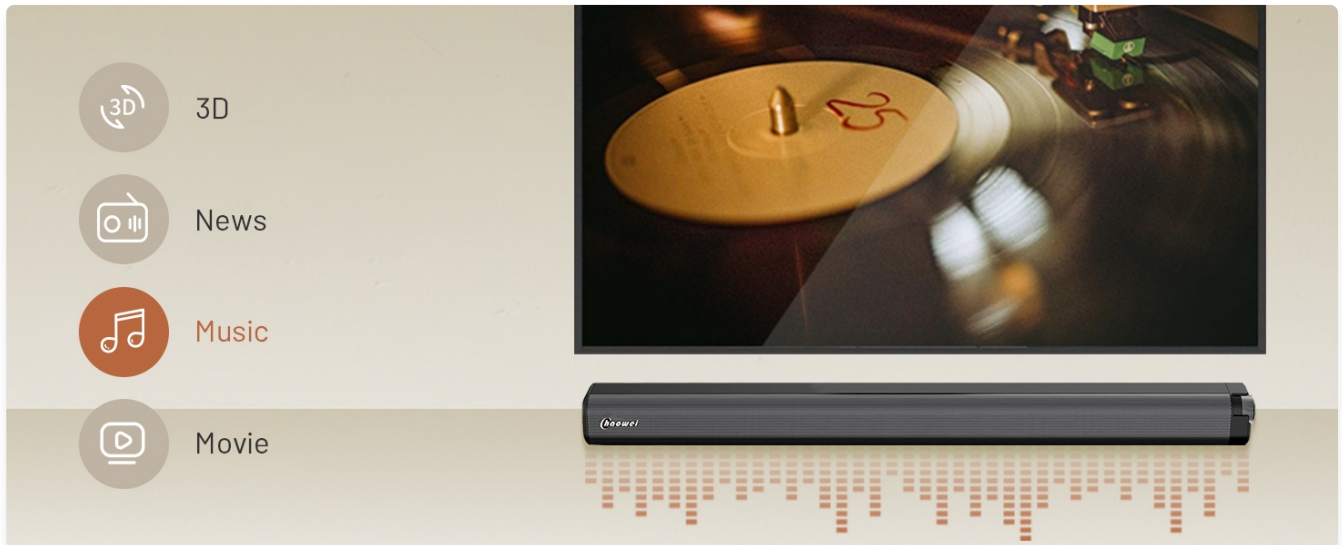

INITIAL SETUP

Placement

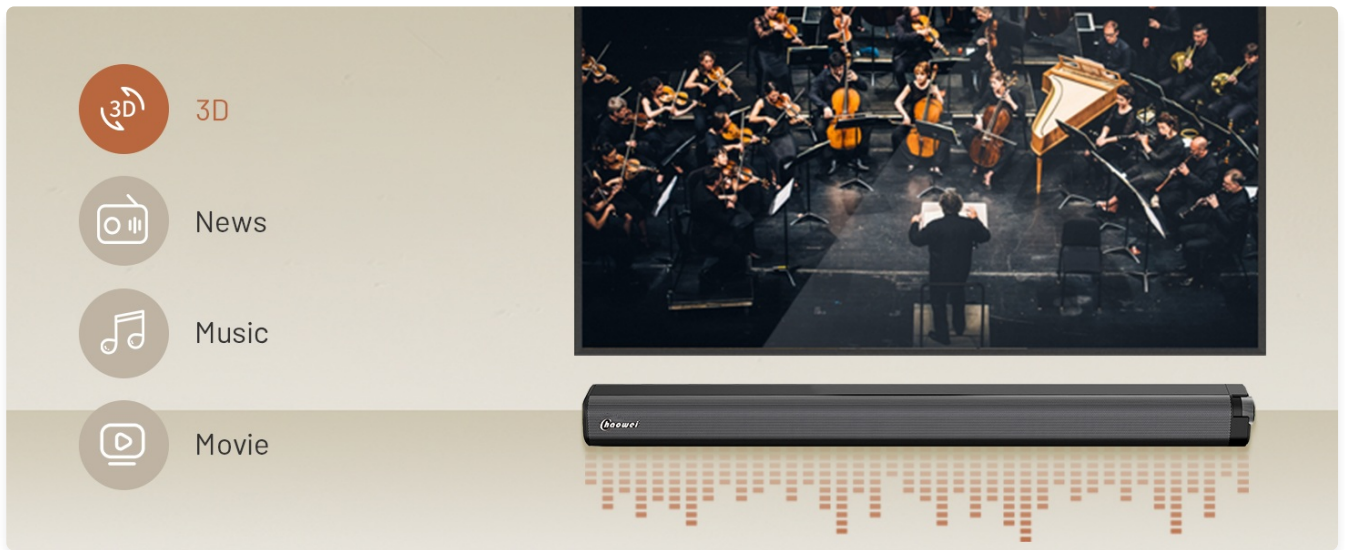

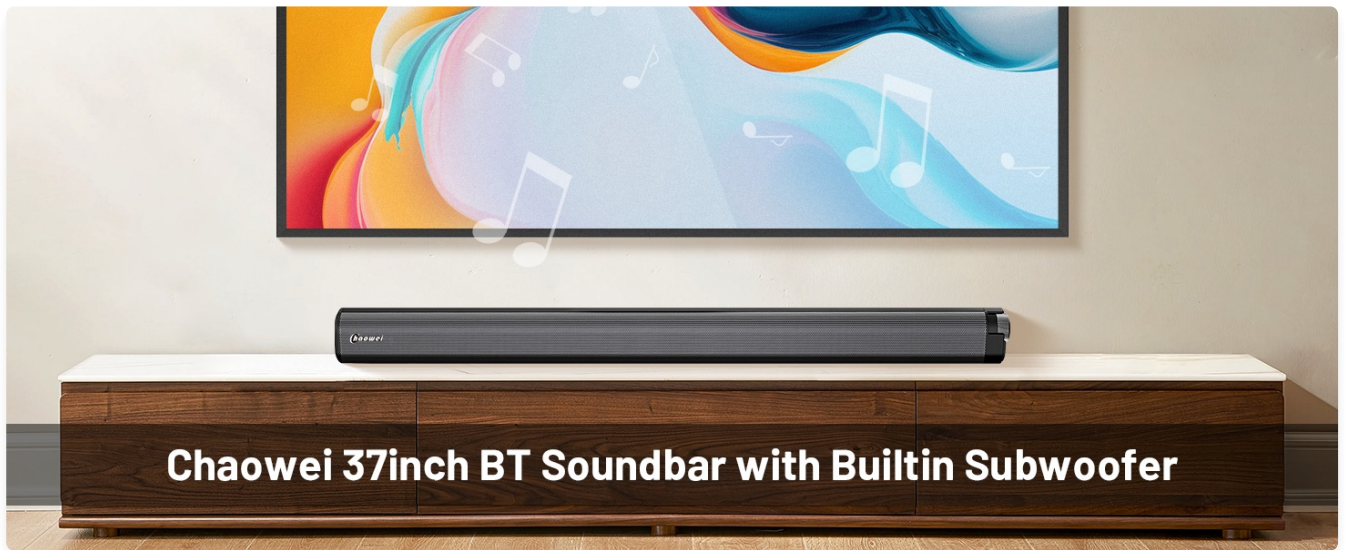

HDMI (ARC) Connection

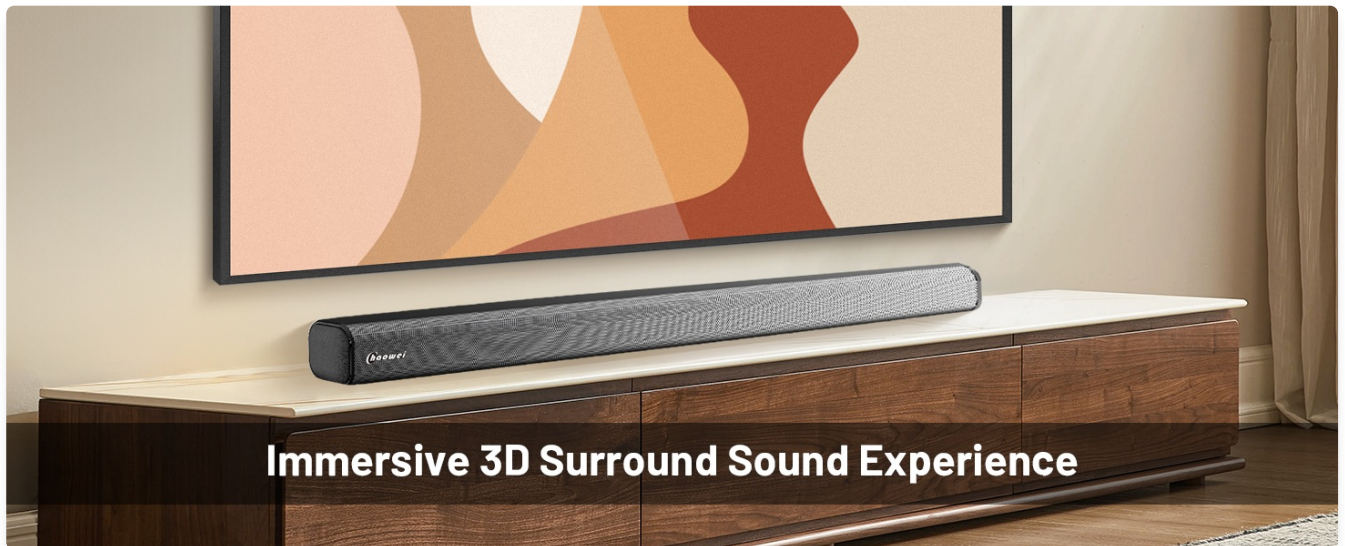
For the best audio quality and TV remote integration, use the HDMI (ARC) port. Ensure your TV also supports HDMI ARC.

Optical Connection

If your TV does not support HDMI ARC, the Optical connection is an excellent alternative for high-quality digital audio.

AUX Connection

The AUX connection provides a simple and universal way to connect audio devices using a 3.5mm stereo jack cable.

HDMI(ARC) Connecting:

1. Make sure TV and soundbar is both "HDMI mode",and cable connected HDMI(ARC) port.
2. Audio out setting is"External Speaker"—"HDMI ARC"—"PCM or Passthrough" (audio output of Samsung TV may "receiver").
3. TV setting "HDMI-CEC" is "ON"
4. HDMI cable is no less than HDMI 2.0 version,poor HDMI cable will be no sound or poor sound.

Optical Connecting:

1. Make sure TV and soundbar is both "Optical mode"
2. Audio out format of TV is "PCM"

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

- Clean the surface with a soft, dry cloth. Avoid using abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- Do not block the ventilation openings on the sound bar.
- Avoid placing heavy objects on top of the sound bar.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your sound bar, please refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No Sound	Incorrect input mode selected.	Ensure the sound bar's input mode matches the connection type (e.g., HDMI ARC, Optical, AUX).
No Sound	TV audio output settings are incorrect.	Set your TV's audio output to "External Speaker" or "PCM" (for Optical/AUX).
No Sound	Cables are not securely connected.	Check all audio cables (HDMI, Optical, AUX) for secure connections.
No Sound	Sound bar is muted or volume is too low.	Increase the volume on both the sound bar and your TV. Ensure the sound bar is not muted.
Bluetooth Pairing Issues	Device is out of range or not in pairing mode.	Ensure your Bluetooth device is within 15 feet of the sound bar. Put the sound bar into Bluetooth pairing mode (BT).
Poor Sound Quality	Incorrect EQ mode or audio source quality.	Adjust the EQ mode (Movie, Music, News, Symphony) to suit your content. Ensure the audio source is of good quality.
Remote Control Not Working	Batteries are low or inserted incorrectly.	Replace the AAA batteries in the remote control. Ensure they are inserted with correct polarity.
Remote Control Not Working	Obstruction between remote and sound bar.	Ensure there is a clear line of sight between the remote control and the sound bar's sensor.
