## INTRODUCTION

---

Thank you for choosing the BuildingBoat Guardian & Korok Construction Kit. This 379-piece set allows you to build detailed models of the iconic Hyrule Guardian and a Korok figure. The Guardian model features a 360-degree rotating head and flexible, actionable legs, providing both an engaging building experience and a dynamic display piece. Please read this manual carefully before beginning assembly to ensure a smooth and enjoyable construction process.

## PACKAGE CONTENTS

---

Before you begin, please verify that all components are present. This kit includes:

- 379 high-quality ABS plastic building pieces
- Instruction Manual (this document)
- Components for one Hyrule Guardian model
- Components for one Korok figure

## SAFETY INFORMATION

---

- **Choking Hazard:** This kit contains small parts and is not suitable for children under 3 years of age.
- Adult supervision is recommended during assembly, especially for younger children.
- Keep all packaging materials away from infants and children to prevent suffocation.
- Do not expose the building pieces to extreme heat or open flames.
- Ensure hands are clean and dry before handling the pieces.

## ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

---

Follow the step-by-step instructions provided in the included printed manual for detailed guidance. The general assembly process involves:

1. **Preparation:** Unpack all pieces and sort them by color and shape. This will simplify the building process. Refer to the parts list in your printed manual to identify each component.
2. **Guardian Body and Head Assembly:** Begin by constructing the central body and head of the Guardian. Pay close attention to the orientation of pieces, especially for the head's eye and sensory components. The head is designed to rotate 360 degrees once assembled correctly.

- 3. Leg Attachment:** Assemble the Guardian's legs individually. Each leg is designed to be flexible and actionable. Carefully attach each leg to the main body, ensuring secure connections that allow for movement.

- 4. Korok Figure Assembly:** The Korok figure is typically simpler to assemble. Follow the instructions to connect its few pieces, forming the small, iconic character.
- 5. Final Check:** Once both models are assembled, gently test the movable parts of the Guardian to

ensure all connections are firm and functional.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

The BuildingBoat Guardian & Korok models are primarily designed for display and gentle play.

- **Guardian Posing:** The Guardian's head can be rotated 360 degrees to face different directions. Its legs are articulated, allowing you to pose the model in various stances. Handle the joints gently to avoid damage.
- **Korok Display:** The Korok figure is a static model, ideal for accompanying the Guardian or being displayed independently.
- Avoid applying excessive force to any part of the models, as this may cause pieces to detach or break.

## MAINTENANCE

---

- **Cleaning:** To clean your assembled models, gently wipe them with a soft, slightly damp cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials, as these can damage the plastic.
- **Storage:** Store the models in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight to prevent discoloration or material degradation.
- If any pieces become loose, reattach them firmly.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

---

- **Missing Pieces:** If you find any pieces are missing from your kit, please contact BuildingBoat customer support with your purchase details.
- **Difficulty Connecting Pieces:** Ensure that you are using the correct pieces as indicated in the instruction manual. Apply gentle, even pressure to connect pieces. If a piece does not fit, do not

force it, as this may cause damage. Double-check the orientation.

- **Model Instability:** If the assembled Guardian model feels unstable, re-examine the connections of the legs to the main body and the joints within the legs. Ensure all pieces are securely fastened according to the instructions.
