FOR JOHN DEERE JS63 WALK BEHIND LAWN MOWERS

1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

4. INSTALLATION (SETUP)

General Installation Steps:

1. **Prepare the Mower:** Disconnect the spark plug wire. Tilt the mower onto its side, ensuring the carburetor and air filter are facing upwards to prevent fuel or oil leaks.
2. **Locate the Drive System:** Identify the drive belt, pulleys, and transmission housing. You may need to remove a belt cover or deck shield to access these components.

5. MAINTENANCE

- **Visual Inspection:** Periodically inspect the belt for signs of wear, cracks, fraying, glazing, or stretching. Replace the belt if any damage is observed.
- **Cleanliness:** Keep the belt and pulleys free from grass clippings, dirt, and debris, which can cause premature wear and slippage.
- **Proper Storage:** When not in use for extended periods, store the mower in a dry environment to prevent

belt degradation from moisture or extreme temperatures.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If your John Deere JS63 walk-behind lawn mower experiences issues with its drive system, the drive belt may be a contributing factor.

- **Mower Not Self-Propelling:**

- Check if the drive belt is broken or has come off the pulleys.
- Inspect the belt for excessive wear or stretching, which can lead to slippage.
- Ensure the drive engagement lever is functioning correctly.

- **Squealing Noise from Drive System:**

- A squealing sound often indicates a worn, glazed, or misaligned belt.
- Check for debris caught in the pulleys or on the belt.

- **Inconsistent Drive Speed:**

- This could be due to a stretched belt that is losing tension.
- Ensure the belt is properly seated on all pulleys.

For persistent issues, consult your mower's service manual or a professional technician.
