maker, and Panini Press. This versatile appliance is designed to simplify your cooking experience, allowing you to prepare a variety of delicious meals with ease. Please read this manual thoroughly before operation to ensure safe and efficient use.

Important Safety Instructions

- Always unplug the appliance from the power outlet when not in use and before cleaning.
- Do not immerse the appliance, cord, or plug in water or any other liquid.
- Close supervision is necessary when any appliance is used by or near children.
- Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug, or after the appliance malfunctions or has been damaged in any manner.
- Do not use outdoors.
- Do not let the cord hang over the edge of a table or counter, or touch hot surfaces.
- Do not place on or near a hot gas or electric burner, or in a heated oven.
- Extreme caution must be used when moving an appliance containing hot oil or other hot liquids.
- Always attach the plug to the appliance first, then plug the cord into the wall outlet. To disconnect, turn any control to "off", then remove the plug from the wall outlet.
- Do not use the appliance for other than intended use.
- The appliance housing may become hot during operation. Use the cool-touch handle for opening and closing.

PRODUCT COMPONENTS

The FOHERE 3-in-1 appliance comes with interchangeable plates for various cooking needs.

- Main Unit: Features a stainless steel top cover, indicator lights (red for power, green for ready), and a temperature control knob.
- Cool-Touch Handle: Designed for safe opening and closing during operation.
- Removable Plates:
 - Waffle Plates: For making classic waffles.
 - Sandwich Plates: For sealing and toasting sandwiches.
 - Grill Plates: For grilling meats, vegetables, and paninis.

SETUP AND PLATE INSTALLATION

Before first use, wipe down the appliance exterior with a damp cloth. Wash the removable plates with warm, soapy water, rinse thoroughly, and dry completely. The plates are non-stick and easy to clean.

Installing/Removing Plates:

1. Ensure the appliance is unplugged and completely cool.
2. To remove a plate, locate the release buttons on the side of the appliance (as shown in the video). Press the button firmly, and the plate will pop out.
3. To install a plate, align the tabs on the back of the plate with the slots in the appliance. Slide the plate in until it clicks securely into place. Ensure both top and bottom plates are correctly installed.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The FOHERE 3-in-1 appliance features a 1200W heating system for fast and efficient cooking, along with a 5-gear temperature control for precise results.

1200 WATT POWERFUL

Enjoy a delicious breakfast in 5 minutes

Temperature Control and Indicator Lights:

- The appliance has an independent ON/OFF button and a 5-gear temperature control knob.
- Turn the knob to "0" to turn the appliance off.

- Settings 1-5 control the heating intensity, with 5 being the fastest heating.
- Red Indicator Light: Stays on when the appliance is plugged in and powered, indicating it is receiving electricity.
- Green Indicator Light: Illuminates when the appliance is preheating and turns off when the desired temperature is reached, indicating it is ready for cooking.

5 GEAR TEMPERATURE CONTROL

Using the Sandwich Maker:

1. Install the sandwich plates.
2. Plug in the appliance and set the temperature (typically 3-5 for sandwiches). The green light will turn off when preheated.
3. Lightly butter the bread (optional, for extra crispiness).
4. Place your sandwich ingredients between two slices of bread and place them on the bottom plate.
5. Close the lid and latch the handle. Cook for 3-5 minutes, or until golden brown and cheese is melted.

Using the Waffle Maker:

1. Install the waffle plates.
2. Plug in the appliance and set the temperature (typically 4-5 for waffles). Allow it to preheat until the green light turns off.
3. Pour waffle batter onto the center of each waffle plate, ensuring not to overfill.
4. Close the lid and latch the handle. Cook for 3-6 minutes, or until waffles are golden brown and crispy.

Using the Panini Press / Electric Grill:

1. Install the grill plates.
2. Plug in the appliance and set the temperature (typically 4-5 for grilling). Allow it to preheat until the green light turns off.
3. Place desired food items (e.g., steak, chicken, vegetables, paninis) directly onto the grill plates.
4. Close the lid. Cooking time will vary depending on the food item and desired doneness.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

Proper care ensures the longevity and performance of your FOHERE appliance. The non-stick plates are designed for easy cleaning.

Cleaning:

- Always unplug the appliance and allow it to cool completely before cleaning.
- Remove the cooking plates. These plates are Teflon-coated, high-quality non-stick, water, and oil repellent.
- Wash the plates with warm, soapy water using a soft sponge or cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners or scouring pads that could damage the non-stick coating.
- Rinse thoroughly and dry completely before re-installing or storing.
- The plates are dishwasher safe for added convenience.
- Wipe the exterior of the appliance with a damp cloth. Do not immerse the main unit in water.

Storage:

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Appliance does not turn on.	Not plugged in; Power outlet malfunction; Temperature knob set to "0".	Ensure the appliance is securely plugged into a working outlet. Check the temperature knob is set to a number (1-5).
Food is not cooking evenly or quickly.	Temperature setting is too low; Insufficient preheating time.	Increase the temperature setting. Allow the appliance to fully preheat until the green indicator light turns off.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Plates are difficult to remove or install.	Plates are not aligned correctly; Release buttons not fully pressed.	Ensure the tabs on the plates are correctly aligned with the slots. Press the release buttons firmly until the plate disengages.
Food sticks to the plates.	Plates not properly seasoned (for first use); Excessive sugar in batter (for waffles); Plates not clean.	Ensure plates are clean. For waffles, reduce sugar content if sticking persists. While non-stick, a light brush of oil or butter can be used if needed.


