# Miroir M76 Micro Pocket Projector User Manual

Your guide to setting up, operating, and maintaining your Miroir M76 projector.

## INTRODUCTION

---

The Miroir M76 Micro Pocket Projector is an ultra-portable, battery-powered DLP mini projector designed for on-the-go entertainment and presentations. Its compact size and versatile connectivity options make it ideal for projecting content from various devices onto any flat surface.

## SETUP

---

### What's Included

Before you begin, ensure all components are present in the box:

- Miroir M76 Projector
- HDMI Cable
- USB-A to USB-C Charging Cable
- Quick Start Guide

## Charging the Projector

The Miroir M76 features a built-in rechargeable battery, offering up to 2 hours of cordless operation. To charge the device, connect the provided USB-A to USB-C charging cable to the projector's USB-C port and plug the USB-A end into a compatible USB-A power adapter (not included). The projector can also be powered via USB connection for extended viewing sessions.

## Powering On/Off

To power on the projector, press and hold the power button located on the side of the device until the indicator light illuminates. To power off, press and hold the power button again until the light turns off.

## Adjusting Focus

Locate the focus wheel near the projection lens. Rotate the wheel until the projected image appears sharp and clear on your desired surface. The optimal focus will depend on the distance between the projector and the projection surface.

## OPERATING

---

### Connectivity Options

The Miroir M76 offers multiple ways to connect your devices:

- **HDMI Input:** Connect laptops, gaming consoles, streaming sticks, or mobile devices (with an appropriate adapter) using the HDMI port.
- **USB Input:** The USB-A port can be used for charging or powering compatible devices.
- **Wireless Mirroring:** The M76 supports iOS and Android screen mirroring, allowing you to project content wirelessly from your smartphone or tablet.

## Wireless Screen Mirroring

For wireless projection, ensure your device and the Miroir M76 are connected to the same Wi-Fi network. Follow your device's instructions for screen mirroring (e.g., AirPlay for iOS, Smart View for Android) and select the M76 from the available devices. Note that some streaming services may restrict mirroring due to content protection.

## Audio Output

The Miroir M76 includes a built-in 1W speaker for direct audio playback. For a more immersive experience or private listening, you can connect headphones or external speakers using the 3.5mm audio out jack.

## Projection Size and Distance

The projector can display a crisp image up to 50 inches. The size and clarity of the projected image will vary based on the

distance from the projection surface and ambient light conditions. For best results, use in a dimly lit environment.

## MAINTENANCE

---

### Cleaning the Lens

To maintain optimal image quality, regularly clean the projector lens using a soft, lint-free cloth specifically designed for optical surfaces. Avoid using abrasive materials or harsh chemicals, which can damage the lens coating.

### General Care

Store the projector in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. Protect it from dust and moisture. When not in use, it is recommended to keep the projector in its original packaging or a protective case to prevent damage.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

---

If you encounter issues with your Miroir M76 projector, refer to the common problems and solutions below:

Problem	Possible Solution
No image projected	Ensure the projector is powered on and fully charged or connected to power. Check HDMI cable connection if using wired input. Verify correct input source is selected on your connected device.
Image is blurry	Adjust the focus wheel until the image is sharp. Ensure the projection surface is flat and the projector is stable.
No sound	Check the projector's volume level and your connected device's volume. Ensure external speakers or headphones are properly connected to the 3.5mm audio jack.
Wireless mirroring issues	Confirm both the projector and your device are on the same Wi-Fi network. Restart both devices. Ensure your device's operating system is up to date.
