Convert your old video and audio sources to digital format with ease.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The ClearClick Video to Digital Converter 3.0 is designed to simplify the process of digitizing your analog video and audio collections. This third-generation device allows you to convert video from sources like VCRs, VHS tapes, AV, RCA, Hi8, camcorders, and DVDs, as well as audio from turntables and cassette tapes, directly to digital files without the need for a computer.

It records video in MP4 format (720x480 or 640x480 pixels) and audio in WAV or MP3 format. Please note that this device does not upscale to HD resolution and does not record from modern HDMI sources.

WHAT'S NEW IN VERSION 3.0

The Video2Digital® Version 3.0 introduces several enhancements for improved functionality and user experience:

- Audio Sources Recording Feature: Now supports direct recording from audio-only sources like cassette tapes and vinyl records.
- Larger 5" Preview Screen: Provides a more comfortable viewing experience during recording.
- Built-In Rechargeable Battery: Offers portability and convenience for recording on the go.
- Custom Auto Stop Feature: Allows setting an exact number of minutes for automatic recording cessation.
- MicroSD Memory Card Slot: Adds flexibility for storage options alongside USB flash drives.
- USB-C Charging Port: Modernized charging for wider compatibility.

SETUP GUIDE

Before you begin, ensure you have a working VCR, camcorder, or other analog video/audio source, and a USB flash drive or MicroSD card (512 GB or less, not included).

Connecting Your Device:

- 1. **Power Connection:** Connect the provided USB charging cable to the USB-C port on the converter and the other end to the USB power adapter. Plug the adapter into a wall outlet. The device can also run on its built-in rechargeable battery.
- 2. **Storage Device:** Insert a USB flash drive or MicroSD card (up to 512 GB, formatted to FAT32 or exFAT) into the corresponding port on the converter. Ensure it is securely inserted.
- 3. Video Source Connection (RCA):
 - Locate the "AV OUT" ports on your VCR, camcorder, or DVD player.
 - Connect the yellow (video), white (left audio), and red (right audio) plugs of the RCA AV cable to the corresponding "AV OUT" ports on your source device.
 - Connect the other end of the RCA AV cable to the "AV Video & Audio Input Ports" on the ClearClick converter.
- 4. Video Source Connection (S-Video): If your source device has an S-Video output, connect an S-Video cable to the "S-Video Video Input Port" on the converter. Note: S-Video only carries video. You must also connect the red and white RCA audio cables for sound.
- 5. **Audio Source Connection:** For audio-only recording (e.g., from a cassette player or turntable), connect the red and white RCA audio cables from your source's "AUDIO OUT" ports to the corresponding red and white "AV Video & Audio Input Ports" on the converter.

Important Considerations:

- A working VCR or camcorder with a working "AV OUT" port is REQUIRED. The converter does NOT play video tapes by itself.
- Your VHS/Camcorder tapes MUST be in working condition.
- Use a brand name USB flash drive or SD card (512GB or less). Generic or slow drives may cause issues.
- Recording resolution is 640x480 pixels or 720x480 pixels. Does NOT upscale to HD quality. Does NOT record from HDMI sources.
- To avoid corrupt recording files, you MUST press the "Rec/Stop" button BEFORE removing your USB drive/SD card.



- → Recording resolution: 640x480 pixels or 720x480 pixels. (Does **NOT** upscale to HD quality. Does **NOT** record from HDMI sources.)
- → To avoid corrupt recording files, you **MUST** stop recording by pressing "Rec/Stop" **BEFORE** removing your USB drive/SD card.

Powering On/Off:

- To power on, press and hold the Power button (LCD On/Off) located on the side of the device.
- To power off, press and hold the Power button again.

Navigating the Menu:

- Use the "Menu" button to access the main menu.
- Use the Up/Down arrow buttons to navigate through menu options.
- Use the "OK" button to select an option.
- Use the "Mode" button to switch between Video Recording Mode and Audio Recording Mode.

Recording Video:

- 1. Ensure your video source (VCR, camcorder, etc.) is connected correctly and powered on.
- 2. Select "Video Recording Mode" using the "Mode" button if not already selected.
- 3. Start playback on your video source. You should see the video on the converter's 5" screen.
- 4. Press the "Rec/Stop" button (usually labeled with a red dot) on the converter to begin recording. A recording indicator will appear on the screen.
- 5. To stop recording, press the "Rec/Stop" button again. The recording will be saved to your USB drive or MicroSD card.

6. Wait 5-10 seconds after stopping recording before removing your storage device to ensure the file is saved properly.

Recording Audio:

- 1. Ensure your audio source (cassette player, turntable, etc.) is connected correctly to the red and white RCA audio input ports.
- 2. Select "Audio Recording Mode" using the "Mode" button. The screen will display an audio equalizer.
- 3. Start playback on your audio source.
- 4. Press the "Rec/Stop" button on the converter to begin recording.
- 5. To stop recording, press the "Rec/Stop" button again. The audio file will be saved to your USB drive or MicroSD card.
- 6. Wait 5-10 seconds after stopping recording before removing your storage device to ensure the file is saved properly.

MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your ClearClick Video to Digital Converter 3.0, follow these maintenance guidelines:

- Cleaning: Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the exterior of the device. Do not use liquid cleaners or aerosols, as they may damage the unit.
- **Storage:** When not in use, store the converter in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- Battery Care: If the device will not be used for an extended period, charge the built-in battery periodically (e.g., every 3-6 months) to maintain its health.
- Cable Management: Avoid bending or kinking cables excessively to prevent internal damage.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your ClearClick Video to Digital Converter 3.0, please refer to the following troubleshooting steps:

- 1. Issue: "No audio or video" / "Poor quality video" / "Intermittent signal" / "Defective transfer of image" / "Worked for a few minutes, but then the video image disappeared" / "Won't read VCR signal"
 - Ensure your VCR or camcorder is in fully working condition, including its "AV OUT" port. If your VCR or camcorder hasn't been used in several years, it likely needs a tune-up, repair, or cleaning. Ensure your tapes are in working condition and are playable. To test, connect your video source directly to a TV to verify playback there.
 - Ensure your AV cable is securely plugged into your "AV OUT" ports (usually in the back) on your video source (VCR, camcorder, etc.), not the "AV IN" ports.
 - Ensure the "Video Source" setting in the converter's main menu is set correctly.
 - If you are using S-Video, ensure you have hooked up the red/white RCA audio connectors to receive audio as well, since S-Video only contains a video signal.
 - Camcorder users: ensure you are using the correct type of AV cable for your camcorder.
- 2. Issue: "The recorded video is jerky or glitchy" or "Video is flickering" or "Picture is jumpy"
 - This can be resolved by recording from your video source's "S-VIDEO OUT" port instead of "AV OUT" port. (Make sure you also change the Video Source to "S-Video" in the converter's main menu.)
 - If your video source does not have an "S-VIDEO OUT" port, please contact ClearClick and they may be able to mail you an "AV to S-VIDEO" adapter.
- 3. Issue: "Converted MP4 file is unreadable or corrupt"
 - Ensure you press the "Rec/Stop" button on the converter to stop recording, prior to removing your USB drive or SD card from the converter.
 - After pressing the "Rec/Stop" button to stop recording, wait 5-10 seconds before removing your USB drive or SD card from the converter, so that the converter can save the file properly.
- 4. Issue: "Transferred video and audio is out of sync"
 - Ensure you are using a brand name USB 3.0 drive or SD card (class 10 or higher). Generic brand drives are too slow to be used with the converter.
 - Ensure your USB drive or SD card is 512 GB or less.

5. Issue: "Can't record from HDMI"

• The converter's HDMI port is an output port, not an input port. This device does not record from HDMI sources (only AV and S-Video).




