### INTRODUCTION

---

Thank you for choosing the Primo Countertop Deluxe Water Dispenser. This appliance provides convenient access to ice cold, cool, and piping hot water, featuring a child-resistant safety feature for hot water. Designed for use with reusable 3 or 5-gallon water bottles, it promotes an earth-friendly lifestyle by reducing waste. The dispenser includes a premium internal stainless steel water reservoir for durability and hygiene. Please read this manual thoroughly before operation to ensure safe and efficient use of your new water dispenser.

## **SAFETY INFORMATION**

---

Your safety and the safety of others are very important. Please read all instructions before operating this appliance to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, or injury.

- Always plug the dispenser into a grounded electrical outlet.
- Do not operate the dispenser if the power cord is damaged.
- Keep the dispenser away from direct sunlight and heat sources.
- Ensure proper ventilation around the dispenser.
- The hot water faucet is equipped with a child-resistant safety feature. Always engage this feature when not in use, especially in households with children.
- Do not immerse the dispenser, cord, or plug in water or other liquids.

- Unplug the dispenser before cleaning or performing any maintenance.
- This appliance is for indoor use only.

## SETUP

---

1. **Placement:** Place the dispenser on a flat, level, and sturdy surface capable of supporting its weight when a full 5-gallon bottle is installed. Ensure there is adequate clearance around the unit for ventilation.
2. **Initial Cleaning:** Before first use, wipe down the exterior of the dispenser with a soft, damp cloth.
3. **Install Drip Tray:** Slide the drip tray and grill into place at the base of the dispenser.
4. **Load Water Bottle:** Remove the cap from a 3 or 5-gallon Primo water bottle. Carefully lift the bottle and invert it, placing it securely onto the piercing probe on top of the dispenser. Ensure the bottle is seated firmly.
5. **Initial Flush:** Before plugging in the unit, dispense at least 1 liter of water from each faucet (hot, cool, cold) to ensure the reservoirs are filled and to flush out any air. This is crucial for proper operation and to prevent damage to the heating element.
6. **Power Connection:** Plug the dispenser into a grounded 120V AC electrical outlet.
7. **Activate Heating/Cooling:** Locate the power switches on the back of the unit. Turn on the switches for hot and cold water as desired. The indicator lights on the front will illuminate when the unit is heating or cooling.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

Your Primo water dispenser offers three temperature options: hot, cool, and ice cold.

- **Cold Water:** Place your glass under the cold water faucet (typically blue). Press the cold water lever to dispense.
- **Cool Water:** Place your glass under the cool water faucet (typically gray/middle). Press the cool water lever to dispense.
- **Hot Water:** The hot water faucet (typically red) has a child-resistant safety feature. To dispense hot water, simultaneously push the safety button and press the hot water lever. Release both to stop the flow.

## MAINTENANCE

---

Regular maintenance ensures optimal performance and longevity of your dispenser.

- **Cleaning the Exterior:** Wipe the exterior surfaces with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Drip Tray:** The drip tray should be emptied and cleaned regularly to prevent overflow and bacterial

growth. Simply slide it out, empty, wash with mild soap and water, rinse, and replace.

- **Bottle Replacement:** When the water bottle is empty, carefully lift it off the dispenser. Dispose of or return the empty bottle according to local regulations. Replace with a new 3 or 5-gallon Primo water bottle.
- **Descaling (Recommended Annually):** Over time, mineral deposits can build up in the hot water tank. To descale, unplug the unit and allow it to cool. Remove the water bottle. Drain all water from the hot and cold reservoirs. Prepare a descaling solution (e.g., a mixture of white vinegar and water). Pour the solution into the hot water reservoir. Let it sit for 30 minutes, then drain. Rinse thoroughly by flushing with several liters of fresh water.

### TRUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No water dispensing.	Empty water bottle; airlock; dispenser unplugged.	Replace bottle; perform initial flush; check power connection.
Water not hot/cold enough.	Heating/cooling switch off; unit recently plugged in; heavy usage.	Ensure switches are on; allow 15-30 minutes for temperature stabilization; allow recovery time between uses.
Water leaking from dispenser.	Bottle not seated correctly; cracked bottle; loose drain plug.	Re-seat bottle firmly; check bottle for cracks and replace if necessary; ensure drain plug (if applicable) is secure.
Hot water safety button stuck.	Possible debris or mechanical issue.	Gently try to free the button. If it remains stuck, contact customer support.


