Uarzt Remote Control Tractor Toy Instruction Manual

Model: 6645

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Uarzt Remote Control Tractor Toy is an advanced farm vehicle playset designed for children aged 3 to 9 years. This set includes a durable metal tractor head, an 8-wheel drive system, a 2.4GHz remote control, a functional front loader, a dumpable trailer, and various farm accessories. It features working lights and realistic movements to enhance the play experience.

Key features include:

- **Metal Tractor Head & 8-Wheel Drive:** Provides enhanced durability and stability across various terrains.
- **2.4GHz Remote Control:** Allows for multi-player operation without interference.
- **Functional Attachments:** Includes a front loader with 3rd gear adjustment and a dumpable trailer for interactive play.
- **Working Lights:** Adds realism to the play experience.
- **Farm Accessories:** Comes with miniature cow, sheep, square hay bales, and round hay bale.

SAFETY INFORMATION

- **Age Recommendation:** Suitable for children aged 36 months to 9 years. Adult supervision is recommended for younger children.
- **Battery Safety:** Use only the specified battery type (1 Lithium Ion battery for the tractor, included). Do not mix old and new batteries, or different types of batteries. Ensure correct polarity when inserting batteries.
- **Choking Hazard:** The set contains small parts (farm animals, hay bales) which may pose a choking hazard for children under 3 years.
- **Operating Environment:** Operate the toy on flat, clear surfaces. Avoid water, sand, or excessively rough terrain to prevent damage.
- **Remote Control Range:** Be aware of the 2.4GHz remote control range to maintain control of the toy.

SETUP

1. Battery Installation

For the Tractor:

1. Locate the battery compartment on the underside of the tractor.
2. Use the included screwdriver to open the battery compartment cover.
3. Connect the rechargeable Lithium Ion battery to the tractor's battery connector, ensuring correct polarity.
4. Place the battery inside the compartment and close the cover securely with the screw.

For the Remote Control:

1. Locate the battery compartment on the back of the remote control.
2. Open the battery compartment cover.
3. Insert 2 x AA batteries (not included) into the compartment, observing the correct polarity (+/-).
4. Close the battery compartment cover.

2. Charging the Tractor Battery

Before first use, fully charge the tractor's battery. The charging time is approximately 2-3 hours.

1. Connect the USB charging cable to the tractor's battery.
2. Plug the other end of the USB charging cable into a standard USB power adapter (e.g., phone charger, computer USB port).
3. The indicator light on the USB cable will show charging status (e.g., red for charging, off when fully charged).
4. Once fully charged, disconnect the battery from the charging cable.

3. Attaching Accessories

Attaching the Front Loader:

1. Align the attachment points of the front loader with the corresponding slots on the front of the tractor.
2. Insert the loader until it clicks securely into place.

Attaching the Trailer:

1. Align the trailer hitch with the towing hook at the rear of the tractor.
2. Press down to secure the trailer to the tractor. Ensure it is firmly attached before operation.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Power On/Off

- **Tractor:** Locate the power switch on the tractor (usually on the underside or rear). Slide it to the "ON" position.
- **Remote Control:** Slide the power switch on the remote control to the "ON" position. The indicator light on the remote will illuminate.
- Ensure both are turned off after use to conserve battery life.

2. Remote Control Functions

The 2.4GHz remote control allows for precise movement and control of the tractor.

- **Forward/Backward:** Use the left joystick (or designated button) to move the tractor forward or backward.
- **Turn Left/Right:** Use the right joystick (or designated button) to steer the tractor left or right.
- **Lights:** Press the "Light" button on the remote control to turn the tractor's headlights on or off. The lights remain on while driving when activated.
- **One-Key Demo:** Press the "One-Key Demo" button to activate an automatic demonstration sequence of the tractor's movements and functions.

3. Using the Front Loader and Trailer

- **Front Loader Operation:** Use the dedicated controls on the remote (if available, or manually adjust if not remote-controlled) to raise, lower, and tilt the front loader bucket. The 3rd gear adjustment allows for flexible and rotating joints.
- **Trailer Operation:** The trailer can be used to transport the included farm accessories (hay bales, animals). The

trailer is dumpable for easy unloading.

MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the tractor and remote control with a clean, damp cloth. Do not immerse in water. Avoid harsh chemicals.
- **Battery Care:**
 - Always turn off the toy and remote control after use.
 - Remove batteries from the remote control if the toy will not be used for an extended period.
 - Recharge the tractor battery only with the provided USB charging cable.
- **Storage:** Store the toy and its accessories in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- **Hinge Maintenance:** The upgraded hinge design prevents shedding, but ensure no debris interferes with its movement.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Tractor does not move or respond to remote.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Tractor battery is low or uncharged.• Remote control batteries are low or incorrectly inserted.• Tractor or remote control is not turned on.• Interference from other 2.4GHz devices.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Charge the tractor battery fully.• Replace remote control batteries, ensuring correct polarity.• Turn on both the tractor and the remote control.• Move to an area with less interference.
Tractor moves slowly or erratically.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Tractor battery is low.• Operating on unsuitable terrain (e.g., thick carpet, sand).	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Recharge the tractor battery.• Operate on a smoother, harder surface.
Lights are not working.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Light button not pressed.• Battery low.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Press the "Light" button on the remote.• Charge the tractor battery.
Attachments (loader/trailer) detach easily.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Not securely attached.• Excessive force during play.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Ensure attachments are clicked firmly into place.• Remind users to handle with care during play.
