

Before You Begin

- Clear an open space for assembly.
- Lay out all parts and hardware on a soft, clean surface to prevent scratches.
- Identify each part using the provided labels and the parts list in your accessory kit.
- Ensure all tools are readily available.

Step-by-Step Assembly

Step 1: Assemble the Headboard and Footboard

Attach the wooden panels to the metal headboard and footboard frames using the designated screws. Ensure all connections are secure but do not fully tighten screws until all parts are aligned.

Rustic Wooden Headboard

Made of high-quality wood board combined with metal frame to provide stable support, add style and function to your bedroom.

Step 2: Connect Side Rails

Attach the side rails to the assembled headboard and footboard using the provided bolts. Make sure the side rails are correctly oriented with the slat supports facing inwards.

Step 3: Install Center Support Legs

Attach the center support legs to the central beam of the bed frame. These legs provide additional stability and weight distribution.

Step 4: Place Metal Slats

Unroll or place the metal slats onto the side rail supports. Secure them using the provided fasteners. Ensure the EVA foam padding on the center slat is correctly positioned to minimize noise.

Step 5: Final Tightening

Once all parts are assembled and aligned, go back and fully tighten all screws and bolts using the provided Allen wrench. Do not overtighten.

Carefully place your twin-size mattress onto the assembled slats. The small tailgate at the foot of the bed helps keep the mattress securely in place.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Wipe down the metal frame with a soft, damp cloth. For the wooden headboard/footboard, use a dry cloth or a slightly damp cloth with a mild wood cleaner. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- **Inspection:** Periodically check all bolts and screws to ensure they remain tight. Retighten if necessary to maintain stability and prevent squeaking.
- **Placement:** Avoid placing the bed frame in direct sunlight or near heat sources to prevent warping or fading of the wooden components.
- **Moving:** When moving the bed frame, lift it rather than dragging it to prevent damage to the legs or frame structure.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Common Issues and Solutions

- **Squeaking Noise:**
 - Ensure all bolts and screws are fully tightened.
 - Verify that the EVA foam padding on the center slat is correctly positioned to reduce friction between metal parts.
 - Check if the mattress is causing the noise; try removing it temporarily to isolate the source.
- **Mattress Sliding:**
 - Confirm the mattress is properly seated against the small tailgate at the foot of the bed.
 - Consider using a non-slip mattress pad between the mattress and the slats.
- **Instability/Wobbling:**
 - Recheck all connections and ensure they are securely tightened.
 - Ensure the bed frame is on a flat, level surface. Adjust leg levelers if applicable (not specified for this model, but a general tip).
