Q 10000mAh Power Bank Instruction Manual

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Q 10000mAh Power Bank is a slim and compact portable charger designed for convenience and versatility. It features a built-in AC wall plug and integrated charging cables, eliminating the need for multiple accessories. With a 10000mAh capacity, it provides multiple charges for various mobile devices. Advanced safety features ensure secure and reliable charging.

- **Slim and Compact Design:** Easy to carry with collapsible AC wall plug and built-in cables.
- **5-in-1 Functionality:** Includes built-in cables for various mobile phones and an AC wall plug for self-charging.
- **High Capacity:** 10000mAh battery provides 2.5-4 full charges depending on the device.

- **Universal Compatibility:** Directly charges all mobile phones with built-in cables.

SETUP AND INITIAL CHARGE

Before first use, it is recommended to fully charge your Q Power Bank.

Charging the Power Bank:

1. Using the Built-in AC Wall Plug:

Locate the foldable AC prongs on the back of the power bank. Gently pull them out until they are fully extended. Plug the power bank directly into a standard wall outlet. The LED indicator lights on the front will illuminate to show charging progress. A full charge typically takes approximately 6 hours.

2. Using a USB Cable (Optional):

If a wall outlet is not available, you can charge the power bank via its USB-C input port. Connect a compatible USB-C cable to the power bank's input port and the other end to a USB power source (e.g., computer, USB wall adapter). The LED indicators will show charging status.

Two Ways to Charge the PowerBank

Battery Indicator Lights:

The power bank features LED lights that indicate the remaining battery level. Press the power button once to check the current charge level. Each illuminated light represents approximately 25% of the battery capacity.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Charging Your Devices:

The Q Power Bank offers multiple ways to charge your mobile devices:

1. Using Built-in Cables:

The power bank includes three integrated cables: USB-C, Lightning (for Apple devices), and Micro USB. Simply pull out the appropriate cable from its slot on the side of the power bank and connect it directly to your device's charging port. The power bank will automatically begin charging your device.

2. Using the USB-A Output Port:

For devices requiring a standard USB-A connection, you can use your own USB cable. Plug one end of your cable into the USB-A output port on the power bank and the other end into your device. The power bank will detect the connection and start charging.

The power bank can charge multiple devices simultaneously using a combination of its built-in cables and the USB-A output port.

MAINTENANCE AND CARE

- Keep the power bank dry and away from moisture.
- Avoid exposing the device to extreme temperatures (hot or cold).
- Do not drop, disassemble, or attempt to repair the power bank yourself.
- Store in a cool, dry place when not in use.
- For optimal battery life, fully charge the power bank at least once every three months if not used regularly.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Power bank not charging.	Loose connection, faulty cable/adaptor, power bank fully charged.	Ensure all connections are secure. Try a different cable or wall outlet. Check LED indicators; if all are solid, it's fully charged.
Device not charging from power bank.	Power bank low on charge, incorrect cable, device not compatible.	Recharge the power bank. Ensure you are using the correct built-in cable or a compatible external cable. Verify device compatibility.
Slow charging.	Using a non-fast charging cable/adaptor, multiple devices charging simultaneously.	Use a high-quality, fast-charging cable. Disconnect other devices to prioritize charging one.
LED indicators not working.	Power bank completely drained or internal issue.	Attempt to charge the power bank for several hours. If still unresponsive, contact customer service.
