
The WEWATCH V51-PS07 projector package includes essential accessories for immediate setup, such as a high-quality 120-inch projection screen, along with 3M adhesive stickers and hooks for easy installation of the screen.

1.2 Projector Placement

Choose a flat, stable surface for your projector. Ensure there is adequate ventilation around the device. The projection distance will determine the screen size. For optimal viewing, a projection distance that yields a 120-inch screen is recommended, though the projector supports up to 450 inches.

1.3 Power Connection

Connect the power cable to the projector's power input port and then plug the other end into a standard electrical outlet. The power indicator light will illuminate.

2. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

2.1 Power On/Off

Press the power button on the projector or the remote control to turn the unit on or off.

2.2 Focus and Keystone Adjustment

- **Focus:** Rotate the focus ring on the projector lens until the image appears sharp and clear.
- **Keystone Correction:** Use the remote control to access the keystone correction settings. The projector supports advanced $\pm 50^\circ$ 4-Point Keystone Correction to adjust the image shape if the projector is not perfectly perpendicular to the screen.

2.3 Input Source Selection

Press the 'Source' button on the remote control or the projector to cycle through available input sources (HDMI1, HDMI2, USB1, USB2, VGA, AV).

2.4 Connecting External Devices

- **HDMI:** Connect your laptop, gaming console, or streaming device (e.g., Fire TV Stick, Roku) to one of the HDMI ports.
- **USB:** Insert a USB drive into a USB port to play media files directly.
- **VGA/AV:** Use these ports for older devices or specific audio/video connections.

2.5 Bluetooth Audio Connection


The projector supports Bluetooth 5.0. Navigate to the Bluetooth settings in the projector's menu to pair with external Bluetooth speakers or headphones for an enhanced audio experience.

2.6 Wi-Fi Connection and Screen Mirroring

Connect the projector to your home Wi-Fi network (supports 5G+2.4G dual band) via the network settings. Once connected, you can use screen mirroring features (e.g., AirPlay for iOS, Miracast for Android) to project content wirelessly from your smartphone or tablet.

2.7 Streaming Device Compatibility

The WEWATCH V51-PS07 is fully compatible with popular streaming devices such as Fire TV Stick and Roku. Simply plug your streaming device into an HDMI port to access a vast library of movies, TV shows, and other online content.

3. MAINTENANCE

- **Exterior:** Wipe the projector's exterior with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use liquid cleaners directly on the device.
- **Ventilation:** Ensure the ventilation vents are clear of dust and debris to prevent overheating. Use a soft brush or compressed air to clean them periodically.

3.2 Storage

When not in use, store the projector in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. If possible, use the original packaging or a protective case to prevent dust accumulation and physical damage.

4. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your WEWATCH V51-PS07 Projector, please refer to the following common solutions:

Problem	Possible Solution
No image on screen	Check power connection. Ensure correct input source is selected. Verify HDMI/VGA cable connection.
Image is blurry	Adjust the focus ring on the lens. Ensure the projection distance is within recommended range.
Image is distorted (trapezoid shape)	Use the keystone correction feature in the settings menu. Adjust the projector's angle relative to the screen.
No sound	Increase volume on projector and connected device. Check audio cable connections (if applicable). Ensure Bluetooth is correctly paired if using external speakers.
Wi-Fi/Bluetooth connection issues	Ensure devices are within range. Restart the projector and the device you are trying to connect. Check Wi-Fi password and network stability.



