Turtle Beach Stealth 600 Gen 2 MAX Wireless Gaming Headset

Introduction

This manual provides essential instructions for the setup, operation, and maintenance of your Turtle Beach Stealth 600 Gen 2 MAX Wireless Gaming Headset. Please read this guide thoroughly to ensure optimal performance and longevity of your device.

The Stealth 600 Gen 2 MAX offers versatile connectivity, dynamic audio, and a comfortable design for extended gaming sessions.

Package Contents

Verify that all items are present in your package:

- Turtle Beach Stealth 600 Gen 2 MAX Headset
- USB Type-C Wireless Transmitter
- USB Charging Cable
- Quick Start Guide (this document)

Setup

1. Charging the Headset

Before first use, fully charge your headset. Connect the supplied USB charging cable to the headset's USB Type-C port and to a powered USB port (e.g., on your console, PC, or a USB wall adapter). The LED indicator on the headset will show charging status. A full charge provides approximately 48+ hours of game time.

2. Connecting to Devices (Wireless)

The Stealth 600 Gen 2 MAX uses a USB Type-C wireless transmitter for primary connectivity.

1. Insert the USB Type-C wireless transmitter into an available USB port on your gaming console (PS5, PS4, Nintendo Switch in docked mode) or PC.
2. Power on your headset by pressing and holding the Power button until you hear a tone and the LED illuminates.
3. The headset and transmitter should automatically pair. A solid LED on both devices indicates a successful connection.

3. Connecting to Devices (Bluetooth)

For mobile devices, tablets, and other Bluetooth-enabled systems, use Bluetooth 5.0 connectivity.

1. With the headset powered on, press and hold the Bluetooth button until the LED flashes blue rapidly. This indicates pairing mode.
2. On your device, navigate to Bluetooth settings and select "Stealth 600 Gen 2 MAX" from the list of available devices.
3. Once connected, the headset LED will show a solid blue light.

Operating the Headset

Controls Overview

- **Power Button:** Press and hold to power on/off. Short press for battery status.
- **Volume Dial:** Adjusts overall game and chat volume.
- **Mic Monitoring Dial:** Adjusts the volume of your own voice heard in the headset.
- **Mode Button:** Cycles through audio presets.
- **Bluetooth Button:** Press and hold to enter Bluetooth pairing mode. Short press to play/pause media or answer/end calls.

Microphone Usage

The integrated flip-to-mute microphone provides clear communication. To activate the microphone, flip it down. To mute, flip it up. A distinct click indicates the mute/unmute action.

Maintenance

Cleaning

To maintain the headset's condition, gently wipe the earcups and headband with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials. Ensure the headset is powered off and disconnected from any power source before cleaning.

Storage

Store the headset in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. Avoid placing heavy objects on the headset to prevent damage.

Troubleshooting

- **No Audio / Low Volume:**
 - Ensure the headset is powered on and fully charged.
 - Check both the headset's volume dial and your device's audio output settings.
 - Verify the wireless transmitter is securely connected and paired.
- **Microphone Not Working:**
 - Ensure the microphone is flipped down to the 'unmuted' position.
 - Check your device's microphone input settings.
 - Adjust the Mic Monitoring dial to ensure you can hear your own voice.
- **Connectivity Issues:**
 - For wireless, ensure the transmitter is correctly inserted and the headset is within range.
 - For Bluetooth, ensure the headset is in pairing mode and your device's Bluetooth is enabled.
 - Try restarting both the headset and the connected device.
 - Check the Turtle Beach support website for any available firmware updates for your headset.
