1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides important instructions for the safe and proper use of your BAIJAC Replacement Power Cord. Please read this manual thoroughly before installation and retain it for future reference. This power cord is designed as a direct replacement for specific Babylock sewing machine models.

1.1 Safety Information

- Always ensure the sewing machine is unplugged from the wall outlet before connecting or disconnecting the power cord.
- Do not use the power cord if it is damaged, frayed, or has exposed wires.
- Keep the power cord away from heat sources, sharp edges, and moving parts of the sewing machine.
- Do not overload electrical outlets.
- This product is intended for indoor use only.
- Ensure the power cord is fully inserted into both the sewing machine and the wall outlet.

2. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

Follow these steps to correctly install the replacement power cord:

1. **Unplug the Machine:** Ensure your Babylock sewing machine is completely unplugged from the electrical wall outlet.
2. **Remove Old Cord (if applicable):** If replacing an existing cord, carefully disconnect it from the sewing machine's power input port.
3. **Connect New Cord to Machine:** Align the connector end of the BAIJAC Replacement Power Cord with the power input port on your Babylock sewing machine. Gently push until it is firmly seated. Do not force the connection.
4. **Connect to Power Outlet:** Once the cord is securely connected to the machine, plug the other end

of the power cord into a standard, grounded electrical wall outlet.

5. **Verify Connection:** Ensure both ends of the cord are securely connected before powering on the machine.

3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The BAIJAC Replacement Power Cord functions identically to the original power cord. Once properly installed, your sewing machine will receive power as expected.

- After connecting the power cord, turn on your Babylock sewing machine using its power switch.
- If the machine does not power on, refer to the Troubleshooting section of this manual or your sewing machine's original instruction manual.
- Always unplug the machine when not in use or when performing maintenance.

4. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Proper care will extend the life of your replacement power cord.

- **Cleaning:** Disconnect the power cord from the wall outlet and the sewing machine before cleaning. Wipe the cord with a dry, soft cloth. Do not use liquid cleaners or immerse the cord in water.
- **Storage:** When not in use, coil the power cord loosely. Avoid tight coiling or bending, which can damage the internal wires. Store in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight.
- **Inspection:** Periodically inspect the entire length of the cord for any signs of damage, such as cuts, abrasions, or discoloration. If any damage is found, discontinue use immediately and replace the cord.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

If your sewing machine is not receiving power after installing the BAIJAC Replacement Power Cord, consider the following:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Sewing machine does not power on.	Cord not fully plugged in.	Ensure both ends of the power cord are securely plugged into the machine and the wall outlet.
	Wall outlet is not active.	Test the wall outlet with another appliance to confirm it has power. Check circuit breakers.
	Power cord is damaged.	Inspect the cord for visible damage. If damaged, discontinue use and replace.
Intermittent power.	Loose connection.	Ensure all connections are firm. Avoid pulling or tugging on the cord during use.

If troubleshooting steps do not resolve the issue, consult your Babylock sewing machine's original manual or contact a qualified technician.
