## **PRODUCT OVERVIEW**

The Livex Lighting Clarion 5-Light Linear Chandelier (Model 49275-46) is a contemporary lighting fixture designed to enhance various indoor spaces. This chandelier features a black chrome finish, an angular frame, and clear cylinder glass shades, providing a sleek and sophisticated aesthetic. It is designed for dry rated indoor use and accommodates five incandescent bulbs.

## IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read and understand all instructions before beginning installation. Failure to do so may result in electric shock, fire, or other injuries that could be fatal or cause property damage. All electrical connections must be in accordance with local codes, ordinances, or the National Electric Code (NEC). If you are unfamiliar with electrical wiring, consult a qualified electrician.

- ALWAYS disconnect power at the main circuit breaker or fuse box before installation or servicing.
- Do not install this fixture in wet or damp locations. It is rated for dry indoor use only.
- Ensure all wiring connections are secure and properly insulated.
- Do not exceed the maximum wattage specified for the bulbs.
- Handle glass components with care to prevent breakage.

## SETUP AND INSTALLATION

#### **Unpacking and Inspection**

Carefully unpack the fixture and its components. Retain all packaging materials until installation is complete and the fixture is operating correctly. Inspect the fixture for any damage that may have occurred during shipping. If any parts are missing or damaged, do not attempt to install the fixture. Contact Livex Lighting customer support immediately.

# **Installation Steps**

- 1. **Turn off Power:** Locate the circuit breaker or fuse box that supplies power to the installation location and turn off the power. Verify that the power is off using a voltage tester.
- 2. **Prepare Mounting:** Attach the mounting bracket to the electrical junction box in the ceiling. Ensure it is securely fastened.
- 3. **Wire Connections:** Connect the fixture's electrical wires to the corresponding house wires (black to black, white to white, ground to ground) using wire nuts. Secure connections with electrical tape.
- 4. **Secure Fixture:** Carefully lift the fixture and attach it to the mounting bracket, securing it with the provided screws or nuts. Ensure the fixture is stable and level.
- 5. **Install Glass Shades and Bulbs:** Gently attach the clear cylinder glass shades to the fixture. Insert five E26 Medium base incandescent bulbs (up to 60 watts each, 300 watts total) into the sockets.

# **OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS**

Once installed, the Livex Lighting Clarion Chandelier operates via a standard wall switch. Ensure the wall switch connected to the fixture is in the "ON" position to provide power to the chandelier.

- Turning On/Off: Use the wall switch to control the power to the chandelier.
- **Bulb Replacement:** To replace a bulb, first turn off power at the circuit breaker. Allow bulbs to cool completely. Unscrew the old bulb and screw in a new E26 Medium base incandescent bulb, ensuring it does not exceed 60 watts.
- **Control Methods:** While primarily controlled by a wall switch, some installations may integrate with app-based or push-button control systems. Consult your electrician or smart home system manual for specific integration details if applicable.

## **M**AINTENANCE

Regular maintenance will help preserve the appearance and functionality of your chandelier.

- Cleaning: To clean the fixture, ensure power is off. Wipe the metal surfaces with a soft, dry cloth. For the glass shades, use a mild glass cleaner applied to a cloth, then wipe the glass. Avoid abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals that may damage the finish or glass.
- **Bulb Check:** Periodically check bulbs for signs of wear or dimming. Replace as needed with bulbs of the correct type and wattage.
- Connection Check: Annually, or if issues arise, have a qualified electrician check electrical connections for tightness and integrity.

## **TROUBLESHOOTING**

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Light does not turn on.	No power to the fixture; loose wiring; faulty bulb; tripped circuit breaker.	Check wall switch and circuit breaker. Ensure power is on. Verify all wire connections are secure. Replace bulb.
Light flickers.	Loose bulb; incorrect bulb type; loose wiring connection.	Tighten bulb. Ensure correct bulb type and wattage. Check wiring connections (with power off).
Humming noise from fixture.	Incompatible dimmer switch; loose components.	Ensure dimmer switch is compatible with incandescent bulbs. Check for any loose parts within the fixture.

If troubleshooting steps do not resolve the issue, contact a qualified electrician or Livex Lighting customer support.
