1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Blackview K1 Bluetooth Keyboard with Touchpad. This manual provides detailed instructions on how to set up, operate, and maintain your keyboard to ensure optimal performance and longevity. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the product.

Safety Information

- Keep the keyboard away from water, moisture, and extreme temperatures.
- Do not attempt to disassemble or repair the keyboard yourself. Contact qualified service personnel if needed.
- Use only the provided USB cable for charging.
- Avoid dropping or subjecting the keyboard to strong impacts.

Key Features

3. SETUP

Charging the Keyboard

1. Connect the small end of the provided USB cable to the charging port on the keyboard (usually located on the top edge).
2. Connect the other end of the USB cable to a USB power adapter (not included) or a computer's USB port.
3. The charging indicator light will illuminate (e.g., red) during charging and turn off or change color when fully charged.
4. A full charge typically takes 2-3 hours.

Bluetooth Pairing

1. Ensure the keyboard is fully charged.

2. Turn on the keyboard by sliding the power switch (located on the top right of the keyboard). The power indicator light will briefly flash.
3. Press the 'Connect' button (often located near the 'C' key or a dedicated Bluetooth pairing button) to put the keyboard into pairing mode. The Bluetooth indicator light will start blinking rapidly.
4. On your device (tablet, smartphone, computer), go to the Bluetooth settings.
5. Enable Bluetooth and search for available devices.
6. Select "Blackview K1" or a similar name from the list of found devices.
7. If prompted, enter the pairing code displayed on your device using the keyboard and press Enter.
8. Once paired, the Bluetooth indicator light on the keyboard will stop blinking and remain solid or turn off, indicating a successful connection.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Basic Keyboard Functions

The Blackview K1 keyboard functions like a standard QWERTY keyboard. Simply type as you normally would. The integrated touchpad allows for mouse-like cursor control and gesture input.

Operating System Switching

The keyboard supports multiple operating systems. Use the following key combinations to switch modes for optimal compatibility:

- **Fn + Q:** Switch to Android system mode.
- **Fn + W:** Switch to Windows system mode.
- **Fn + E:** Switch to iOS system mode.

Touchpad Functions

The touchpad supports various gestures for enhanced navigation:

- **Single Finger Tap:** Left-click.
- **Two Finger Tap:** Right-click (context menu).
- **Two Finger Scroll:** Scroll up/down or left/right.
- **Pinch to Zoom:** Zoom in/out (supported by some applications).
- **Three Finger Swipe Up:** Show all open applications (Windows/Android).
- **Three Finger Swipe Down:** Show desktop (Windows/Android).

Function Keys (Fn Combinations)

The top row of keys (F1-F12) can be used as standard function keys or multimedia/shortcut keys when combined with the 'Fn' key.

5. MAINTENANCE

Cleaning

- Turn off the keyboard before cleaning.
- Use a soft, lint-free cloth slightly dampened with water or a mild cleaning solution to wipe the surface.
- Do not use harsh chemicals, abrasives, or solvents.
- Use compressed air to remove dust and debris from between the keys.

Storage

- Store the keyboard in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight.
- If storing for an extended period, ensure the keyboard is fully charged before storage and recharge it every few months to maintain battery health.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Blackview K1 keyboard, please refer to the following table for common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Keyboard does not turn on.	Battery is low or dead.	Charge the keyboard for at least 30 minutes.
Keyboard does not pair with device.	Keyboard not in pairing mode; Bluetooth off on device; device too far.	Ensure keyboard is in pairing mode (blinking light). Turn on device's Bluetooth. Move keyboard closer to device (within 10 meters). Try unpairing and re-pairing.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Keys are not responding.	Loose connection; incorrect OS mode; low battery.	Ensure keyboard is paired. Switch to the correct OS mode (Fn+Q/W/E). Recharge the keyboard.
Touchpad is not working.	Touchpad disabled; software issue.	Ensure touchpad is enabled (if there's a toggle). Restart the keyboard and device. Check device settings for touchpad options.
Input lag or disconnections.	Interference; low battery; distance.	Move away from other wireless devices. Recharge keyboard. Reduce distance between keyboard and device.
