## INTRODUCTION

The set includes one exclusive fingerboard, one pair of removable skate shoes, and the Taco Truck playset with various stunt features and storage options.

- 1 Exclusive Hot Wheels Skate Fingerboard
- 1 Pair of Hot Wheels Skate Shoes
- Assorted removable ramps and rails (picnic table, grind rail, rear ramp)

## SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

1. **Unpack Components:** Carefully remove all items from the packaging.
2. **Prepare the Truck:**
  - The Taco Truck serves as the base of your skatepark.
  - The rooftop taco can be used as a handle for portability or as a stunt feature.
3. **Attach Rear Ramp:**
  - Locate the rear door of the truck.
  - Open the rear door and attach the gray ramp piece to create a quarter-pipe. This piece can also be reversed to form a flat ramp.

### **4. Set Up Grind Rail:**

- Pull out the orange grind rail from the side of the truck. This rail can be positioned at various angles for different tricks.

### **5. Position Picnic Table:**

- Place the included picnic table accessory anywhere on your play surface to create additional obstacles for tricks.

## 6. Prepare Fingerboard and Shoes:

- The exclusive fingerboard comes with removable skate shoes.
- To use the shoes, slide your fingers into them and then clip the shoes onto the fingerboard. This helps beginners control the board.
- The shoes can be removed for advanced play or to use with other Hot Wheels Skate boards.

- **Grind Rail:** Practice various grind tricks on the extendable orange rail.
- **Picnic Table:** The included picnic table is ideal for practicing ollies, flips, and other street-style tricks.

## STORAGE

The Taco Truck Play Case is designed for convenient storage and portability:



- **Internal Storage:** The truck's interior is hollow, allowing you to store the picnic table, ramps, and other small accessories inside.
- **Board Storage:** The sides of the truck feature clips to store up to six fingerboards. The included board storage rack can also hold multiple fingerboards.
- **Skate Shoe Storage:** The removable skate shoes can be stored on the truck itself or within the internal compartment.
- **Portability:** Use the rooftop taco as a handle to easily transport the entire playset.
