INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential instructions for the safe and efficient operation, maintenance, and care of your Bajaj Platini Food Art 1000-Watt Food Processor. Please read all instructions carefully before using the appliance and retain this manual for future reference.

This product is a refurbished item, tested to work and look like new with minimal to no signs of wear and tear. It comes with relevant accessories and is backed by a minimum six-month seller warranty. Refurbished products are professionally inspected, tested, and cleaned by expert sellers to ensure they are in fully working condition, offering high quality at great prices.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

To reduce the risk of personal injury or damage to the appliance, always follow these basic safety precautions:

- **Read All Instructions:** Familiarize yourself with all operating and safety instructions before using the appliance.
- **Electrical Safety:** Ensure your mains voltage corresponds to the voltage stated on the appliance's rating plate. Do not immerse the motor unit, cord, or plug in water or any other liquid.
- **Blade Handling:** Blades are extremely sharp. Handle them with utmost care. Always use the provided spatula or a suitable tool to remove food from the processing bowl or jars.
- **Supervision:** Close supervision is necessary when the appliance is used by or near children or individuals with reduced physical, sensory, or mental capabilities.
- **Attachments:** Use only attachments and accessories specifically recommended or sold by the manufacturer. Using other attachments may cause fire, electric shock, or injury.
- **Avoid Contact:** Keep hands and utensils away from moving blades or discs while processing food to prevent severe injury.
- **Maintenance:** Unplug the appliance from the outlet when not in use, before putting on or taking off parts, and before cleaning.
- **Damaged Cord/Plug:** Do not operate any appliance with a damaged cord or plug, or after the appliance

malfunctions or has been dropped or damaged in any manner.

PRODUCT COMPONENTS

Your Bajaj Platini Food Art Food Processor is a versatile appliance designed for various kitchen tasks. It includes the following components:

- Motor Unit (Main Body)
- Transparent Liquidizing Jar (1.5 Litres)
- Stainless Steel Grinding Jar (1 Litre)
- Stainless Steel Chutney Jar (0.4 Litre)
- Processing Bowl with Lid (Thermoplastic material)
- 7 Stainless Steel Blades: Grinding, Liquidizing, Chutney, Chopping, Slicing (variable), Grating, and Shredding blades
- Efficient Attachments: Atta Kneading tool, Centrifugal Juicer, and Citrus Juicer
- Spatula

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Follow these steps to set up your food processor for first use or before each operation:

1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Retain packaging for storage or future transport.
2. **Initial Cleaning:** Before first use, wash all detachable parts (jars, blades, lids, attachments) in warm, soapy water. Rinse thoroughly and dry completely. Wipe the motor unit with a damp cloth; never immerse it in water.
3. **Placement:** Place the motor unit on a stable, flat, dry, and non-slip surface, away from the edge of the countertop.
4. **Jar Assembly:** Select the appropriate jar and blade/attachment for your task. Carefully place the blade onto the spindle inside the jar. Ensure it is seated correctly.
5. **Lid Placement:** Place the lid onto the chosen jar. Rotate the lid clockwise until it securely locks into position. The appliance will not operate if the lid is not properly locked.
6. **Mounting Jar:** Place the assembled jar onto the motor unit. Twist the jar gently until it locks into place on the motor unit.

7. **Power Connection:** Only after the appliance is fully assembled and locked, plug the power cord into a suitable electrical outlet.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Always ensure the appliance is properly assembled and locked before plugging it in and switching it on. Do not operate the appliance continuously for more than 3 minutes; allow a cooling period between cycles.

General Operation Steps:

1. Prepare your ingredients and place them into the chosen jar or processing bowl. Do not exceed the maximum fill level indicated on the jars.
2. Secure the lid and ensure the jar/bowl is correctly mounted and locked onto the motor unit.
3. Plug the appliance into a suitable power outlet.
4. Turn the control knob to the desired speed setting (usually 1, 2, or 3) or use the 'Pulse' function for short bursts of power.
5. After processing, turn the control knob to the 'OFF' position, unplug the appliance, and wait for the blades to stop completely before disassembling.
6. Carefully remove the jar/bowl from the motor unit, then unlock and remove the lid.
7. Use the spatula to scrape down sides or remove processed food.

Specific Functions and Blade Usage:

- **Liquidizing (1.5 Litre Jar):** Use the liquidizing blade for making shakes, smoothies, purees, soups, and blending liquids. Add liquids first for best results.
- **Grinding (1 Litre Jar):** Use the grinding blade for dry grinding tasks such as spices, coffee beans, nuts, and grains. Ensure ingredients are dry.
- **Chutney Making (0.4 Litre Jar):** Use the chutney blade for small quantities of wet or dry grinding, ideal for chutneys, pastes, and dips.
- **Chopping, Slicing, Grating, Shredding (Processing Bowl):** Utilize the processing bowl with the respective blades for these tasks. The variable slicing blade allows for different slice thicknesses. Always use the food pusher when feeding ingredients through the chute.
- **Atta Kneading (Processing Bowl):** Attach the atta kneading tool in the processing bowl for preparing dough. Follow specific recipes for flour and water ratios.
- **Centrifugal and Citrus Juicing:** Attach the appropriate juicer attachment to the motor unit for extracting juice from various fruits and vegetables. The centrifugal juicer is for harder produce, while the citrus juicer is for citrus fruits.

MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Regular cleaning and proper maintenance will ensure the longevity and hygienic operation of your food processor.

1. **Unplug First:** Always ensure the appliance is switched off and unplugged from the power outlet before cleaning or disassembling.
2. **Disassemble:** Carefully disassemble all removable parts: jars, lids, blades, and attachments.
3. **Hand Wash Only:** All jars, blades, and attachments should be hand washed with warm, soapy water. Use a non-abrasive sponge or brush. Exercise extreme caution when handling blades due to their sharpness.
4. **Rinse and Dry:** Rinse all washed parts thoroughly under running water. Dry them completely with a soft cloth or allow them to air dry before reassembling or storing.

5. **Motor Unit Cleaning:** Wipe the exterior of the motor unit with a soft, damp cloth. Never immerse the motor unit in water or any other liquid, and do not rinse it under a tap.
6. **Stubborn Stains:** For stubborn food stains on plastic parts, a paste of baking soda and water can be used, then rinsed thoroughly.
7. **Storage:** Store the food processor and its accessories in a clean, dry place, out of reach of children. Ensure blades are stored safely.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your food processor, refer to the following common troubleshooting steps before contacting customer support:

- **Appliance Not Starting:**
 - Ensure the power cord is securely plugged into a functional electrical outlet.
 - Verify that the jar/processing bowl and its lid are correctly assembled and securely locked onto the motor unit. The appliance has a safety interlock system that prevents operation if not properly secured.
 - Check if there has been a power outage or if the circuit breaker has tripped.
- **Motor Stops During Operation:**
 - The appliance might be overloaded. Switch off, unplug, remove some ingredients, and restart. Do not exceed maximum fill lines.
 - Check for any blockages around the blades or attachments. Clear any obstructions carefully after unplugging.
 - The motor might have overheated. Turn off the appliance and let it cool down for at least 15-20 minutes before attempting to use it again.
- **Unusual Noise or Odor:**
 - Switch off immediately and unplug the appliance. Check for any foreign objects inside the jar or improper assembly of blades/attachments.
 - If the issue persists after checking, discontinue use and contact customer support.
- **Leakage from Jar/Bowl:**
 - Ensure the lid is properly sealed and locked onto the jar/bowl.
 - Do not overfill the jar/bowl beyond the maximum fill line.
 - Check if the blade assembly is correctly seated and the sealing ring (if applicable) is in place and undamaged.
