INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the assembly, operation, and maintenance of your GLORHOME Twin Over Full Bunk Bed + Loft Bed with Storage Staircases. Please read all instructions carefully before beginning assembly and retain this manual for future reference. This bed frame is designed to offer versatile sleeping arrangements and integrated storage, suitable for various room configurations.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

WARNING: Failure to follow these warnings and instructions could result in serious injury or death.

- Always follow the manufacturer's recommended mattress size.
- Ensure all connections are securely tightened before use and check periodically.
- Do not allow children under 6 years of age on the upper bunk.
- Prohibit more than one person on the upper bunk.
- Always use the provided guardrails on the upper bunk.
- Do not attach or hang items to any part of the bunk bed that are not designed for use with the bed; for example, but not limited to, hooks, belts, and jump ropes.
- Use a nightlight on the upper bunk for safety when descending.
- Periodically check and ensure that the guardrail, ladder, and other components are in their proper position and free from damage.
- Do not use substitute parts. Contact the manufacturer for replacement parts.
- Keep these instructions for future reference.

PARTS LIST

Before assembly, verify that all parts are present and undamaged. This product is shipped in 3 separate packages. Please ensure all packages have arrived before beginning assembly.

Refer to the assembly diagram for specific part identification. Common components include:

- Upper Bed Frame Components (Headboard, Footboard, Side Rails, Slats)
- Lower Bed Frame Components (Headboard, Footboard, Side Rails, Slats)
- Staircase Unit (Side panels, Steps, Storage drawers/lids)
- Support Legs and Beams
- Guardrails
- Hardware (Bolts, Screws, Washers, Allen Wrench)

SETUP & ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Assembly requires two adults. Clear a spacious area for assembly. Do not fully tighten bolts until instructed.

1. **Unpack and Identify Parts:** Carefully unpack all components and lay them out. Compare with the parts list to ensure everything is present.
2. **Assemble the Lower Bed Frame:** Attach the side rails to the headboard and footboard of the full-size bed. Insert the mattress support slats.
3. **Assemble the Upper Bed Frame:** Attach the side rails to the headboard and footboard of the twin-size bed. Insert

the mattress support slats.

4. **Assemble the Staircase Unit:** Connect the side panels of the staircase unit. Install the steps and the storage compartments with their flip-up lids. The staircase can be positioned on either the left or right side of the bed.
5. **Connect Upper Bed to Staircase:** Securely attach the upper twin bed frame to the top of the staircase unit using the provided hardware.
6. **Attach Support Legs and Guardrails:** Install the support legs for the upper bunk. Attach the guardrails to the upper bunk, ensuring they are firmly secured.
7. **Position the Lower Bed:** Place the assembled full-size bed frame underneath the upper bunk. The lower bed can be positioned to create a bunk bed configuration or moved separately as a stand-alone full bed.
8. **Final Tightening:** Once all components are assembled and aligned, fully tighten all bolts and screws. Do not overtighten.

OPERATION

Standard Bunk Bed Configuration

In its standard configuration, the twin bed is positioned above the full bed, with the staircase providing access to the upper bunk. The lower full bed is placed directly beneath the upper twin bed.

Convertible Loft Bed Configuration

The lower full bed is designed to be movable. It can be pulled out from under the upper twin bed and placed elsewhere in the room, converting the upper twin bed into a loft bed. This creates a larger open space beneath the loft, which can be used for play, study, or additional furniture.

Storage Staircases

Each step of the staircase unit features a flip-up lid, revealing a storage compartment. These compartments are ideal for storing toys, books, bedding, or other personal items. Ensure lids are closed securely when not in use.

MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Wipe surfaces with a damp cloth and mild soap. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners that may damage the wood finish.
- **Hardware Check:** Periodically (e.g., every 3-6 months) check all bolts, screws, and connections to ensure they remain tight. Retighten if necessary to maintain stability and safety.
- **Wood Care:** Protect the wood from extreme temperature changes and direct sunlight to prevent warping or fading.
- **Mattress Support:** Ensure mattress slats are properly seated and undamaged. Replace any broken slats immediately.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Bed feels wobbly or unstable.	Loose hardware connections. Uneven floor surface.	Check and tighten all bolts and screws. Ensure the bed is on a level surface; use shims if necessary.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Squeaking noises during use.	Loose connections or friction between wood parts.	Tighten all hardware. Apply a small amount of paraffin wax or silicone spray to contact points between wood components if squeaking persists.
Storage compartment lids do not close properly.	Obstruction in the compartment. Misaligned hinges.	Remove any items obstructing the lid. Check hinge alignment and adjust if possible.
Missing parts or damaged components upon arrival.	Shipping damage or packaging error.	Do not proceed with assembly. Contact GLORHOME customer service immediately for replacement parts.

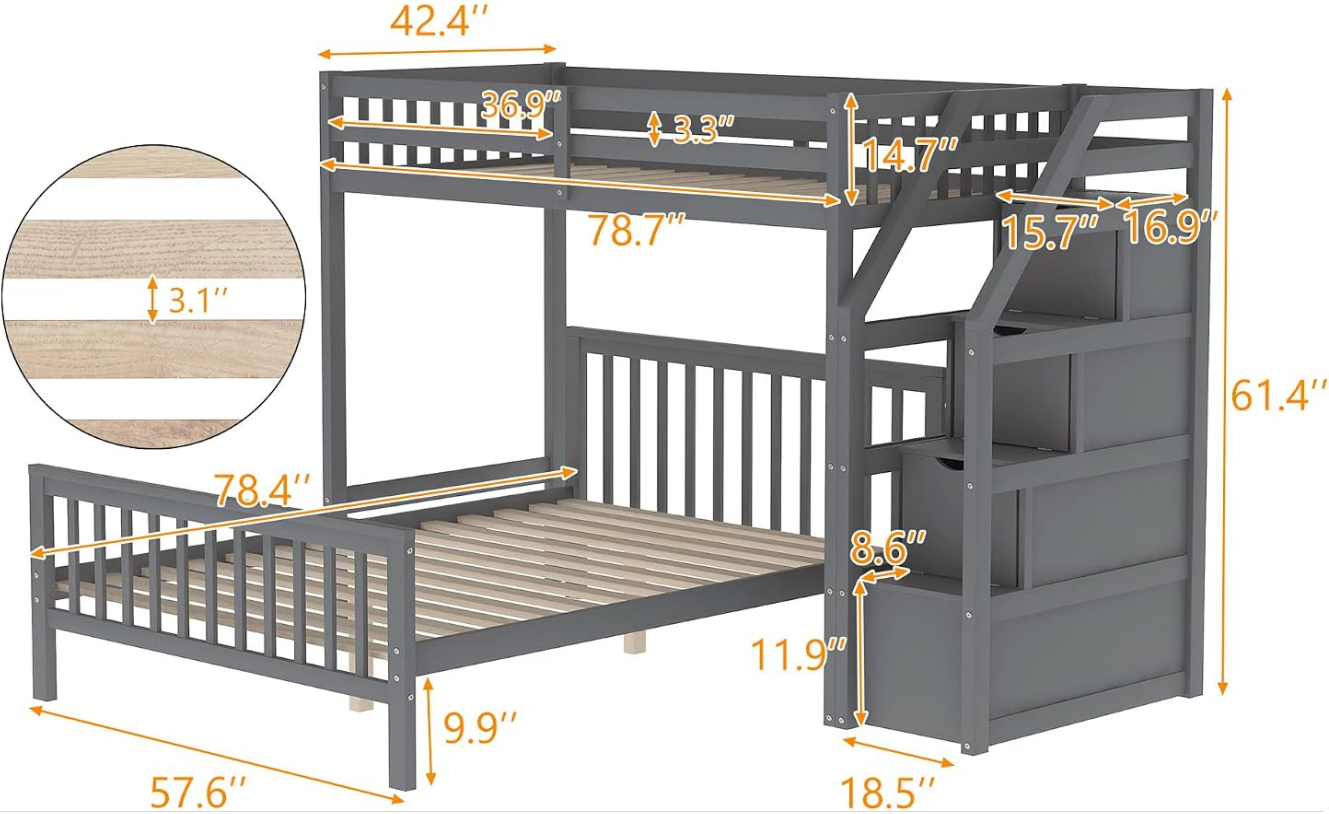


Image: Comprehensive diagram illustrating all key dimensions of the bunk bed and staircase unit in inches.
