1. INTRODUCTION

The Oral-B iO Series 9 Electric Toothbrush represents a significant advancement in oral care technology. It combines powerful yet gentle micro-vibrations with Oral-B's unique dentist-inspired round brush head design to deliver a professional clean feeling every day. Key features include a Smart Pressure Sensor to protect gums and enamel, 3D Teeth Tracking with AI Recognition via an interactive color display, and a built-in 2-minute quadrant timer for comprehensive cleaning. This manual will guide you through setting up, operating, and maintaining your new Oral-B iO Series 9 toothbrush to ensure optimal performance and oral health.

2. WHAT'S IN THE BOX

Your Oral-B iO Series 9 package includes the following components:

- Oral-B iO Series 9 Power Handle
- 4 Oral-B iO Series Brush Heads
- Magnetic Charger
- Charging Travel Case

The toothbrush handle features an interactive color display for selecting cleaning settings and tracking progress.

3. SETUP

3.1 Initial Charging

Before first use, fully charge your Oral-B iO Series 9 toothbrush. Place the handle on the magnetic charger. A full charge typically takes approximately 3 hours. The display will indicate the battery level.

3.2 Attaching the Brush Head

Align the brush head with the metal shaft on the handle and push it down until it clicks into place.

3.3 Connecting to the Oral-B App

For a personalized brushing experience, download the Oral-B app on your smartphone. The toothbrush connects via Bluetooth. The app tracks your brushing habits, provides real-time feedback, and helps ensure you don't miss any spots.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Powering On/Off and Mode Selection

Press the power button to turn the toothbrush on. Use the mode selection button to cycle through the 7 available cleaning modes: Daily Clean, Sensitive, Gum Care, Intense, Whiten, Super Sensitive, and Tongue Clean. The interactive display will show the selected mode.

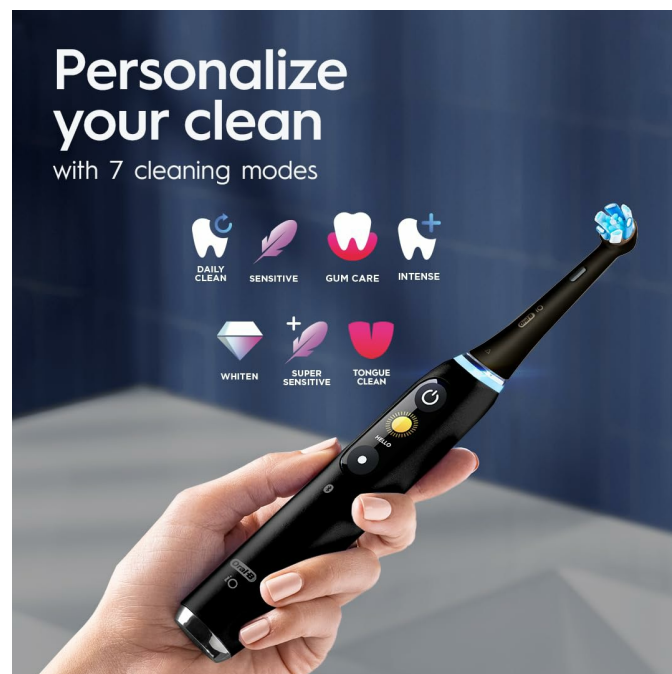


Figure 4.1: Personalize your clean with 7 cleaning modes.

4.2 Smart Pressure Sensor

The iO pressure sensor helps protect your gums and enamel. The light ring on the handle changes color to provide real-time feedback:

- **Green:** Optimal pressure.
- **Red:** Too much pressure (reduce pressure to avoid damage).

- **Blue/White:** Too little pressure (increase pressure for effective cleaning).

4.3 2-Minute Timer and Quadrant Pacer

The toothbrush features a built-in 2-minute timer that pulsates every 30 seconds, signaling when to move to the next quadrant of your mouth. This ensures a complete and thorough clean as recommended by dentists.

5. MAINTENANCE

5.1 Cleaning the Toothbrush

After each use, rinse the brush head thoroughly under running water with the handle still switched on. Remove the brush head and rinse both the brush head and the handle separately. Wipe the handle dry with a soft cloth. Do not immerse the charger in water.

5.2 Replacing Brush Heads

Replace your Oral-B iO Series Replacement Brush Heads every 3 months for best results, or sooner if the bristles are splayed or worn. The toothbrush display will provide a timely refill head alert.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your Oral-B iO Series 9 toothbrush, please refer to the following common solutions:

- **Toothbrush not charging:** Ensure the magnetic charger is properly connected to a power source and the toothbrush handle is correctly seated on the charger.
- **Brush head not vibrating:** Check if the brush head is securely attached to the handle. If the issue persists, try a different brush head.
- **App connectivity issues:** Ensure Bluetooth is enabled on your smartphone and the Oral-B app is updated to the latest version. Restarting both the toothbrush and your phone may resolve connection problems.
- **Pressure sensor light not working:** Ensure the toothbrush is powered on and you are applying pressure to the brush head. If the light remains unresponsive, contact customer support.
