1. INTRODUCTION

- **Installation:** Must be performed by a qualified technician in accordance with local codes and regulations.
- **Ventilation:** Ensure adequate ventilation in the kitchen area.
- **Gas Supply:** Verify the correct gas type (LPG or Natural Gas) and pressure.
- **Children:** Keep children away from the cooktop during operation and when it is hot.
- **Flammable Materials:** Do not store or use flammable materials near the cooktop.
- **Cleaning:** Always turn off the cooktop and allow it to cool before cleaning.

4. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

The Itatiaia Essencial Cooktop is designed for built-in installation. Proper installation is crucial for safety and performance.

4.1 Unpacking

1. Carefully remove the cooktop from its packaging.
2. Inspect for any damage during transit. Contact your retailer immediately if damage is found.
3. Remove all protective films and packaging materials.

4.2 Countertop Preparation

Ensure your countertop is suitable for a built-in cooktop. Refer to the specifications section for precise dimensions. The cutout must be made by a professional to ensure proper fit and stability.

4.3 Gas Connection

This cooktop is compatible with both LPG (Liquefied Petroleum Gas) and Natural Gas. Ensure the appliance is configured for your specific gas type. If conversion is needed, it must be performed by a qualified technician.

- Use only approved gas hoses and fittings.
- Check for gas leaks using a soapy water solution after connection. Never use an open flame.

4.4 Electrical Connection

The cooktop operates on a Bivolt system (110V/220V). Connect the appliance to a properly grounded electrical outlet. The electrical connection is primarily for the automatic ignition system.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Operating your Itatiaia Essencial Cooktop is straightforward thanks to its super automatic ignition and intuitive controls.

5.1 Lighting a Burner

1. Place your cookware centrally on the grate above the desired burner.
2. Press down and turn the corresponding control knob counter-clockwise to the maximum flame position. You will hear a clicking sound as the igniter sparks.
3. Hold the knob down for a few seconds until the flame is stable.
4. Release the knob. If the flame extinguishes, repeat the process.
5. Adjust the flame intensity by turning the knob between the maximum and minimum flame settings.




Figure 5: A detailed view of the ignition spark mechanism, which provides super automatic ignition for the burners.

5.2 Turning Off a Burner

To turn off a burner, simply turn the control knob clockwise until it clicks into the 'off' position.

5.3 Using the Triple Flame Burner (if applicable)

Some models of the Essencial Cooktop feature a triple flame burner for increased power and faster cooking. This burner operates similarly to the standard burners but provides a more intense heat output, ideal for larger pots or quick boiling.

6. MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Regular cleaning and maintenance will ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your cooktop.

6.1 Daily Cleaning

- Allow the cooktop to cool completely before cleaning.
- Wipe the tempered glass surface with a soft cloth and a mild detergent or glass cleaner. Avoid abrasive cleaners or scouring pads.
- The enameled steel grates can be removed and washed with warm soapy water.

6.2 Cleaning Burners and Knobs

- The aluminum burners and burner caps can be removed for thorough cleaning. Wash them with warm soapy water and ensure they are completely dry before reassembling.
- The control knobs are removable for easy cleaning of the surrounding area. Pull them gently to remove and push them back into place after cleaning.

6.3 Preventing Stains

Wipe up spills immediately, especially acidic liquids like lemon juice or vinegar, to prevent permanent staining on the glass surface.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your cooktop, refer to the following common problems and solutions. If the problem persists, contact a qualified technician.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Burner does not ignite	No gas supply, igniter dirty, power outage, knob not pressed down sufficiently.	Check gas valve, clean igniter, check power, press and hold knob firmly.
Flame is weak or uneven	Burner ports clogged, burner cap not seated correctly, low gas pressure.	Clean burner ports, reseal burner cap, contact gas supplier.
Gas odor detected	Gas leak.	Immediately turn off gas supply, open windows, do not operate electrical switches, evacuate and call gas company/technician.
Cooktop surface difficult to clean	Dried spills, incorrect cleaning agents.	Clean spills immediately, use recommended mild detergents and soft cloths.
