INTRODUCTION

This user guide provides detailed instructions for viewing the movie **Terminator (Subtitled Version)** on Amazon Prime Video. It covers how to access the content, use playback controls, manage subtitles and audio, and troubleshoot common issues. For the best viewing experience, ensure your device and internet connection meet Prime Video's requirements.

ACCESSING THE MOVIE (SETUP)

- Open Prime Video:** Launch the Amazon Prime Video application on your smart TV, streaming device, computer, or mobile device. Alternatively, visit amazon.co.jp/primevideo in your web browser.
- Sign In:** If prompted, sign in with your Amazon account credentials.
- Search for the Movie:**
 - Use the search bar (usually represented by a magnifying glass icon) and type "Terminator (Subtitled Version)".
 - You can also search using the ASIN: **B0B5VT43K6**.
- Select and Play:** Click or tap on the movie title from the search results. On the movie's detail page, select the "Watch Now" or "Play" button to begin streaming.

PLAYBACK CONTROLS (OPERATING)

During playback, various controls are available to enhance your viewing experience. These controls typically appear when you move your mouse (on a computer) or tap the screen (on a mobile device/tablet) or use your remote control (on a TV/streaming device).

- **Play/Pause:** A single click or tap on the screen, or pressing the play/pause button on your remote, will toggle between playing and pausing the movie.
- **Fast Forward/Rewind:** Use the progress bar to drag to a specific point, or use the dedicated fast forward/rewind buttons on your remote. On some devices, tapping the left/right side of the screen may skip backward/forward by a few seconds.
- **Volume Control:** Adjust the volume using your device's volume buttons or the volume slider within the Prime

Video player interface.

- **Full Screen:** Select the full-screen icon (often two arrows pointing outwards) to expand the video to fill your screen. Select it again (or press Esc on a keyboard) to exit full-screen mode.

SUBTITLES AND AUDIO

To manage language options:

1. During playback, access the playback controls.
2. Look for the "Subtitles" or "Audio & Subtitles" icon (often a speech bubble or a square with lines).
3. **Subtitles:** Select "Subtitles" and choose your preferred language. This version is specifically "Subtitled Version".
4. **Audio Language:** Select "Audio" and choose "English" as the available audio track.

TROUBLESHOOTING COMMON ISSUES

If you encounter problems while streaming, consider the following solutions:

- **Buffering or Poor Quality:**
 - Check your internet connection speed. A stable, high-speed connection is required for optimal streaming.
 - Reduce the number of devices using your internet connection simultaneously.
 - Try lowering the video quality setting within the Prime Video player, if available.
- **No Sound or Video:**
 - Ensure your device's volume is turned up and not muted.
 - Restart the Prime Video application or your streaming device.
 - Check if other applications or videos on your device have sound/video.
- **App Crashing or Freezing:**
 - Close and reopen the Prime Video application.
 - Ensure your Prime Video app and device operating system are up to date.
 - Clear the cache for the Prime Video app in your device settings.
