INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the GAZHOME Twin Size Bed Frame. This manual provides essential information for the safe assembly, operation, and maintenance of your new bed frame. Please read these instructions carefully before beginning assembly and retain them for future reference.

SAFETY INFORMATION

- Always assemble the bed frame on a soft, clean surface to prevent damage to the product or your floor.
- Ensure all parts are present and undamaged before assembly. Do not use if any parts are missing or broken.
- Tighten all bolts and screws securely, but do not overtighten until instructed.
- Regularly check all connections to ensure they remain tight. Loose connections can lead to instability and injury.
- Do not allow children to climb on the bed frame or drawers.
- Distribute weight evenly on the bed frame. The maximum weight recommendation is 1200 lbs (544.31 kg).
- Keep small parts away from children during assembly to prevent choking hazards.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The GAZHOME Twin Size Bed Frame is designed for comfort and functionality, featuring a sturdy metal frame, a two-tier storage headboard, and two large storage drawers. It offers strong metal slat support, eliminating the need for a box spring.

Key Features:

- **Strong & Sturdy Metal Frame:** Constructed from selected steel with anti-rust finish paint, capable of supporting up to 1200 lbs (544.31 kg). Includes rubber strips on slats for noise prevention.
- **Integrated Storage Headboard:** A two-tier headboard provides convenient space for items like phones, glasses, books, or decorative pieces.
- **Two XL Storage Drawers:** Two large drawers offer ample under-bed storage, designed to be moved left or right as needed.
- **No Box Spring Needed:** The robust metal slat system provides direct support for your mattress.
- **Easy Assembly:** Comes with a complete hardware kit and detailed instructions for straightforward setup.

PARTS LIST

Before assembly, ensure all components are present. Refer to the included assembly diagram for specific part identification.

- Bed Frame Components (Headboard, Footboard, Side Rails, Support Legs)

- Metal Slats
- 2 Storage Drawers (including drawer frames and wooden fronts)
- Hardware Kit (Bolts, Screws, Washers, Allen Wrench, etc.)

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Assembly is designed to be straightforward and can typically be completed within half an hour with the provided hardware kit. Follow the detailed installation manual included in your package for step-by-step instructions.

1. **Unpack and Identify:** Carefully unpack all components and lay them out on a soft, clean surface. Identify each part using the provided parts list and diagrams.
2. **Initial Connections:** Begin by connecting the main frame components (headboard, footboard, side rails). Insert bolts loosely at first.
3. **Assemble Headboard:** Attach the two-tier storage shelves to the headboard frame.
4. **Install Slats:** Secure the metal slats to the bed frame. Ensure the rubber strips are properly positioned to prevent noise.
5. **Assemble Drawers:** Construct the two storage drawers. Note that these drawers are not on tracks and are designed to be moved freely under the bed.
6. **Final Tightening:** Once all components are assembled and aligned, gradually tighten all bolts and screws securely. Avoid overtightening.
7. **Mattress Placement:** Place your twin-size mattress (recommended height 10-14 inches) directly onto the slats. A box spring is not required.

Important Tip:

- Do not fully tighten any bolts until all components are loosely assembled and aligned. This helps prevent misalignment and makes assembly easier.
- Before fastening, check if bolts go in freely. Some nuts might have metal shavings that need to be cleaned out, or they might be stripped.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Using the Storage Drawers:

The two XL storage drawers are designed for flexible use under the bed. They are not fixed on tracks, allowing them to be positioned on either the left or right side as needed.

- To access items, simply pull the drawer out from under the bed.
- To store, push the drawer back into the under-bed space.
- **Note:** The drawers may tip easily if pulled out too far or if weight is not balanced. Consider adding a small weight to the back of the drawer to improve stability if this becomes an issue.

Using the Headboard Shelf:

The two-tier headboard provides convenient shelving for bedside essentials or decorative items. Ensure items placed on the shelf are stable and do not obstruct movement or pose a falling hazard.

MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the metal frame and wooden surfaces with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners that could damage the finish.
- **Regular Inspection:** Periodically check all bolts, screws, and connections to ensure they are tight. Retighten if necessary to maintain stability and prevent noise.
- **Noise Prevention:** The bed frame includes rubber strips on the slats to prevent noise. If squeaking occurs, check the slat connections and ensure all bolts are snug.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Bed frame is wobbly or unstable.	Loose bolts or screws.	Check and securely tighten all bolts and screws. Ensure the bed is on a level surface.
Squeaking noises from the bed.	Loose slat connections or frame joints.	Ensure all slats are properly seated and all frame bolts are tight. The rubber strips on the slats are designed to prevent noise; verify their position.
Drawers tip easily when pulled out.	Drawers are not on tracks and can become unbalanced.	Avoid pulling drawers out too far. Consider adding a small weight to the back of the drawer to help balance it.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Difficulty inserting bolts during assembly.	Metal shavings in nuts or stripped nuts.	Before fastening, check if bolts go in freely. Clean out any metal debris from nuts. If a nut is stripped, contact customer service for a replacement part.
